Administration sanctions Filter Bed Unit and Clear Water Reservoir to improve water supply at Wrafter Creek, Baratang

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 8 In a major step towards strengthening drinking water infrastructure in Baratang, the A&N Administration has accorded sanction for the construction of a Filter Bed Unit and a Clear Water Reservoir (CWR) at Wrafter Creek, Baratang, at an estimated cost of Rs.1.38 crore.

Clear Water Reservoir with a storage capacity of 1.35 lakh litres, relaying of pipelines, and installation of an 8 HP diesel engine pump set. This long-pending demand of the residents of Wrafter Creek, Khattakhari and Rajatgarh villages aims to significantly improve the availability, quality and reliability of treated drinking water in the area.

On completion, the project is expected to result in a marked improvement in daily water supply, ensuring safe and treated potable water to the beneficiary villages and enhancing overall public health and living standards. This initiative is part of the Administration's continuous efforts to strengthen water supply systems and ensure consistent access to potable water for the public, especially in areas facing water stress. The project is being implemented by

the Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) with the objective of improving service delivery and meeting the growing water demand of the area. Meanwhile, the APWD has also appealed to the general public to use water judiciously, emphasizing that water is a precious resource and its availability reduces significantly during the summer

of 10 group members, 7 women initially came forward to work together. With an initial investment of just Rs.1,000 per member, The early phase was extremely challenging- no prior business experience, licensing hurdles, packaging costs, electricity, rent, and market access posed serious risks.



The early push came through DAY-NRLM-supported Fairs and Melas, which provided direct consumer access and Free brand exposure. They availed loan from Village Organization and repaid the initial contributions of the outgoing members. Later, a formal partnership agreement was signed between Smt. Supriya Dutta and Smt. Sukla Halder, while another member joined as an employee. This transformation brought clear ownership and accountability, Financial discipline, Stronger people management and Structured production and sales planning.

The DAY-NRLM played a catalytic role in transforming the group from a small unit into a thriving, multi-location enterprise with a strong and consistent market presence.

Today, the members of Parash SHG earn an average of Rs. 35,000 per month, qualifying them under the Lakhpati Didi category, a landmark milestone reflecting their transition from marginal income earners to stable micro-entrepreneurs. (Source: RD Department)

Eligibility

- ◆ Unorganised Workers (PM-SYM): Monthly income up to Rs15,000, age 18-40 years, not covered under EPFO/ESIC/ NPS, and not an income tax payer.
- ◆ Small Traders/Shopkeepers (PM-LVM): Age 18-40 years, annual turnover up to Rs. 1.5 crore, and not an income tax payer.

Scheme Benefits

- ◆ Voluntary and contributory pension scheme.
- ◆ Minimum assured pension of Rs. 3,000 per month after attaining 60 years of age.
- ◆ 50% family pension payable to spouse after the death of the subscriber.
- ◆ Equal matching contribution by the Central Government.

Enrolment

Eligible persons may enroll through the nearest Common Services Centre (CSC) using Aadhaar Card and Savings/Jan-Dhan Bank Account. The first contribution is to be paid in cash, followed by auto-debit of monthly contributions.

The Un-Organized Workers / small trader/shopkeepers and self-employed persons who are unable to register themselves or through CSC may visit the Labour Department, Sri Vijaya Puram, on any working day for assistance with registration.
