## State Steering Committee meeting on COVID-19 vaccination held

# Chief Secretary directs to intensify contact tracing of all new positive cases

Second dose of vaccination to be administered from Feb. 13

About 10170 Frontline Workers to be vaccinated soon

Port Blair, Feb. 9

The State Steering Committee meeting on COVID-19 vaccination was held under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Shri Chetan B. Sanghi in the conference hall of Secretariat here today. The meeting was also attended by Shri Jitendra Narain, Principal Secretary (Home), Shri Vijay Kumar, Principal Secretary (Finance), Dr. V Candavelou, Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health), Shri S.K. Jain, IGP (Headquarter), Secretaries of A&N Administration,



Officials of Health Department and representative from Andaman Nicobar Command.

The meeting was aimed to assess the present situation of COVID-19 vaccination in A&N Islands and the future plan of action. During the meeting, it was informed that A&N Islands has completed about 74% of vaccination as on date and it was also decided to cover maximum Health Care Workers for vaccination in the coming week. There was no complication observed after the vaccination in these Islands and the second dose of COVID-19 vaccination for the Health Care Workers will be administered from Feb.13, 2021. The Frontline Workers to be vaccinated soon are about 10170 in number across these Islands. Necessary arrangements have been made for receiving the awaiting vaccine consignment.

The Chief Secretary stated that the Defence may be facilitated for

their vaccination process, if needed. He also directed that the data of Frontline Workers must be cross verified for duplication of data by the respective Districts. Further, he directed to augment the vaccination process as soon as the vaccine consignment is received. The Chief Secretary also directed that the contact tracing must be enhanced for all the new positive cases so that the transmission can be halted, a press release from Directorate of Health Services said.

# Academic Cooperation between Andaman & Nicobar Administration and Indian Maritime University

Port Blair, Feb. 9

The A&N Administration has concluded an MOU with Indian Maritime University (IMU) by virtue of which both sides will extend their facilities to enhance academic cooperation between the two sides. The MOU would be in force for the next two years. As per the MOU, the IMU is to provide 7 vacancies earmarked for the students from the A&N Islands in various Maritime related courses being conducted by the university viz. B.Sc Nautical Science, B.Tech Marine Engineering, B.Tech Naval Architecture, BBA Logistic Retailing and E Commerce. The A&N

Administration in reciprocation shall provide 40 training slots for cadets from the IMU onboard the A&N Administration ships for conduct of sea training. The selection of candidates for the Maritime related courses above will be carried out through specially designed tests by DBRAIT, Port Blair. The MOU was initially concluded in the year 2016 for a period of 02 years as an initiative to enhance academic cooperation. The MOU has thereafter been renewed at intervals of two years and has been found to be useful to both sides.

In a judgement, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 13/11/2019 in Civil Appeal No.10044 of 2010 titled as Central Public Information Officer, Supreme Court of India

Vs. Subhash Chandra Agarwal, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in para no. 59 of the above referred case has defined 'personal information'. As per the judgment, personal records,

including name, address, physical and mental and psychological status, marks obtained, grades and answer sheets, are all treated as personal information. Similarly,

# Rehabilitation and up-gradation of NH-4 progressing smoothly

Road upto Chidiyatapu completed; marking & signages will be done in a month's time

Carriageway upto Kalara Junction (km 298) to be completed during this working season

Port Blair, Feb. 9

The Andaman Trunk Road (National Highway-4) is the lifeline of the people of the Islands connecting South Andaman to N&M Andaman District. To ensure hassle free travel through this carriageway, the National Highway Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (NHIDCL) has taken up the work of rehabilitation and upgradation of NH-4 in the year 2017.

The work for construction and upgradation of roads are progressing smoothly during this working season. In the last two months, the construction of roads has also picked up pace and the carriageway of the road upto Chidiyatapu has been completed. Disclosing about the progress of the work, the Executive Director, NHIDCL,



Shri Devendra Singh in a press release has stated that the marking and signages are to be placed and it will be done in a month's time. It is to mention that the journey upto Jirkatang has also become comfortable as the road has been completed upto CTB level and the bituminous work on this stretch will also be completed during this working season, he added.

He further informed that apart from the construction of roads in South Andaman, the road construction in North & Middle Andaman has also picked up pace and almost 30 kms of DBM equivalent roads have been constructed during the last two months.

If things go as per the plan, atleast the carriageway upto

Kalara Junction (km 298) on NH-4 will be completed in this working season, the ED stated adding that this will provide a smooth ride to the local population and some remaining auxiliary works will also be completed in due course.

