



President presents 'Vayoshreshtha Samman' to senior citizens

New Delhi, Oct 9
The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, presented the Vayoshreshtha Samman - a scheme of National Awards for senior citizens at a function held in New Delhi today. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that there is a healthy tradition of respecting and taking care of elders in our country. He added, according to the last census, the population of senior citizens in our country was approximately 10.5 crore, which was about 8.5% of our total population. The average life expectancy has increased in recent decades due to improvement in health services and other reasons. It is estimated that by the



year 2050, the number of senior citizens will be approximately 19% of our total population. The President said that he was happy to note that the Government of India has taken several steps for the welfare of elderly persons. These include the National Programme for Healthcare

of the Elderly wherein specialised services will be provided for their treatment. Under the National Health Insurance Scheme implemented with the help of State Governments, additional health insurance is being provided. Among the dignitaries present on the

occasion were Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot, Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment, Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar, Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment.

Status of energy sector in India highly uneven: Prime Minister

New Delhi, Oct 9
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said that the status of the energy sector in India is highly uneven and stressed on the need to develop energy infrastructure and access to energy in Eastern India. Interacting with CEOs and experts of oil and gas from across the world in New Delhi today, Shri Modi flagged the potential of biomass energy and also invited participation and joint ventures in coal gasification. He welcomed all possibilities for innovation and research in the oil and gas sector. He also



welcomed the suggestion made for a comprehensive energy policy. Prime Minister Shri Modi indicated that as India moves towards a cleaner and more fuel-efficient economy, its benefits should expand horizontally to all sections of the society and in particular to

the poorest. Later briefing media, NITI Aayog CEO Shri Amitabh Kant said many participants recommended the inclusion of oil and gas in the GST framework. He quoted the Prime Minister as saying that there is a need to talk to states over the issue. Shri Kant said,

the Prime Minister also focused on the use of biogas and underlined the importance of development in eastern India. He said, according to the experts, India can decrease the export of gas and oil by 10 percent by 2022 and can emerge as a strong oil and gas based economy.

Finance Ministry makes Aadhaar mandatory for small saving schemes

New Delhi, Oct 9
The government has made biometric identification Aadhaar mandatory for all Post Office deposits, Public Provident Fund, National Savings Certificate scheme and Kisan Vikas Patra. Finance Ministry has issued four separate Gazette notifications making Aadhaar mandatory for opening all Post Office deposit accounts, Public Provident Fund, National Savings Certificate scheme and Kisan Vikas Patra deposits. Existing depositors who have not provided Aadhaar number at the



time of application for such deposit shall submit his Aadhaar number to the post office savings bank or deposit office concerned, on or before December 31, 2017. The government has insisted on quoting Aadhaar for bank deposits, obtaining mobile phone and several other utilities to weed out benami deals and black money.

RBI to soon launch financial literacy drive in 9 states

New Delhi, Oct 9
The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is to launch a financial literacy drive in 80 blocks in nine states on pilot basis to educate people on e-transactions and insurance purchases. The pilot project, according to RBI will be commissioned in the 9 states of Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Odisha, Karnataka, Telangana, Andhra

Pradesh, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh by the 6 NGOs in collaboration with the sponsor banks. The aim of the CFL is to inculcate the habit of making a household budget and recording financial transactions, encourage transactions in savings accounts, and active saving by depositing in banks through fixed deposits and recurring deposits.

New Delhi, Oct 9
Women and Child Development Ministry is celebrating the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Week from today to 14th of this month. The theme of the week is - 'the daughters of New India'. States, Union Territories, Districts have undertaken several innovative initiatives to address the issue of declining child sex ratio and promote value of girl child. The collective and coordinated efforts undertaken at national,

state and districts level has been successful in establishing a substantial improvement in the number of girls being born in the target districts. Out of the total 161 districts where the BBBP programme is being implemented, an increasing trend in Sex Ratio at Birth is visible in 104 districts. The Women and Child Development Ministry now plans to extend this programme to all the districts of the country with focus on the 56 of the total 161 districts that have



shown a decline in Sex Ratio at Birth. This scheme is one of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's pet projects and was launched by him in January, 2015. It focuses on districts with the worst child sex ratio as per the 2011 Census.

SC bans sale of firecrackers in Delhi-NCR till 31st Oct

New Delhi, Oct 9
The Supreme Court today extended its order of last November banning the sale of firecrackers in Delhi-NCR till the 31st of this month. A bench headed by Justice A K Sikri said the apex court's September 12 order temporarily lifting the stay and permitting sale of firecrackers would be effective from November 1. With Diwali on the coming 19th, the order effectively means that no firecrackers will be available for purchase before the festival.



The top court, through the 2016 order, had suspended all licences which permit sale of fireworks, wholesale and retail within the territory of NCR. On September 12 this year, the apex court had temporarily lifted its earlier order and permitted sale of firecrackers. The apex court's verdict came on a plea

seeking restoration of last year order suspending all licences which permit sale of fireworks. Each year, the festival leaves the air in Delhi thick with deadly smog which led to breathlessness and lung difficulties. Last year, Diwali firecrackers pushed pollution level in the capital to a dangerous level.

India's Anupama Ramachandran wins World Open U-16 Snooker Ch'ship

St. Petersburg, Oct 9
India's Anupama Ramachandran has clinched the World Open Under-16 Snooker Championship title at St. Petersburg in Russia. In the girls category, second seed Anupama knocked out her compatriot and top seed

Keerthana Pandian 3-1 to become World Open Under-16 champion on Sunday. Earlier, she defeated Albina Leschuk of Belarus 3-0 in the semifinals and Aleksandra Riabinina of Russia in the quarterfinals with an identical 3-0 scoreline. Dylan Emery of

Wales has claimed the title in the boys category. Federation of Billiards Sports of Russia hosted this first ever World Open championships for Under-16 boys and girls. Total 73 cueists from across the world have participated in this championship.

Germany win historic 10th 2018 FIFA World Cup qualifier

Berlin, Oct 9
Midfielder Leon Goretzka netted twice as Germany routed Azerbaijan 5-1 on Sunday to make history with a perfect World Cup qualifying record of 10 wins in as many games. The reigning world champions had already sealed their ticket to Russia last Thursday with a 3-1 win over Northern Ireland and finished their qualifying campaign in Kaiserslautern with a 10th straight victory. This is the first

time Germany have qualified for a World Cup finals with a perfect record. Joachim Loew's side are only the second team to achieve the feat in a European qualifying campaign after Spain managed it on their way to winning the 2010 World Cup in South Africa. However, the comfortable win came at the cost of two centre-backs, as Bayern Munich's Niklas Sule and Arsenal's Shkodran Mustafi both limped off with first-half injuries.

they lost to Korean squad. India also took a bronze medal in the compound cadet women's event when Khushbu Dhayal, Sanchita Tiwari and Divya Dhawal defeated their opponents from Great Britain. The mixed team gold is India's fourth World Archery Champion title across all disciplines.
