RBI to link base rate with MCLR
New Delhi, Feb 8

The Reserve Bank of India has said that it will link the base rate with the MCLR from 1st of April this year to ensure expeditious transmission of its policy rate to borrowers. In a statement, RBI said, though it had introduced the Marginal Cost of Funds based Lending Rates (MCLR) system with effect from 1st April 2016, the Central bank observed that a large proportion of bank loans continue to be linked to Base Rate.

Five year jail for former B'desh PM
Dhaka, Feb 8

Bangladesh's former Prime Minister and Opposition BNP chief Smti Khaleda Zia has been sentenced to five years in jail in a corruption case. 72-year-old Zia was sentenced by a special court in the capital, Dhaka, in connection with embezzlement of 252,000 US dollar in foreign donations meant for the Zia Orphanage Trust.

PM Modi calls for opposition's cooperation for holding simultaneous polls to save resources

New Delhi, Feb 8

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has sought the opposition's cooperation for a constructive discussion and working out a solution on the issue of simultaneous polls. Shri Modi said, thousands of crore rupees are spent in conducting elections and so much time is wasted in holding them.

The Prime Minister was replying to a debate in the Rajya Sabha on the Motion of Thanks to the President's address to the joint sitting of both the Houses of Parliament yesterday. Shri Modi asked all parties to rise above politics on this issue, arguing that it will cut down the cost of elections in terms of time, money and manpower.

The Prime Minister also sought constructive suggestions from all parties for government's healthcare programme 'Ayushman Bharat' which was announced in the recently presented budget. He said, the Centre is always looking for suggestions, feedback and input on its schemes. He said that 'Ayushman Bharat' scheme should not be compared with such similar schemes in Britain and America as every nation has its own context, challenges and nature of working. He also requested the opposition parties to form a task force within their parties to give suggestions on



the health scheme.

Shri Modi appealed to the opposition parties to extend their support in passing the Triple Talaq Bill and a Bill to give constitutional status to the National Commission of Backward Classes. Shri Modi questioned why the opposition parties stalled these two bills in the last session. Shri Modi also said, the NDA government has worked hard and ushered in a paradigm shift in its functioning. He said innovative projects are being completed in a time-bound manner. He said, the government

always looked for suggestions, feedback and input on various schemes as everyone is working for the interest of the nation and the poor.

Remembering former Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, he said when three new states Uttarakhand, Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh were carved out, Shri Vajpayee showed farsightedness in decision making. He said, the NDA government is building more roads than the UPA government and it has given a strong boost to the infrastructure sector across the nation. The Prime Minister said, in the new aviation policy, the government is focusing on smaller cities and towns to provide air connectivity so that more people could avail the facility of air services.

On Aadhaar, the Prime Minister said, the government is implementing it in a more scientific way to provide the benefits of subsidy to the people of various schemes but the Congress is opposing it. He said, the only people who are adversely affected by the implementation of Aadhaar are dishonest, corrupt and middlemen and this is the real reason why it is being opposed. He said India's middle class wants good education facilities, infrastructure and affordable housing and 'Ease of Living' to which the government is committed.

Scheme made easy for prizes of Rs. One Lac every Month

Port Blair, Feb.8

A scheme to collect plastic waste by the PBMC was launched in the month of January. The winners for the month of January were announced on Feb.5 2018 and prize money is being transferred to their respective Bank Accounts within this week.

Following this, many requests have been received to allow weekly collection since spaces are not available in small houses to keep the collected material and it is inconvenient to carry huge quantity of collected waste to the collection points on monthly basis. To make the Scheme more user friendly, certain changes have been made

by PBMC. Accordingly, now the plastic bottles/plastic bags/plastic waste can be deposited on every Monday between 9 am to 12 noon at the six collection points. If Monday happens to be holiday, the collection will

be accepted on the next working day. Cash amount @ Rs. 2/- per kg will be paid at the time of weekly deposit. Further, it must be ensured that the collections are deposited at the same centre during the month.

MS Dhoni becomes first India wicketkeeper to reach 400 dismissals in ODIs

Cape Town, Feb 8
MS Dhoni's stumping of South African captain Aiden Markram in Cape Town during the third ODI was his 400th time he effected a dismissal in the 50-over game. He is the first Indian wicketkeeper to do so and the fourth after Sri Lanka's Kumar Sangakkara, Australia's Adam Gilchrist and South Africa's Mark Boucher.



Dhoni took 315 matches to get to the mark. Sangakkara, who tops this list, had 482 dismissals from 404 matches while Gilchrist and Boucher were involved in 472 and 424 dismissals respectively. Interestingly, Dhoni has 105 stumpings to his name so far, most by any glovesman in ODI cricket. In the 17th over of the South African innings, chinaman bowler Kuldeep deceived Markram with a tossed up

delivery and Dhoni subsequently disturbed the woodwork behind the Proteas captain to send him back in the hut. Earlier, in the day, the visiting team rode on captain Virat Kohli's scintillating 160* to compile a score of 303/6 in 50

overs. Later, South Africa started off the chase disappointingly after losing Hashim Amla early but Markram and JP Duminy resisted against India's pace attack. But the script totally changed when the wrist

spinners were introduced in the attack as South Africa lost three wickets in quick succession that included Markram and Duminy to be reduced to 95/4 in 22nd over. India lead the 6-match series 2-0.

Stephen Constantine set to be India coach until 2019 Asian Cup



New Delhi, Feb 8

Indian football coach Stephen Constantine was on Wednesday offered a contract extension until the end of the 2019 AFC Asian Cup, following a string of highly impressive results in recent times.

The "unanimous" recommendation was passed in Mumbai by the All India Football Federation's (AIFF) technical committee headed by former India player Shyam Thapa. The technical committee's recommendation will now have to be ratified by the AIFF's executive committee. The team has stayed undefeated in 13 matches, an unprecedented run that includes 11 wins and two draws. Under the Englishman, the Indian team also achieved its best FIFA ranking since February 1996 as it was placed at No.96 in the rankings released last July. Given the team's dream run of wins, the AIFF's top brass was naturally not keen of parting ways with the 55-year-old Constantine.

PV Sindhu wins but India lose to Japan, still progress to Badminton Asia Team Championship QFs

Indian women shuttlers advanced to the Badminton Asia Team Championship quarterfinals despite a 1-4 loss to Japan in which PV Sindhu notched up the country's only win here on Thursday. Sindhu extended her domination over world No.2 Akane Yamaguchi with a straight-game win. Despite the loss, India qualified for the quarter-final in both the women's and men's

competition. The Indian women finished second in Group W with one win and one loss ahead of Hong Kong China but behind Japan. The Sindhu-led squad had defeated Hong Kong China 3-2 in its opening group tie. With a rampaging 5-0 win over lower-ranked Philippines and Maldives, the Indian men's team too has qualified for the quarter-finals from Group D.

General, 13- OBC, 03-ST, 01-Person with disabilities and 02 for Meritorious Sports Persons. As per instructions of DoPT, Govt of India, in case a candidate belonging to ST/OBC who is selected on the same standards as applied to general category candidates and who appears in the general merit list is treated as own merit candidate for adjustment against, general category. Accordingly, it may be seen that many candidates belonging to OBC category have been included in the General Category also. However final placement of the candidates of OBC category will be decided after Type-Test and verification of their eligibility documents.

The short-listed candidates are required to submit self-attested copy of their documents with regard to educational qualification, age proof, valid employment registration card, local and category certificates and other testimonials latest by 20.02.2018 to the Administrative Officer, PBMC.
