Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare and Rural Development reviews action plan for strengthening KVKs

Focus on upgradation of 300 KVKs by March 2027 and establishment of Incubation-cum-Skill Centres in all KVKs by December 2028

New Delhi, Sept. 7(PIB)

Union Minister for Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare and Rural Development, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan, today chaired a meeting in New Delhi to review the Action Plan for strengthening Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) through enhanced participation of States. The deliberations focused on the implementation of key recommendations concerning KVKs emerging from the 5th Chief Secretaries' Conference 2025, and on measures to accelerate their implementation.

Discussions focused on the action point of



upgrading the infrastructure and logistics of 300 prioritized KVKs by March 2027. Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan emphasized the need for active participation and timely support from State Governments to achieve the target within the stipulated timeframe. The Secretary, DARE, has

engaged with the Chief Secretaries of all States and Union Territories to mobilize financial and institutional support for the upgradation of prioritized KVKs. Several States have initiated the process through their respective State Agricultural Universities, Maharashtra, Gujarat,

Goa and Chhattisgarh have received Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) from Universities/KVKs, while other States are at various stages of preparation and implementation.

Also covered the action point of establishing Incubation-cum-Skill Centres in all KVKs by December 2028. Under the initiative, KVKs are being mapped with agro-based enterprises, technical partner institutions and district-specific agricultural opportunities. KVK-wise incubation plans are being developed for submission to States and

Union Territories for funding and implementation support.

Further detailed discussions on reforms concerning KVK personnel. The proposed reforms relating to pay, allowances and promotion of KVK staff have received approval from the Department of Expenditure (DoE). The role of State Governments in providing NPS contributions and retirement benefits for KVK staff, as applicable, was also emphasized. States were urged to undertake timely recruitment against vacancies to ensure adequate manpower for the effective functioning of KVKs and delivery of their mandated activities.

Attention was also drawn to the importance of ensuring timely release of funds to KVKs, particularly for seasonal agricultural programmes, so that planned activities are implemented within the appropriate agricultural window. Under the Cluster Frontline Demonstrations (CFLD) on Pulses and Oilseeds programme for 2026-27, activities are being implemented across 24 States through 353 KVKs/districts, with a target area of 12,349 hectares. An area of 9,750 hectares, has already been achieved. Issues relating to fund-flow mapping and delays in the release of funds in some States were discussed. States were requested to facilitate the smooth and timely flow of funds up to ATARI and KVK levels, ensure timely availability of recommended quality seeds and varieties, and strengthen coordination during the planning and execution of demonstrations.

Review also highlighted the role of KVKs in supporting the Pradhan Mantri Dhan-Dhaanya Krishi Yojana (PM DDKY). States were requested to provide adequate funding support to KVKs for implementing their mandated activities as well as district-specific action plans under PM DDKY. It was further emphasized that activities undertaken by KVKs at the district level, in addition to capacity-building programmes, should be captured and uploaded on the designated portal to facilitate comprehensive monitoring, reporting and assessment of outcomes.

The CRCFV programme, initiated by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India, aims to strengthen livelihood security and climate resilience of coastal fishing communities through skill development, diversified livelihood activities, sustainable fisheries practices and post-harvest management, with special emphasis on enhancing livelihood opportunities through value addition.

In the A&N Islands, Hope Town and Junglighat in South Andaman District and Durgapur in North & Middle Andaman District have been identified for implementation of CRCFV activities. As part of these initiatives, the present training programme is being conducted from 7th to 9th September, 2026 at Hope Town village, South Andaman and from 11th to 13th September, 2026 at Durgapur, Diglipur to impart technical and practical skills in seafood processing and value addition. Such initiatives are intended to promote better utilization of fishery resources, reduce post-harvest losses and create additional income-generation opportunities for fishing communities, particularly through small-scale value addition and entrepreneurship.

The programme was inaugurated by Dr. K. Gopal, Joint Director (Fisheries), in the presence of Ms. V. K. Mariyam Bibi, Zilla Parishad Member, Hope Town, Smt. Rasheeda Bibi, Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Hope Town and Shri B. Laxmi Narayan, Panchayat Samiti Member, Hope Town, as guests. The programme was coordinated by Shri Mohammed Farooque, In-Charge, Fish Landing Centre, Panighat, along with Sagar Mitras. During the inaugural session, Joint Director (Fisheries), emphasized the importance of making effective use of the specialized training being imparted by NIFPHATT, Cochin, a premier institute in the field of fisheries post-harvest technology and value addition.

Dr. Nithin C. T., Processing-cum-Quality Assurance Supervisor, and Shri Bineesh K. Mukundan, Processing-cum-Quality Assurance Supervisor, NIFPHATT, Cochin is leading the three days programme by providing technical sessions on detailed guidance on various aspects of value-added seafood product development, including processing techniques, product preparation, hygienic handling, quality assurance and other relevant post-harvest practices.

During the programme, various value-added seafood products, including fish pickles, fish wafers, smoked fish, canned fish and ready-to-cook Tilapia curry etc. branded by NIFPHATT, Cochin were also displayed and demonstrated. The training programme will further provide practical exposure to the participants in the preparation and development of at least 10 different value-added seafood products, including breaded and battered products, pickles, fried products and different types of fish-based curries.

Vessel MV Swaraj Dweep to arrive on Sept. 8

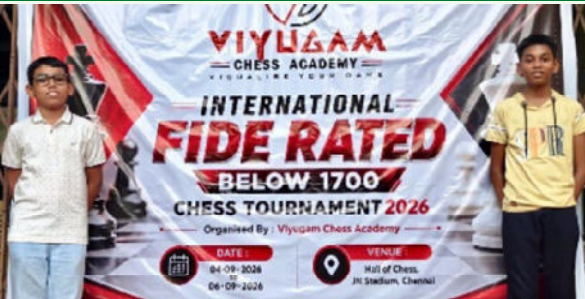

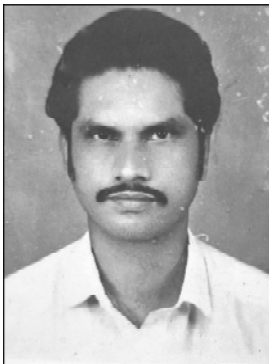

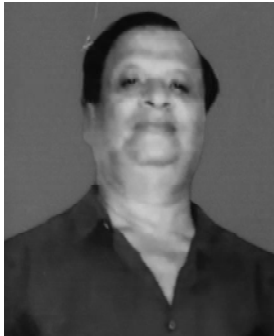
