Strengthening Health Care Delivery System in Isles

40% of construction work for up-gradation of PHC Garacharma to District Hospital completed

Exclusive 10-bedded Geriatric Ward to provide comprehensive health care to ageing

Port Blair, Nov. 9

Health care service delivery system in A&N Islands is being strengthened with a vision to provide better health care services to the people. Towards achieving this, the A&N Administration has upgraded the existing Primary Health Centre (PHC) at Garacharma into District Hospital. Despite COVID-19 pandemic, the construction work of the District Hospital is progressing steadily and about 40% of the construction work has already been completed. The 1st phase of building is expected to be completed by March, 2021. With the up gradation of PHC, Garacharma, the number of patients visiting/availing services at GB Pant will reduce, thereby enabling the hospital to provide quality health care services to the people visiting GB Pant. Garacharma which is centrally



located can easily cover all the segments of South Andaman District viz. Garacharma, Rangachang, Prothrapur, Calicut, Birdline, Dollygunj, Brichgunj, Sippighat, Bathubasti and also areas like Chouldari, Port Mout, Manglutan, Tushnabad, Ferrargunj and Bambooflat etc. The people of these areas will be immensely benefitted as they need not come all the way to GB Pant Hospital for treatment. The upcoming District Hospital at Garacharma will have the

facilities like Emergency Operation Theatre, Accident and Trauma Ward, Critical Care Ward, Antenatal and Postnatal Wards, Labour Room and Ward (as per LaQshya guidelines of GOI), Male, Female and Children Wards, Surgical Wards, Laboratory, Blood Bank, Pharmacy, Ultra Sonography facilities, Specialist services and AYUSH Unit.

Apart from this, to provide accessible, affordable, high quality, long term, comprehensive and dedicated health care services to the ageing population, a 10-bedded Geriatric Ward will also be set up in the proposed District Hospital.

Further, for proper disposal of bio-medical waste, a new 100 kilo per hour incinerator will also be installed at the District Hospital, Garacharma. The civil work is nearing completion and the

Subsidy for purchase of motorized fishing boats 50% for fishers/unemployed youths & 75% for Tribes/ Tribal Cooperative Society

Condemnation and disposal of old & unused vessels - a key focus area for A&N Administration to De-clutter Port Area

Eight out of fourteen vessels approved for decommissioning auctioned Proposal to decommission MV Nicobar & MV Nancowry in process

Port Blair, Nov. 9

Old and unused vessels anchored in the port area not only pose a threat to safe navigation within the harbour but also give a shabby look to the port premises. Timely condemnation and disposal of the ships and vessels is therefore an important function of any port/ship operating agency. This not only helps to maintain a clean and lean inventory for the ship owners but also ensures neat and ship safe port



premises. Further, the proceeds accruing out of the disposal of condemned vessels are available to the ship owners for re-investment.

With an aim to de-clutter the port premises, the A&N Administration in the recent past had taken up condemnation/ disposal of old and unused vessels both belonging to the Government and Private Owners as a key focus area. The entire process of condemnation and disposal of Government vessels was put on fast



track. Additionally, the private owners were directed to clear/ dispose of the old vessels/ wrecks belonging to them in an expeditious manner. The results of the efforts made by the A&N Administration on this front have now started showing positive results.

In the last few months, a total of 14 IV vessels belonging to the Directorate of Shipping Services have been approved for condemnation after following all the laid down procedures.

Further, six more IV vessels belonging to the DSS are being presently progressed for decommissioning/ condemnation. In addition, the A&N Administration has also taken up a proposal to decommission two of the existing Mainland bound vessels namely MV Nicobar and MV Nancowry with GoI. This proposal is in an advanced stage of approval.

Conviction under POC SO Act

Special Judge (POCSO) convicts one for committing sexual assault on minor girl

The Hon'ble Special Judge (POCSO), Shri Raju Mukherjee convicted one accused person namely Kalyan Bhagwar, resident of Swaraj Dweep under POC SO Act for committing sexual assault against one

minor girl aged about 5 years on 21st of last month. The case was initiated on the basis of the statement given by the victim girl, aged about 5 years. It was averred that the victim girl was a student of KG-II in a local school at Swaraj