The road is being constructed by using chemical stabilization procedure which is beneficial for Isles' ecosystem thereby reducing the dependency on aggregates. It may be recalled that Andaman is the first UT where NHIDCL has started constructing roads using the soil stabilization technique. This pavement design was approved by CRRI (Central Road Research Institute) and is being constructed mainly in central and North Andamans.

## Sustainable development of fisheries sector in A&N Islands through PMMSY

Interested persons urged to submit project proposals to Zonal Fisheries Offices

Port Blair, Feb. 9

The Govt. of India, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying has launched the flagship scheme 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)' to address critical gaps in fish production and productivity, quality, technology, traceability, post harvest infrastructure and management. PMMSY also envisages creation of a conducive environment for private sector participation, development of entrepreneurship, promotion of ease of doing business, innovations and innovative projects including startups, incubators etc in fisheries sector. Accordingly, the Government of India, Ministry of Fisheries has formulated detailed guidelines on entrepreneur model in fisheries and aquaculture. The objective of entrepreneurship model are to attract private investment, foster linkages among producers, aggregators, processors and exporters, generate

sustainable employment and livelihood of opportunities besides creation of ecosystem for growth of entrepreneurship in fisheries and aquaculture.

The beneficiaries eligible under entrepreneurship model are individual, entrepreneurs and private firms; fishers, fish farmers, fish workers and fish vendors and Self Help Groups (SHGs)/ Fisher Cooperatives/Joint Liability Group/Fish Farmer Producer Organizations (FFPOs)/ Companies.

The broad requirements of the scheme are applicants/beneficiaries should possess own land with clear title free from all encumbrances for the implementation of the projects; the applicant shall have necessary clearance/permission etc from concerned local authorities wherever applicable as per project requirements; the applicant should

## A&N Police adopts 'Zero Tolerance' against drug peddlers

Freezes immovable property, bank accounts & seizes 4 vehicles of drug peddler Mohammed Sultan

Port Blair, Feb. 9

In a first-of-its-kind case in the Islands, A&N Police has frozen immovable property, bank accounts and seized 4 vehicles of drug peddler Mohammed Sultan, R/o Garacharma. He was arrested on 22/10/2020 by Police Station Central Crime Station with 13.320 Kgs of Ganja. Md. Sultan has amassed huge wealth through his career of crime. During



investigation by PS CCS the details of his illegally acquired properties were traced and identified. The investigation resulted in a Seizing/Freezing Order by the Station House Officer, PS as

regards to a land piece at Chouldhari, four vehicles and 4 bank accounts having significant deposits. Mohammed Sultan has been involved in 11 cases of drugs and other cases since 2008. The order was confirmed by the Competent Authority and Administrator, Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India, resulting in freezing of his immovable property and seizure of his movable properties including four nos. of super luxury Audi A4, Maruti Vitara Brezza, Maruti Ertiga VDI and Suzuki Access Moped. New Delhi, Feb. 9

The Government is not considering any proposal for dual citizenship in the country. In a written reply in the Lok Sabha today, Minister of State for Home Affairs, Shri Nityanand Rai said that a total of 1,36,441 people gave up Indian citizenship and took citizenship of other countries. He added that more than six lakh 76 thousand people gave up Indian citizenship during the period of 2015 to 2019. Shri Rai also said that more than 36 lakh 99 thousand foreigners registered as Overseas Citizenship of India cardholders during the past 15 years. **Empowering & instilling confidence among women**

**Nai Roshni- scheme for leadership development of minority women**

Port Blair, Feb.9

The Ministry of Minority Affairs, GoI is implementing Nai Roshni- the Scheme for Leadership Development of Minority Women. The target group includes women belonging to all minorities notified under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 viz. Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains. The objective of the scheme is to empower and instill confidence among minority women, including their neighbours from other communities living in the same village/locality, by providing knowledge tools and techniques for interacting with Government systems, banks and other institutions at all levels.

The leadership development training scheme shall be implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs through selected organizations. The selected organizations should implement the project directly through their organizational set-up in the locality/village/area. The Central Government and UT Administration training institutes including universities and institutes of higher learning can also implement the scheme. Organizations which would be eligible for applying for financial assistance under this scheme are Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860; a public Trust registered under any law for the time being in force, a private limited non-profit company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act, 1956; Universities/ Institutions of higher learning recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), Training institutes of Central and State

Government/UT Administration including Panchayati Raj Training institutes and Duly registered Cooperative Societies of Women/ Self Help Groups.

