PM reviews status of COVID-19 & preparedness for vaccination

Vaccination drive to kick off on 16th January; priority will be given to healthcare & frontline workers

New Delhi, Jan. 9 (PIB)

The Prime Minister chaired a high-level meeting to review the status of COVID-19 in the country along with the preparedness of the State/UTs for COVID vaccination today. The Prime Minister took a detailed and comprehensive review of status of COVID management covering various issues. Emergency Use Authorisation or Accelerated Approval has been granted by the National Regulator for two vaccines (Covishield and Covaxin) which have established safety & immunogenicity.

The PM was also briefed about the preparedness status of the Centre in close collaboration with the State and UT Governments for roll out of the vaccine in the near future. The vaccination exercise is underpinned by the principles of people's participation (Jan Bhagidari); utilizing

experience of elections (booth strategy) and Universal Immunization Program (UIP); no compromise of existing healthcare services, especially national programs and primary health care; no compromise on scientific and regulatory norms, other SOPs; and an orderly and smooth implementation driven by technology. The roll-out of COVID-19 vaccine will provide priority to the

healthcare workers and the frontline workers who are estimated to be around 3 cr, followed by those above 50 years of age and the under-50 population groups with co-morbidities numbering around 27 cr.

The Prime Minister was also apprised about the Co-WIN Vaccine Delivery Management System. The unique digital platform will

India registers unprecedented hike in Testing with more than 18 cr tests A&N Islands one among 15 States/UTs with Positivity Rate less than National Average

New Delhi/Port Blair, Jan 9

A total of 15 States and Union Territories have a cumulative COVID-19 positivity rate below the national average of 5.79 per cent with Bihar having the lowest positivity rate of 1.44 per cent, the Health Ministry said. Over 18 crore total COVID-19 tests have been conducted in the country till date with over 9 lakh tests in the past 24 hours alone, the Health Ministry said in a statement.

The 15 States and UTs are Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Mizoram, Jharkhand, Gujarat, Daman and Diu, Assam, Punjab, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Odisha, Telangana, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya and Jammu and Kashmir.

It is noteworthy to see the A&N Islands featuring among those States and UTs having the lowest positivity rate as compared to the national average of the country. In A&N Islands, as on Jan 9, the positivity rate stands at 2.58 %. The significant reduction in positive cases has been made achievable by the A&N Administration through its relentless efforts in containing the spread of the virus in the Islands by implementing various directives of GoI and safety measures in letter and spirit.

The Health Ministry has also stated that India's Tests per Million (TPM) stands at 1,30,618.3. "With the increase in testing infrastructure, the TPM has also increased exponentially." Here too, A&N Island has made remarkable progress with 4,81,400 rate of Testing Per Million being conducted in the Islands till date which is also above the national average.

Consequent upon declaring part of Hut Bay village as Micro Containment zone, to take first hand stock of the ground situation and arrangements required to be made and for better preparedness in the fight against COVID-19, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner (SA) led a team of officials comprising of Shri Ravi Kumar Singh, SP (SA), Dr. Omkar Singh, DHS, Shri Yash Chaudhary, ADM, Shri Prem Singh Meena, AC(S) and Shri Lakshay Singhal, AC(UT) visited Little Andaman.

The team inspected PHC Hutbay, RK Pur and Health and Wellness Centre at Harminder Bay. During the visit, they



interacted with Medical Officer (i/c), staff nurse and the field staff. Further, the team also visited the COVID Care Centre and interacted with Doctors on duty and also with patients. Issues regarding food and water have been resolved and the patients have been assured of timely treatment and prompt action from the District Administration. Directions were issued to streamline field surveillance from door to door with special focus on co-morbid persons and it was reiterated that immediate delivery of medicine at homes of ILI suspects may be taken up on priority. The DC (SA) directed the officials for strict enforcement of COVID-19 protocols and to urge the people to avoid unnecessary travel.

The team also interacted with ex-

PRIs/PRIs, public and urged them for mobilization of volunteers for effective fight against COVID -19 pandemic.

The District Administration, South Andaman has further posted Shri Lakshay Singhal, AC (UT) as Tehsildar, Little Andaman and will be stationed there till the situation returns to normalcy. He would take stock of the arrangements required to be made in COVID Care Centres and also local issues, if any.

The Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs, A&N Administration continuing its commitment towards 'Zero Waste Andamans' today dedicated three more Solid Waste Management (SWM) Clusters at Shorepoint, Mannarghat and Wandoor for the scientific Solid Waste Management in the Islands. The SWM Clusters were inaugurated by Shri Abhishek Dev, Secretary (RD/Panchayat) in the presence of Shri Vinay Kumar Jindal, Director (RD/Panchayat).

These SWM Clusters have been constructed under the GoI scheme - Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) with an objective to achieve ODF+ status. The focus

under the scheme is not only to ensure sustainability of the ODF status achieved by the UT on 02.09.2018 but to march one step ahead and ensure that the Solid and Liquid Waste generated in rural areas of the Islands is scientifically treated.

The Gram Panchayats in the Islands have already started source level segregated collection of waste from households and market places. The wet waste collected shall be converted to organic manure through windrow composting which shall be then packaged and sold on nominal price basis. The dry waste shall be bailed and transported out of the Islands through authorized recyclers.

The hazardous waste collected

shall be incinerated in the SWM Cluster using the Napkin Incinerator installed at these sites.

The Secretary (RD) on the occasion exhorted for better upkeep of the asset and requested all to coordinate and support the Gram Panchayats in this noble initiative of making 'Waste Free Islands', a press release from Directorate of Rural Development said.

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Implementation of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana by Social Welfare Deptt. Cash incentive amounting to Rs. 252.59 Lakh disbursed to 5461 beneficiaries in Isles

Port Blair, Jan. 9

The Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) is a maternity benefit program being implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development since 2017. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme for pregnant and lactating women of 19 years of age or above for the first live birth. The objective of the Yojana is to provide partial compensation for the wage loss in terms of cash incentives so that the woman can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first living child and the incentive provided would lead to improved health seeking behaviour amongst the Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers (PW&LM).

The Social Welfare Department, A&N Administration is instrumental in implementing the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana in these



Islands. The number of beneficiaries' enrolled (till date) stands at 5575 while the average beneficiaries enrolled in a month is 80. The number of beneficiaries enrolled (March 2020 - Dec 2020) stood at 810. Since inception of the scheme, an amount of Rs. 252.59 Lakh has been disbursed to 5461 beneficiaries so far in the Islands.

The targeted beneficiaries under this Yojana are all Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers, excluding PW&LM who are in regular

employment with the Central Government or the State Governments or PSUs or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force, all eligible Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers who have their pregnancy on or after 01.01.2017 for first child in family. The date and stage of pregnancy for a beneficiary would be counted with respect to her LMP date as mentioned in the MCP card.

The mother is entitled to a cash incentive of Rs. 5,000 in three installments. For institutional delivery, an additional amount of Rs. 700/- is released under Janani Suraksha Yojna to women who fall under BPL category. The cash incentive is directly released into the bank account of the beneficiary.

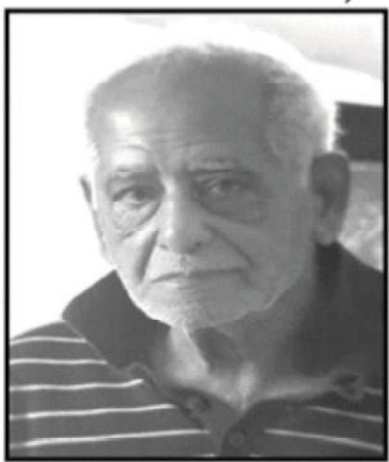

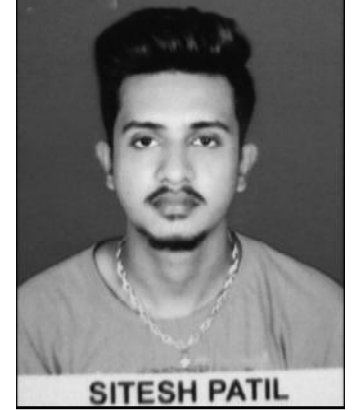

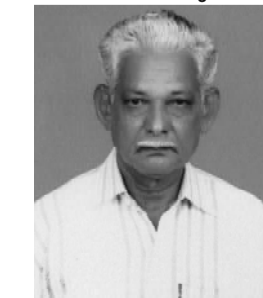
