Surfing gets a New Home

India's Best Surfers and Stand-Up Paddlers converge at Butler Bay Beach in Little Andaman as National Championship begins



Little Andaman, Apr. 9

India's top surfing and stand-up paddling talent has converged in Little Andaman as the inaugural Little Andaman Pro 2026, the National Surfing & Stand-Up Paddling (SUP) Championship, gets underway today at the iconic Butler Bay Beach. The four-day surfing spectacle opened with pre-event expression sessions, flagged off by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, in the presence of Comm- cum-Secretary, Ms. Chanchal Yadav, IAS, Director (IP&T), Shri Vinayak Chamadia, IAS, other senior officers of A&N Administration alongside India's prime athletes, offering an electrifying preview of the competition ahead.

Organised by the Surfing Federation of India (SFI) and fully sponsored by Andaman & Nicobar Tourism, the championship features close to 100

participants competing across categories including Men's Open Surfing, Women's Open Surfing, SUP Sprint (Men & Women), and SUP Technical (Men & Women).

In a landmark moment for the region, large crowds from Little Andaman gathered along the shoreline to witness surfing and stand-up paddling at a national scale for the very first time, marking a significant cultural and sporting milestone for the islands.

The event holds added significance as it serves as a key opener for India's surfing season in a landmark year for the sport, with the country set to make its debut in surfing at the Asian Games Japan 2026. Following strong performances at recent Asian Surfing Championships, where India secured qualification quotas, domestic competitions like the Little Andaman Pro are crucial in preparing athletes

for the international stage.

Leading the charge in the men's surfing division are Kishore Kumar, Sivaraj Babu, Srikanth D, and Ramesh Budhial. Kishore Kumar remains one of India's standout international performers, having clinched a silver medal at the Asian Surfing Championships in Taiwan and becoming one of the first Indians to reach the semifinals at the continental level. Sivaraj Babu brings consistency and depth from the national circuit, while Srikanth D continues

to build on multiple domestic podium finishes. Ramesh Budhial, part of India's international contingent, has shown steady progression in recent competitions.

In the women's division, Kamali Prakash, Sugar Shanthi, and Shristi Selvam are among the frontrunners. Kamali Prakash, one of India's most recognised surfing talents, has represented the country at multiple international events. Sugar

Andaman birder cop finds tagged migratory bird, identified by Mumbai expert

The Andaman and Nicobar archipelago comprises hundreds of tropical islands known for their rich biodiversity and ecological significance

In a rare and scientifically significant sighting, a migratory shorebird tagged in South Australia after travelling nearly 7,500 km has been recorded on the remote Narcondam Island in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The Andaman and Nicobar archipelago, located about 1,200 km from the Indian mainland between the Bay of Bengal and the Andaman Sea, comprises hundreds of tropical islands known for their rich biodiversity and ecological significance.



Narcondam Island, one of the most isolated among them, remains largely inaccessible and sparsely inhabited. The bird, identified as a Sanderling (Calidris alba),

was photographed by G. Thikanna, an Assistant Sub-Inspector in the Communications Wing of the Andaman Police. An avid birder, Thikanna is associated with the

Andaman Avians Club and actively works to promote awareness about avifauna in the islands.

Thikanna was posted on Narcondam Island, located about 140 nautical miles from Sri Vijaya Puram, for a one-month tenure when he made the observation. Life on the island is challenging, with no mobile network and limited electricity supplied by a portable generator for a few hours daily.

During a routine shoreline inspection on

the morning of June 16, 2025, Thikanna noticed a small shorebird moving along the tidal edge. What drew his attention were coloured tags on its legs. Recognising the importance of the sighting, he quickly retrieved his camera and documented the bird. The images revealed three distinct markers: a red flag above the knee and a yellow tag below the knee on the right leg, and a metal ring on the left leg. The red flag bore the code "DYM".

Although he initially shared the sighting informally with friends, it remained unreported due to work commitments.

The breakthrough came in March 2026 when Mumbai-based ornithologist Dr Raju Kasambe, former Assistant Director at the Bombay Natural History Society and founder of Mumbai Bird Katta, visited South Andaman on a birding trip.

Upon reviewing the photographs shared by Thikanna, Dr Kasambe confirmed the bird's identity as a Sanderling, a long-distance migratory wader that breeds in the Arctic regions of Asia, Europe, and North America. Further analysis using the East Asian-Australasian Flyway (EAAF) colour-marking protocol indicated that the bird had been tagged in South Australia.

Subsequent communication with the EAAF team revealed that the bird was tagged on April 13, 2025, by researcher Maureen Christie at Danger Point, Brown Bay near Port Macdonnell in South Australia.

"This indicates that the bird reached Narcondam Island in just over two months during its northward migration towards its Arctic breeding grounds. The straight-line distance covered was approximately 7,472 km, and it had not yet reached its final destination," Dr Kasambe said.

The sighting marks the first recorded resighting of a tagged bird on Narcondam Island, underscoring the island's ecological importance despite its isolation.

Notably, Narcondam is also home to the endemic Narcondam Hornbill, a species found nowhere else in the world, further highlighting the island's unique biodiversity. (Source: <https://www.deccanherald.com/>)

No.69/2026/F.No.34-725/2026-Rev.— WHEREAS, the Preliminary Notification under Section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued by Revenue Department for acquisition of 6.8244 hectares of land in Hopetown Village under Ferrargunj Tehsil, South Andaman District vide Notification dated 29.01.2025 which was published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette for the public purpose of "Shifting the existing POL Terminal from Haddo to Hopetown village" for Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL).

AND, WHEREAS, Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) has requested withdrawal of the said acquisition vide letter dated 04.12.2025 since the land offered to IOCL at Hope Town for creation of new POL Terminal, falls under ICRZ IA, IB and CRZ III areas as per the IPZ Notification, 2011 and while the construction of Petroleum, Oil & Lubricant (POL) storage and handling facilities is permissible in ICRZ III areas subject to obtaining CRZ clearance, such facilities cannot be constructed in ICRZ IA and IB areas.
