## DLSA holds Lok Adalat; settles bank recovery cases at pre-litigation stage

Port Blair, Apr 8

The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman and Nicobar Islands held National Lok Adalat in the District Court Building, Port Blair, ADR Centre - PRAYAS, Port Blair, District Court building at Mayabunder, Circuit Court building at Diglipur, CJM Court building at Car Nicobar and JM Court building at Campbell Bay today.

Out of the total 435 pre-litigation bank recovery cases and 227 cases pending in courts at Port Blair, 37 pre-litigation bank recovery cases and 27 cases including 2 Motor Accident Claim cases and 1 Money suits pending in Court were settled and finally disposed of by the National Lok Adalat at Port Blair. Disposing of 37 bank recovery cases, of Rs. 53,04,524/- has been settled at Rs. 28,80,238/- thus paving a benefit of Rs. 24,24,286/- to the bank loan customers. For taking up these 662 cases of Port Blair, the District Legal Services Authority has constituted three Benches, each headed by Shri

Prasenjit Biswas, Registrar, High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Port Blair, Shri Siddhartha Kanjilal, District & Sessions Judge & Chairman, District Legal Services Authority and Shri Debasish Bandyopadhyay, Additional District and Sessions Judge as Chairpersons sitting with Shri Rakesh Pal Gobind, Advocate & Secretary, A & N Bar Association, Shri VD Shiva Balan, Advocate, Smt. Anita Hegde, Advocate, Ex-Adhyaksha, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman, Ms Mariyam Bibi, Councillor, Ward No. 8, PBMC, Shri K. Ganeshan, and Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Mannarghat, Shri Basheer, as Members.

Earlier, before commencement of the National Lok Adalat, a legal awareness programme was organized. Speaking on the occasion Shri Siddhartha Kanjilal, District and Sessions Judge and Chairman, DLSA asked the gathering to take benefit of the Lok Adalat stating that the awards passed by the Lok Adalat are not appealable before any court

of law and that such award can be executed as if it is the decree of a Civil Court. Shri Rakesh Pal Gobind, Advocate and Secretary, Andaman and Nicobar Bar Association also spoke on the occasion stating various aspects as to how the litigants will be benefitted if their disputes and cases are settled at the instance of Lok Adalats. The programme commenced with welcome addressed by Shri J. Sudarsanan, Chief Administrative Officer, District and Sessions Court.

## No more grace period to exchange demonetised notes: Govt to SC

New Delhi, Apr 8

The Centre has told the Supreme Court that it took a conscious decision not to extend the period beyond December 30 last year for exchanging the demonetised currency notes unlike for NRIs which ended on the 31st of last month.

The Finance Ministry filed an affidavit in response to petitions by private individuals and a

firm seeking a window like those given to NRIs and people who were abroad during the period of demonetisation.

The Ministry said, it was not legally bound to come out with a fresh notification to grant grace period or window. It said, the decision not to extend the period was taken after an overall review of the malpractices and irregularities detected

between 9th November and 30th December when the public was allowed to exchange or deposit their old money for the new currency.

The Ministry also gave details about the raids and recoveries made by law-enforcing agencies during and after the demonetisation period claiming that undisclosed income of over 5,400 crore rupees was detected.

## Large asteroid to buzz past Earth

New York, Apr 8  
A relatively large near-Earth asteroid will fly safely past our planet on April 19 at a distance of about 1.8 million kilometres - over four times the distance from Earth to the Moon, NASA said on Saturday. Although there is no possibility for the asteroid to collide with Earth, this will be a very close approach for an asteroid of this size.



The asteroid, known as 2014 JO25, was discovered in May 2014 by astronomers at the Catalina Sky Survey in Arizona, US. Contemporary measurements by NASA's NEOWISE mission indicate that the asteroid is roughly 650 meters in size, and that its surface is about twice as reflective as that of the Moon. At this time very little else is known about the object's physical properties, even though its trajectory is well known. The asteroid will approach Earth from the direction of the Sun and will become visible in the night sky after April 19. It is predicted to brighten to about magnitude 11, when it could be visible in small optical telescopes for one or two nights before it fades as the distance from Earth rapidly increases, NASA said. Small asteroids pass within this distance of Earth several times each week, but the upcoming close approach is the closest by any known asteroid of this size, or larger, since asteroid Toutatis, a five-kilometre asteroid, which approached within about four lunar distances in 2004. The next known encounter of an asteroid of comparable size will occur in 2027 when the 800-metre-wide asteroid 1999 AN10 will fly by at one lunar distance, about 380,000 kilometres. The April 19 encounter provides an outstanding opportunity to study this asteroid, and astronomers plan to observe it with telescopes around the world to learn as much about it as possible. The encounter on April 19 is the closest this asteroid has come to Earth for at least the last 400 years and will be its closest approach for at least the next 500 years. Also on April 19, the comet PanSTARRS (C/2015 ER61) will make its closest approach to Earth, at a very safe distance of 175 million kilometres, NASA said. A faint fuzball in the sky when it was discovered in 2015 by the Pan-STARRS NEO survey team using a telescope on the summit of Haleakala, Hawaii, the comet has brightened considerably due to a recent outburst and is now visible in the dawn sky with binoculars or a small telescope.
