## Govt approves promulgation of amended regulations for municipalities in 3 UTs

New Delhi, Mar 9  
The Central Government has approved various amendments to regulations for municipalities of three Union Territories – Daman and Diu, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, and Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The decision was taken at a meeting of the Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi recently. The proposals are Daman and Diu Municipalities (Amendment) Regulation, 2018; the Dadra and Nagar Haveli Municipal Council (Amendment) Regulation, 2018; and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Municipal (Amendment) Regulation 2018. The decision will help ensure better provisions for the constitution, administration and powers of the municipalities in the

# Spectacular International City Parade fascinates spectators at Marina Park

The stunning settings at the Marina Park was the venue for a glorious International City Parade this evening. The City Parade showcased the motto of MILAN 'Friendship Across the Seas' in great style as school children, Marine Commandos, Para Jumpers, marching contingents and cultural troops stole the hearts of the spectators gathered at the venue in large number. Eight foreign contingents participated in the International Parade.

They included Australia, Bangladesh, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Singapore and Thailand. The Lt Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, VSM, NM (Retd), reviewed the parade as smartly turned out contingents of all four components, marched to the tunes of military bands. The Chief of Naval Staff, Admiral Sunil Lanba, PVSM, AVSM, ADC, the Commander-in-Chief, A & N Command, Vice Admiral

Bimal Verma, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar, a host of foreign naval officers, senior officers of the Defense and Civil Administration were among the large gathering to witness the parade. The events unfolded with the backdrop of the historic Ross Island against the pristine blue waters of the Andaman Sea. Marine Commandos of the Indian Navy demonstrated a small team insertion and extraction

technique as they launched an attack on a dummy oil rig. This was followed by a Search and Rescue demonstration by Chetak helicopters of the Indian Navy & the Coast Guard, instilling confidence amongst the spectators about the HADR capabilities of the Armed Forces. The daring display by motorcyclists from the Indian Army left the audience enthralled. The Marine Commandos of the Indian Navy jumped from a Dornier aircraft for a

combat free fall to exhibit sky diving skills. Ceremonial bands of the Army, Navy, Andaman & Nicobar Police mesmerised the audience with martial music. The colourful tableaux from Andaman & Nicobar Command, Forest Department and Directorate of Shipping Services as also the cultural folk dances added colour to the event. The 15 Assam Regiment closed out the cultural extravaganza with an ebullient Manipuri dance.

The Continuity Drill of the Indian Navy and the precise manoeuvres of Air warrior Drill Team, drew applause from the huge gathering with their split second precision. As the setting sun streaked the twilight sky, the Indian Naval Band performed, the last tune before the Retreat, while the National Flag was being lowered. The fireworks and the synchronized illumination of the Naval ships at anchorage was a sight to cherish for a long time to come.

**Anjum Moudgil wins silver in Women's Rifle 3 positions at ISSF World Cup**



New Delhi, Mar 9  
Indian shooter Anjum Moudgil clinched a silver medal in the women's 50m Rifle 3 Positions event at the ongoing ISSF World Cup in Guadalajara, Mexico. It was Anjum's first World Cup medal as she battled windy conditions to shoot 454.2 in the 45-shot final to finish behind former junior world champion China's Ruijiao Pei (455.4). Another Chinese Ting Sun claimed bronze, finishing with a score of 442.2.

This was India's eighth medal in the competition and the first silver after having won three golds and four bronze medals already, for their best ISSF World Cup performance by far. India thus remained on top of the medals tally with eight medals, while China is in second with two gold, two silver, one bronze.

Anjum remained in medal contention from the beginning of the final and at the end of the 15-shot kneeling position stood third behind Ruijiao and

Slovakia's Ziva Dvorsak. A brilliant 10.8 in the 41st shot took her up to second and she maintained that position finishing with scores of 10.2, 10.1, 9.5 and 10.2 to secure the first World Cup medal of her career. Earlier in qualification, Anjum rode on the back of a solid prone round of 399 out of 400 to log a combined 1170 and sail through to the eight-woman final in second place behind Pei, who shot a qualification world record score of 1178.

**Sharath Kamal stuns World No.7 Koki Niwa at Qatar Open**

Doha, Mar 9  
India's Sharath Kamal and G Sathiyam made heads turn when they defeated World No.7 Koki Niwa and 27th-ranked Yuya Oshima respectively to enter men's singles pre-quarterfinals of the ITTF World Tour Platinum Qatar Open here. If Sharath disposed of Niwa 8-11, 11-9, 11-8, 14-12, 11-9 rather easily, the passage of Sathiyam saw a roller-coaster ride before the Indian prevailed over Oshima 6-11, 11-5, 2-11, 12-10, 10-12, 11-4, 11-8 in a tension-ridden Round of 32. The match between Sathiyam and Oshima had several Indian expats on the edge of their seats and, in fact, their support encouraged him to put up a spirited fight against the 15th seed Japanese.



The turnaround for Sathiyam happened when he held on to the fifth game 12-10 after deuce -- he lost the previous game 10-12 -- to level score in the second consecutive thriller. But it gave the necessary confidence to Sathiyam as he won the last two games, striking a nice rhythm. His next outing in the round of 16 will be much tougher he takes on the Japanese child prodigy Tomokazu Harimoto,

who needs no introduction to his Indian fans. For Sharath, who did not have a good track record against Koki Niwa, the win looked rather sweet as he was down in most games. Yet, Sharath was impressive throughout and his experience came to the fore when he caused one of the biggest upsets in the championships with his strong backhand fetching him good results.

**Sri Lanka aims to extend domination over Bangladesh**

Colombo, Mar 9  
Hosts Sri Lanka will aim to continue their recent domination against a beleaguered Bangladesh when the two teams meet in the Nidahas Twenty20 Trophy in Colombo on Saturday. Sri Lanka will be high on confidence going into their second game after they surprised India in the tournament opener. Their recent record against Bangladesh is impressive, having beaten them in the away Test and T20 series besides the final of the tri-series, which

also included Zimbabwe. The way Sri Lanka played against India was even more impressive, comfortably chasing a stiff 175-run target courtesy a Kusal Perera special. On the bowling front, pacer Dushmantha Chameera stood out while the Indians struggled to read the wrong-un of leggie Jeevan Mendis. The openers, Kusal Mendis and Danushka Gunathilaka, began well but failed to make a substantial contribution, something they will look to change on Saturday.

After the India win, captain Dinesh Chandimal said the players are feeling good about their game and also gave credit to coach Chandika Hathurusingha, who was earlier with Bangladesh. "This is all about transferring confidence from the Bangladesh series. The management have done a wonderful job at training sessions. Chandika Hathurusingha has been amazing. This result shows how good we are as a team," Chandimal had said.
