## NEET: President gives nod for uniform admission test to medical, dental courses

New Delhi, Aug 9  
There will be single test-National Eligibility cum Entrance Exam (NEET) for admissions to medical and dental courses across the country, as President Shri Pranab Mukherjee has given nod to two bills recently passed by Parliament in this regard. Shri Mukherjee has given assent to Indian Medical Council Amendment Bill 2016 and Dentists Amendment Bill 2016.

These Bills were passed by Rajya Sabha on 1st of this month to pave way for the NEET, which is designed to curb corruption by bringing in transparency, checking multiplicity of exams and to stop exploitation of students in counselling. The bills seek to amend the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the Dentists Act, 1948 to replace the ordinances that were promulgated in May to

keep state boards out of the ambit of National Eligibility Entrance Examination, NEET for admission to MBBS and BDS courses for this year. The Bills provide for conduct of uniform entrance examination for admission to all medical educational institutions at the undergraduate and post-graduate courses. These Bills were passed by the Lok Sabha last month.

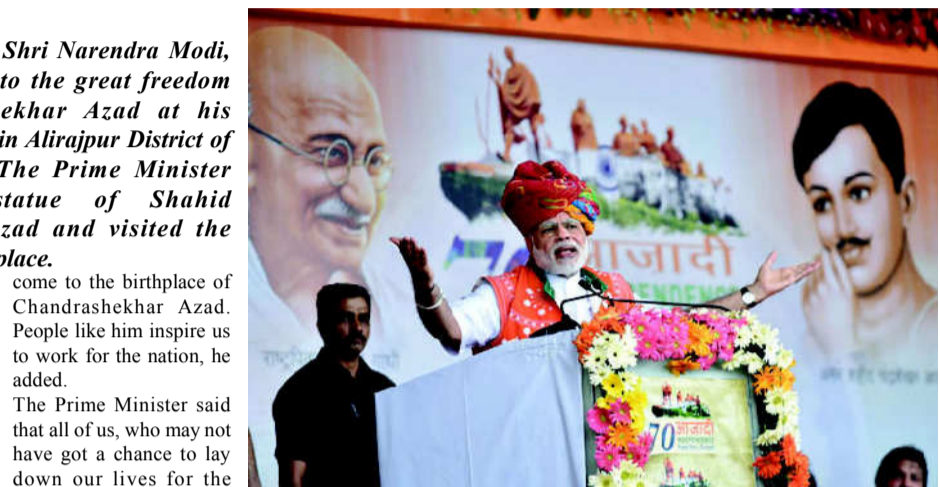

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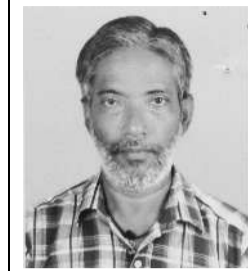

The CMD informed that the projects being undertaken by BSNL in A & N Islands include augmentation of satellite bandwidth in A & N Islands (USOF funded project), augmentation of Inter Island OFC Network in A & N Islands (USOF Funded Project), submarine cable connectivity from Chennai to Port Blair and for other Islands in ANI, 2G GSM coverage for uncovered villages, augmentation of GSM Network and NOFN Project- 69 GPs are to be connected under NOFN Projects. Total 66kms of OFC is to be laid. Tenders could not be materialised due to high rates and fresh tenders are yet to be floated, he informed. Further, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Member of Parliament requested CMD to visit Andaman & Nicobar Islands soon, so that the projects are implemented at faster pace, a communication from the Office of the MP said.