Dweep used to board a STS bus to attend her school on a daily basis. On 12.03.2015, the complainant was waiting along with her daughter to board the subject bus towards school. On arrival, the victim girl refused to

board the bus and when asked she started crying and told her that the conductor to whom she described as "ticket katnewala uncle" used to force her to sit on his lap and sexually assault her. On 11.03.2015, the conductor repeated the same and asked her not to disclose the same to anybody. She further stated that everyday she used to get her daughter to board the bus and yesterday also she went along with her daughter to find one Kalyan Bhagwar, R/o Swaraj Dweep who was on duty as conductor of the bus. On the basis of the complaint, Swaraj Dweep PS crime case No. 10 of 2015 dated 12.03.2015 was initiated u/s 345 I.P.C r.w.s. 10 of POCSO Act, 2012. After completion of the investigation charge sheet being No. 11/2015 dated 20.04.2015, the prosecution examined vital witnesses and after conclusion of trial, the Hon'ble Court found that the victim was subjected to sexual assault on repeated occasion by the convict who happened to be conductor of her school bus.

The victim was aged about 5 years at the time of such offence. The convict has committed such a heinous offence on a regular basis without having any sense of remorse. Such incident said to have changed her outlook towards society. Hence, the Hon'ble Court of Special Judge (POCSO) finds it appropriate to sentence him to suffer 5 years of rigorous imprisonment and fine of Rs. 5,000/- in default of payment of such fine further one year of imprisonment. The trial was conducted by Ms. A.S. Zinu, Special Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State, a press release said.

Health Minister reviews COVID and public health measures with State Health Ministers

New Delhi, Nov. 9 (PIB) Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare today interacted with the State Health Ministers and Principal Secretaries/ Additional Chief Secretaries of 9 states. Dr. Harsh Vardhan reminded everyone that the country had stepped into the 11th month of the pandemic with the first meeting on COVID being held on 8th of January. Restating his concern that the coming winter and the long festive season pose a significant risk that could threaten the gains made collectively till now against COVID-19, he said, "We all need to be more vigilant for the entire festive season that started with Dussehra and would continue on to Diwali, Chhat Puja, Christmas and then on to Makar Sankranti in next year. Respiratory virus also spreads rapidly in the winter months."

BSNL network affected at some places due to OFC cuts by private TSP

Due to indiscriminate and careless underground digging operations carried out by this TSP, the underground OFC cables have been severed at more than six places in and around Port Blair, within the last fortnight, by the contractors of the TSP.

BSNL had cautioned them on several occasions to be careful in their activities, but to no avail. This has affected vital links to Defence Units, A & N Command, Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Secretariat, Airport, Hospitals, Banks as well as institutes in their carelessness, before undertaking any more digging. FASTags to be mandatory for all 4-wheelers from 1st January, 2021

New Delhi, Nov. 9 Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has issued a notification making FASTags mandatory for all four wheel vehicles from 1st January next year. As per Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, the FASTag had been made mandatory for all registration of new four wheeled Vehicles since 1st December, 2017 and is being supplied by the Vehicle Manufacturer or their dealers. It had further been mandated that the renewal of fitness

certificate will be done only after the fitment of FASTag for the Transport Vehicles. For National Permit Vehicles the fitment of FASTag has been mandated since 1st of October, 2019. A valid FASTag is also mandatory while getting a new third Party Insurance through an amendment in certificate of Insurance, wherein the details of FASTag ID will be captured. This will be applicable with effect from 1st of April, 2021. (Source: india.gov.in)

2014) and Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 (amended upto 2019), it is obligatory on the part of establishments having a manpower strength (including contractual employees) of 30 or more to engage number of apprentices in a band of 2.5% to 15% of its total manpower strength including the contractual staff in each financial year. Similarly, if an organization/establishment is having a manpower strength of 100, the apprentices seats will be 15. A large number of training facilities available in the industry and organization are unutilized depriving unemployed youth to avail the benefits of the Apprentices Training Scheme.

In view of this, Establishments have been advised to utilize the training resources and extend job role training under Apprentices Training Scheme. Non compliance of Section 30 of the Apprentice Act 1961(amended upto 2014) will attract penalty and is punishable with fine of Rs. 500 per shortfall of apprenticeship per month for first three months and thereafter Rs. 1000 per month till such number of seats are filled up.

Under National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS), the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) Govt. of India will provide financial support to the industry undertaking apprenticeship programme under the Apprentice Act, 1961 and sharing of 25% of prescribed stipend.
