## New Rs 13,000 crore airport at Great Nicobar Island to improve India's forward posture in the Indian Ocean



India's Rs 13,000 crore investment in the Great Nicobar Island to build a dual-use airport and runway marks a critical step in strengthening both civilian connectivity and military readiness at one of the most critical global maritime chokepoints, the Strait of Malacca.

Strategically located near the Strait of Malacca, the project enhances India's ability to monitor one of the world's busiest trade routes, and enhancing New Delhi's leverage in the Indo-Pacific.

expected to be completed in five years, and the budget will be shared by both the defence ministry and the ministry of civil aviation," a source in the defence ministry said.

The Great Nicobar Islands development project is central to India's maritime strategy. Situated just 40 nautical miles from international shipping lanes, the island provides a vantage point over the Strait of Malacca.

By establishing an international airport with a naval enclave, India is effectively creating a forward operating base that will expand surveillance reach across critical chokepoints like the Malacca, Sunda and Lombok straits.

This dual-use infrastructure, jointly funded by the defence ministry and the ministry of civil aviation, is expected to be completed in five years, reflecting a long-term

vision of integrating economic and military objectives.

Economically, the project includes plans for a trans-shipment hub at Galathea Bay under the Maritime India Vision 2030.

This will reduce India's dependence on foreign ports such as Colombo, Dubai and Singapore, saving millions in foreign exchange while positioning India as a key player in global

## Tiny Lives, Big Miracles: Rare newborn surgeries highlight super-specialist expertise at GB Pant Hospital

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 9 In a significant boost to healthcare in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, GB Pant Hospital, Sri Vijaya Puram, has successfully carried out two highly complex, life-saving surgeries on newborn babies, demonstrating the critical importance of having advanced super-specialist surgical expertise available locally.

A one-day-old newborn was diagnosed with ileal atresia (Type 3b), a rare condition where a portion of the intestine is absent or blocked, making survival without immediate surgery. Acting swiftly, the surgical team performed an emergency laparotomy. Super Specialist Surgeon Prof. Dr. Saji Vargheese, Consultant Minimal Access Surgeon, and Dr. Anis Akhtarkhavari, Super Specialist Paediatric Surgeon undertook the complex procedure of removing the affected segment of the intestine and reconnecting the healthy ends. The surgery, supported by Dr. Narayan and his anesthesia team, was

successfully completed, and the newborn was managed postoperatively by the PICU team, ensuring a safe recovery. Another extraordinary case, a 12-day-old baby girl underwent a rare and delicate brain surgery (Contd. on last page)



## Unified Consent & Authorisation Management System (UCAMS) Portal launched

Industrial units, entrepreneurs & stakeholders urged to submit applications for grant or renewal of CTE, CTO & various authorisations through online

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 9 The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (M o E F & C C), Government of India, vide Gazette Notification No. G.S.R. 85(E) dated 30-01-2025 and G.S.R. 84(E) dated 29-01-2025, notified the Control of Water Pollution (Grant, Refusal or Cancellation of Consent) Guidelines, 2025 and the Control of Air Pollution (Grant, Refusal or Cancellation of Consent) Guidelines, 2025. The notifications, directed the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), in consultation

with the State Pollution Control Boards and Pollution Control Committees, to develop a unified online portal for processing applications under these guidelines.

Accordingly, the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), New Delhi, has developed the Unified Consent and Authorisation Management System (UCAMS) Portal for online processing and grant of Consent to Establish (CTE), Consent to Operate (CTO), and various Authorisations under

the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, and the Rules framed under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

The UCAMS Portal was officially launched for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands on June 5, 2026 by the Member Secretary, Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC)-cum-Director (Science & Technology).

All industrial units, project proponents, entrepreneurs, and other stakeholders have

been informed that, henceforth, applications for grant or renewal of Consent to Establish (CTE), Consent to Operate (CTO), and various Authorisations shall be submitted online through the UCAMS Portal only. The UCAMS Portal can be accessed at (<https://ucams.cpcb.gov.in>).

for subdural hemorrhage, a condition involving bleeding around the brain. Detected during pregnancy through ultrasound, the diagnosis allowed early planning, but it was the timely surgical intervention after birth that proved decisive.

The baby was delivered safely by Lower Segment Caesarean Section (LSCS) by the gynecology team led by Dr. MK Saha and was stabilized in the NICU under Dr. Pragatheesh and his team. However, doctors recognized that without precise and timely surgery, the child's chances of survival would be extremely limited. Paediatric surgical opinion was sought for the child.

At just 12 days of life, the newborn



underwent a highly delicate neurosurgical procedure performed by Super Specialist Surgeon Prof. Dr. Saji Vargheese, Consultant Minimal Access Surgeon, and Dr. Anis Akhtarkhavari, Super Specialist Paediatric Surgeon. With essential anesthesia support from Dr. Narayan and his team, the surgery was carried out with exceptional precision. This critical intervention became the turning point in the child's recovery, and she was later discharged in stable condition. These cases clearly demonstrate that the presence of super-specialist surgical expertise can make the difference between life and death, especially in critically ill newborns," Doctors noted.

The successful outcomes of both cases underline the exceptional skill, dedication, and coordination of the teams at GB Pant Hospital. More importantly, they mark a turning point for healthcare in the islands-showing that families no longer need to travel to mainland India for many complex paediatric surgical conditions, a press release from DHS said.

**PM-KISAN beneficiaries urged to complete annual biometric e-KYC by June 30**

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 9

The Department of Agriculture has urged that all beneficiaries under the Central Sector Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) must complete their Annual Biometric e-KYC for the financial year 2026-27 to continue receiving benefits. The Government of India has mandated the completion of Annual e-KYC for all PM-KISAN beneficiaries. The beneficiaries who have already completed e-

KYC earlier are also required to complete the annual e-KYC process afresh for 2026-27.

Under PM-KISAN, eligible farmer families receive financial assistance of Rs. 6,000 per year, disbursed in three equal installments of Rs. 2,000 every four months. Till date, the Government of India has successfully released 22 installments to farmers across the country. The deadline for completion of e-KYC

process is June 30, 2026, failing which beneficiaries may not receive the forthcoming installment for the period from April-July 2026.

Farmers can complete the process at their nearest Common Service Centres (CSCs) or Agriculture Office. For any assistance, beneficiaries are advised to contact the respective offices promptly, a press release from Department of Agriculture said.

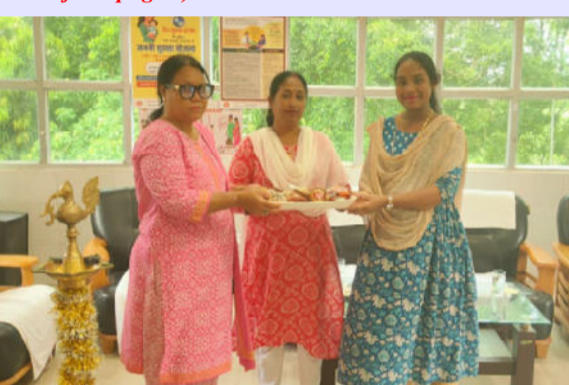