The selected organization would have the responsibility to motivate, identify and select women to be trained in accordance with the criteria of the scheme from villages/urban localities having a substantial minority population. The organizations will involve Head of the Gram Panchayat/Municipal Body/Local Authority for identification/ selection of women trainees. The details of the trainees will be submitted by the organization before the start of training through the Online Application Management System (OAMS) for Nai Roshni, once the project is approved. Although there will be no annual income bar, a woman/parent or guardian of woman having annual income not exceeding Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources would be given preference in selection. They should be between the age group of 18 years to 65 years.

The proposal should be submitted in the prescribed format through Online Application Management System (OAMS). The link of OAMS is available on official website of Ministry of Minority Affairs i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. After filling up the complete proposal in the OAMS, a print of the same may be taken and submitted to the District Collector/ District Magistrate for their recommendation in the prescribed format. The detailed guidelines of the scheme are available on the website www.minorityaffairs.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

**India loses first cricket test to England by 227 runs in Chennai**

Chennai, Feb. 9

England have won the first Test against India by 227 runs at the MA Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai today. Chasing a 420-run target, India were bundled out for 192 runs in their second innings, as wickets fell like ninepins to some great reverse swing by James Anderson who took 3 wickets for 17 and fine spin bowling by Jack Leach who took 4 wickets for 76 runs.

To chase a 420-run target was highly improbable but given the resilience and fightback shown on the



recent tour of Australia, no one would have expected the Indians to be humbled this way on home soil. Virat Kohli scored 72 while Shubman Gill, scored a swashbuckling 50 gave some resistance to the visitors attack. Yesterday, England's second innings was wound up for 178 runs

as spinner R. Ashwin scalped six wickets while Shahbaz Nadeem claimed two wickets. Pacer duo Jasprit Bumrah and Ishant Sharma bagged one wicket each. The second test will be played at the MA Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai from February 13.

not have availed similar assistance/subsidy for any activity under entrepreneurs model or from any government schemes or government agency and assets created out of the assistance provided shall not be disposed off in any form by way of sale, gift, transfer and lease for a period of ten years from the date of sanction of project.

The funding pattern shall be upto 25% of the total project cost for General Category with a ceiling of Rs. 1.25 crores per project or upto 30% for SC/ST/Women with a ceiling of Rs. 1.50 crores per project; bank loan shall be upto 65% of the project cost for General Category and upto 60% of the project cost in case of SC/ST/Women; beneficiary contribution shall be minimum 10% of the project cost. Beneficiary may contribute higher margin money in lieu of loan which in any case shall not exceed 40% of the total project cost and the Government assistance shall be released in three installments to the beneficiaries loan account as milestone link backhanded subsidy in the ratio of 50:30 as per guidelines laid down by the Ministry.

The integration and packing of activities into entrepreneurship model is left to the applicant and some of the suggested entrepreneurship model are:

- Development of aquaculture Construction of pond with necessary electricity, water supply facilities, development of hatcheries for seed production, feed mill, quality testing labs, fish storage/preservation facilities (ice plant/cold storages), pre-processing facilities, fish transport facilities.
- Integrated fish farm: Establishment of RAS, Bio-floc, hatchery for seed requirement, feed mill, ice plant, cold storage, testing labs, fish transport facilities (insulated/refrigerated vehicles), kiosks etc.
- Cage cultivation: Establishment of cages, brood bank, feed mill, hatchery for seed, feed mill, disease management lab, value addition, branding and marketing etc.
- Seaweed Cultivation processing and marketing.
- Recreational fisheries with backward and forward integration/linkages.
- Promotion of domestic marketing of finfish, shell fish in rural and urban areas.
- Creation of post harvest infrastructure including cold chain and marketing.
- Any other model within the scope of PMMSY.

Interested applicants/beneficiaries have been requested to submit detailed project proposals to the nearest Zonal Fisheries Office where they intend to establish the business with broad outlines of the proposal and all relevant details. For further details of the scheme interested beneficiaries/applicants may contact the Directorate of Fisheries, Port Blair or Zonal Fisheries Offices at South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

professional records, including qualification, performance, evaluation reports, ACRs, disciplinary proceedings, etc. are all personal information. Medical records, treatment, choice of medicine, list of hospitals and doctors visited, findings recorded, including that of the family members, information relating to assets, liabilities, income tax returns, details of investments, lending and borrowing, etc. are personal information. Such personal information is entitled to protection from unwarranted invasion of privacy and conditional access is available when stipulation of larger public interest is satisfied. This list is indicative and not exhaustive, the Supreme Court observed.

In view of this, all the Heads of Department have been requested to bring it to the notice of all the Public Information Officers under their control, a press release from Assistant Secretary (AR & Trng.) said.


