**RBI warns fake website**  
New Delhi, Feb 9  
Reserve Bank of India has cautioned the people about a fake website which is reportedly asking for personal and confidential banking details of bank customers in its name. In a statement, the RBI said the fake website, www.indiareservebank.org, which has similar layout as the RBI website contains a provision called Bank verification with online account holders which appears to have been created with a fraudulent intent.

**Hike for smart city mission in budget**  
New Delhi, Feb 9  
Housing and Urban Affairs Minister Shri Hardeep Singh Puri has said that the budgetary allocation for Smart Cities Mission in the next financial year has been hiked by more than 54 percent over last year's allocation. He said, an amount of 6,169 crore rupees has been proposed in the budget for smart cities. Under the mission, 99 cities have been selected so far and a total investment of over two lakh crore rupees has been proposed in the Smart City Plans.

**China deploys Su-35 jets in South China Sea**  
Beijing, Feb 9  
China has deployed the newly acquired Russian made Su-35 fighter jets in its combat mission over the disputed South China Sea. The deployment is reportedly aimed to challenge recurring US aerial and naval patrols asserting freedom of navigation and over-flight in region.

the agricultural sector. He said, there are several schemes of the Centre and State Governments that offer special incentives to enterprises engaged in the agriculture sector. He added that there are also many venture capital funds that can come

forward to invest in agriculture-based enterprises. Shri Kovind said, students should use the opportunities and set up their ventures and become job creators. The President said, IARI played a critical role in the Green Revolution that

changed the course of food production in the country. He expressed happiness that students from fourteen countries are being educated in IARI and it is helping in the development of agricultural capacities and research in neighbouring countries.

## BJP State Prez urges for justified seniority list of DRMs in APWD

Port Blair, Feb.9  
The State President of BJP A&N Islands, Shri. Vishal Jolly, in a letter addressed to the Lt. Governor A&N Islands, with reference to APWD's decision to extend the benefit of 1/30th of Pay plus DA to DRMs dated 16th January 2018, has requested for preparing a justified seniority list of DRMs, in the APWD, including those engaged through Contractor as per the Mandays with a view to get the benefit of 1/30th pay

plus DA to the DRMs serving the Department for a long period. He mentioned that engagement as DRMs gives employment opportunity to Isles educated youth to a great extent. During later 90's, the DRMs were employed only for 6 months (180 days) in a year to avoid legal conspiracy on 240 days statutory in A&N Islands. But now, after removing 240 days statutory, the DRMs are continuously (Contd. on last page)

## DLSA to conduct National Lok Adalats today

The District Legal Service Authority (DLSA), Andaman and Nicobar Islands will hold National Lok Adalats in the Alternative Disputes Resolution Centre- 'PRAYAS' and District Court complex at Port Blair from 9.30 am onwards on Feb.10, 2018. The categories of cases which will be taken up by the National Lok Adalat for consensual settlement between the parties are Criminal Compoundable cases; Negotiable Instruments Act under Section 138; pending in courts, Bank Recovery cases both pending in courts and at the prelitigation stage, MACT cases pending in courts; Labour disputes cases; Electricity and water bills (excluding non-compoundable); Matrimonial disputes, Land Acquisition cases pending in courts; Revenue cases (pending in District Courts only) and other Civil Cases (rent, easmentary rights, injunction suits, specific performance suits) etc., a communication said.

## BSNL's mobile network expansion project Two mobile BTSs & a micro BTS commissioned in Great Nicobar Island

## India eye milestone win, South Africa hope for revival

Johannesburg, Feb 9

An indomitable Team india looks set for a landmark series triumph but an injury-ravaged South Africa would hope for some AB de Villiers magic to halt the visitors' charge in the fourth one-day, here on Saturday.

With an unassailable 3-0 lead in hand, India need just one more win to claim their maiden ODI series triumph on South African soil. The closest they came was in 2010-11, when under Mahendra Singh Dhoni, they shot into a 2-1 lead only to lose the five-match series 3-2. India had previously broken into uncharted territory at Newlands when, for the first time since they began touring here in 1992-93, they won three matches in a bilateral ODI engagement in South Africa. A fourth consecutive win will



also cement their spot as the No.1 side in the ICC ODI Rankings. De Villiers has a handsome record on Pink Days. In 2015, he had smashed 149 off just 44 balls against the West Indies. In 2013, when India were first part of this Pink Day celebration, De Villiers had scored 77 off 47 balls. Their only cause for cheer against the Proteas here came in January 2011, when Munaf Patel took 4/29 to lead India to a thrilling one-run win. Thanks to Kohli's imperious

consistency and the terrorising form of their wrist spinners, that lopsided record might just be about to change.

as highest annual incremental performance. He said, the study of incremental performance of states will ensure the government for better health outcomes.

The report said about one third of the states have registered a decline in their performance in 2016 as compared to 2015. 
