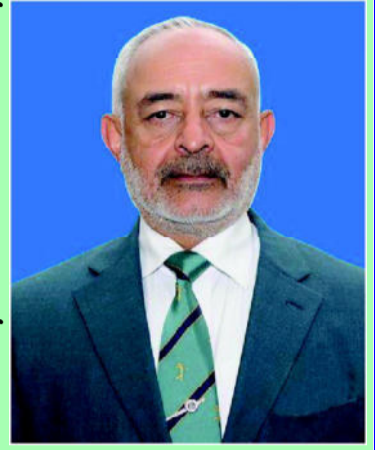

'One Nation One Ration Card' facilitating migrants with foodgrains at affordable rate

Port Blair, Oct. 9

The Government of India launched a landmark scheme 'One Nation One Ration Card' (ONORC) to facilitate migrants meeting their requirement of foodgrains at a very affordable rate. This scheme was implemented by the Central Government in a war footing manner in the wake of pandemic COVID-19 to avoid struggle of the socio-economically weaker migrant labourers to

meet both ends of their livelihoods. This UT Administration has taken relentless efforts, leaving no stone unturned to implement this scheme within the established time frame by the Central Government and made functional with effect from February 2021.

For effective implementation of this scheme, the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has launched

The Directorate of Agriculture is implementing a capacity for Central Sector Scheme RKVY-RAFTAAR under which a project namely 'Creation of Marketing Infrastructure' is undertaken for post harvest marketing support to farmers. Under the project,

52nd Annual General Meeting of ACCI held

Tourism potential in Isles needs to be optimally tapped by eliminating bottlenecks: CS

Upcoming projects in varied sectors will be a game changer for economic growth of the UT

Port Blair, Oct. 9

The 52nd Annual General Meeting of the Andaman Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ACCI) was held today at Hotel TSG Emerald View, Phoenix Bay. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS was the chief guest on the occasion.

Addressing the gathering, the Chief Secretary said, there is need to identify the sectors which have potential and which have not been able to contribute substantially. He mentioned that tourism potential in A&N Islands needs to be tapped optimally by removing the gaps in infrastructure, policies and future initiatives. Opining that one important factor in the development of tourism in the Islands is connectivity, the Chief Secretary said connectivity comes first and then infrastructure. He remarked that the Administration is in the process of finalizing the Yatch policy. On the disruption in flights due to maintenance of runway and high air fares, he stated that to address the



for which the NITI Aayog has identified some Islands which are being explored for setting up the infrastructure to bring these areas at par with some of the destinations which is globally recognized. RFP for these projects have been floated and the Administration is in constant touch with the investors, he said. To attract more foreign tourists, the Chief Secretary said that Administration is planning to provide e-visas. He also mentioned that the Administration is in the process of finalizing the Yatch policy. On the disruption in flights due to maintenance of runway and high air fares, he stated that to address the

concern, the Administration is in touch with Civil Aviation, Secretary, GOI and a meeting will be held soon with all the flight operators to impress upon them to increase the number of flights so that tourist as well as the Islanders are benefitted. The Chief Secretary disclosed that the Shibpur Airport at Diglipur will be expanded and once the project is completed, the flight operation in this sector will commence.

The Chief Secretary further stated that for the economic development, the Govt. of India has announced Great Nicobar Island projects. He said,

there are four components viz. International Container Transshipment Terminal (ICTT), new Green Field Airport, Power Plant and the township development. The Administration has already finalized the RFP for selection of consultant and preparation of master plan. He said, "We are close to Malacca Strait and the ICTT project will be a game changer for not only the Indian economy but also the economy of the A&N Islands. The coming up of this project will certainly witness a major boost not only in shipping related activities but also in other sectors, he said. By the year

2024, the entire project worth 74,000 crore would be launched in a record time, thereby boosting economy of A&N Islands, he remarked.

Apart from these projects, the Chief Secretary said, the fundamental sectors which need to be focused are water supply, power supply, sanitation and road connectivity. Regarding road connectivity, he said that he is in constant touch with the NH-4 construction agency and they have assured that by March next year, the entire NH-4 will be completed. In the power sector, the A&N Administration will bring a fair policy so that it contributes

efficiently. He said, a 50 MW Power Plant will come up at Hope Town, for which, NHPC has already floated tender and the construction work will start soon.

The Chief Secretary informed that fishery potential of the Islands needs to be tapped under various components of Blue Economy. He urged the ACCI to coordinate with the Fisheries Department so that entrepreneurs can take up the schemes to start their own ventures.

Earlier, welcoming the chief guest and others present on the occasion, the President, ACCI, Shri Surendra Prahladka

India successfully electrifies 95% of district hospitals: MoS Health

New Delhi, Oct. 9
Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare, Dr. Bharati Pravin Pawar said that India has successfully electrified 95 percent of district hospitals and around 90 percent of sub-divisional hospitals with a three-phased power supply.

She said, cumulatively, almost 75 percent of the health centres in the country have been electrified with a cumulative solar

capacity of 3.5 Mega Watt. Addressing the second meeting of the High-Level Coalition on Health and Energy yesterday virtually, Dr.Pawar highlighted Government of India's vision of attaining 450 Giga Watt of renewable energy generation by 2030. Dr. Pawar added that India is already ahead of pledged 33 percent in Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs). She said that the country has already achieved 39

percent of installed capacity from non-fossil-based sources and by 2022, it will reach the target of 40 percent.

She informed that India has attained Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) target 7.1 of providing universal access to affordable, reliable, and modern energy services by 2030 by improving the electrification of around hundred percent of the households. (Source: india.gov.in)

Pankaj Advani wins gold medal at IBSF World Billiards Championship in Kuala Lumpur

Kuala Lumpur, Oct. 9
In billiards, India's leading cueist, Pankaj Advani has claimed his 25th gold medal on the world stage, winning the 2022 IBSF World Billiards Championship in Kuala Lumpur yesterday.

He outclassed compatriot Sourav Kothari 4-0 in a one-sided final to defend the title for the fifth time in a row. Advani's last world



title came over 12 months ago in Qatar where he won the IBSF 6-Red Snooker World Cup. With 25 world titles, Advani has

extended his record-breaking success as India's winner of most gold medals in world championships across all sports.

Hockey India has announced the 18-member Indian Junior Men's Hockey Team for the upcoming Sultan of Johor Cup Malaysia 2022. It has been scheduled to begin on 22 October in Johor Bahru.

This year, the Indian team will take on Australia, Japan, South Africa, hosts Malaysia and defending champions Great Britain. The team had ended their

campaign with a Silver medal in the 2019 edition. The team will be captained by Uttam Singh. Bobby Singh Dhami has been named the Vice Captain of the team. Goalkeepers Mohith HS and Ankit Malik, defenders Amir Ali, Shardanand Tiwari, Rohit, Amandeep Lakra, Cyril Lugun, midfielders Vishnukant Singh, Rajinder Singh, Ankit Pal, Poovanna

CB, Amandeep and Johnson Purthy have been selected.

India will face Malaysia on the opening day on 22 October followed by their game against South Africa on 23rd October. Later, India will take on Japan on 25 October followed by a match against Australia on 26. They will take on Great Britain on 28th October while the finals will be held on 29 October.
