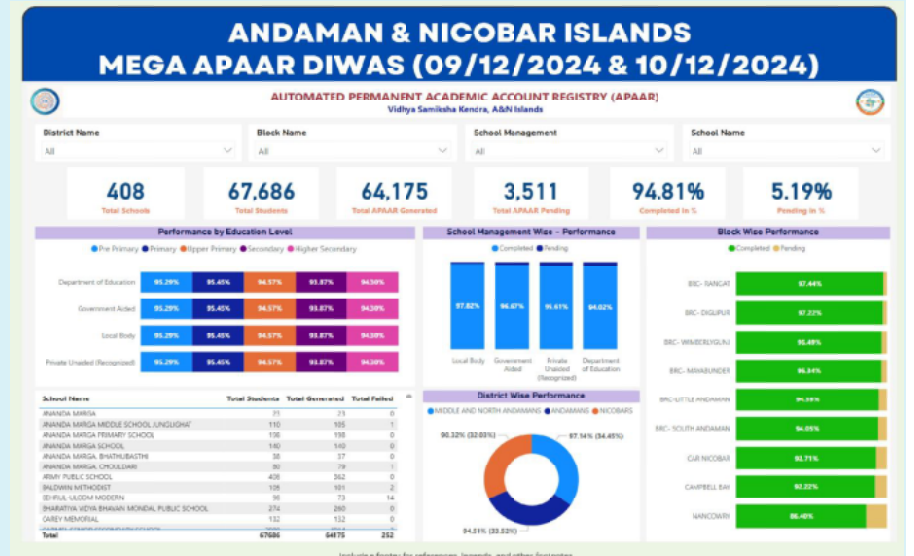

Training for Medical Officers on 'Revised Routine Immunization Handbook 2024' conducted

Parents can conveniently download the APAAR ID for their child using the Digilocker website (<https://digilocker.meriphechaan.gov.in/signin>) or through the Digilocker app by signing in with the student's Aadhaar number. Schools will soon begin distributing physical APAAR cards to students. Further information regarding card distribution will be communicated shortly.

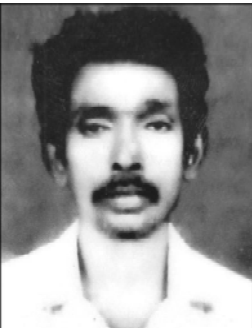
