ECI issues Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth

Polling in A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency will be held on April 19 from 7 am to 6 pm

Port Blair, Apr. 9

In order to uphold the integrity of the electoral process to achieve the predominant objective by ensuring level playing field towards conduct of free, fair, peaceful and inducement-free elections, the Election Commission of India has issued strict Poll Day instructions on movement of vehicles and prohibitions on canvassing near Polling Stations & Candidate Election Booth, which have

been summarised as under:

- Each contesting candidate, on the Poll Day will be entitled for one vehicle for his own use in respect of the entire constituency. In addition, one vehicle for use of his election agent is allowed. The Poll Day permission of respective vehicles to be displayed prominently on the wind-screen of the vehicles meticulously. Moreover, illegal hiring of vehicles for the conveyance of voters during Poll Day is a corrupt practise and an electoral offence, inviting strict action.
- More than 5 persons in a vehicle including driver is not allowed.
- Private vehicles utilised by owners for themselves/family members for going to Polling Booth to cast vote is allowed upto a radius of 200 meter of Polling Station.
- Act of canvassing for votes, soliciting the vote of an elector, persuading any elector not to vote for any particular candidate, persuading any elector not to vote at the

election, exhibiting any notice or sign relating to the election are strictly prohibited within 100 meters radius of the Polling Station.

➤ Candidate Election Booth is allowed to be set up beyond a distance of 200 meters from the Polling Station with one table and two chairs for the use of their agents/workers for distribution of unofficial identity slips to voters. Moreover, to protect from sun/rain, they may use an umbrella or a piece of tarpaulin over their head.

The electorate of A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to be informed voters and to contribute their share for upholding the democratic principles of free, fair and transparent elections. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency is on 19/04/2024 (Friday) and Hours of Poll is from 7 am to 6 pm, a Press Note received from RO, ANIPC said.

Alternative photo identity documents for establishing identity in lieu of EPIC notified

Port Blair, Apr. 9

In an effort to achieve 100% active participation of the electorate in the General Elections-2024, the Election Commission of India has taken special initiatives Vide Order No.3/4/ID/2024/SDR/Vol. I Dt. 19th March, 2024, to encourage the electorate to exercise their most basic democratic franchise. Those who are not able to produce the EPIC, shall produce one of the alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity viz. Aadhaar Card, MNREGA Job Card, Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office, Health Insurance Smart Card issued

under the scheme of Ministry of Labour, Driving License, PAN Card, Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR, Indian Passport, Pension document with photograph issued to employees by Central /State Govt./ PSUs/Public Limited Companies, Official Identity Cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs, and Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card, M/o Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. Moreover, the Commission has evolved specific modus operandi to facilitate and outreach the voters through distribution of Voter Information Slip through the Booth

Level Officer of respective Polling Station wherein the voters could easily know the serial number of electoral roll of his/her Polling Station, date of poll, time etc. However, Voter Information Slip will not be allowed as a proof to identify the voters.

The electorates under Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to cast their vote by exercising their most basic democratic right. The Date of Poll (Phase-I) in this constituency is on 19/04/2024 and Hours of Poll is from 7 am to 6 pm, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

Ban enacted under Representation of People Act, 1951 and other laws

N&M District Police conducts raids to combat illegal activities

Mayabunder, Apr. 9

The North & Middle Andaman District Police is steadfast in its commitment to maintaining the integrity of the electoral process in view of the forthcoming General Election - 2024. Vigilance measures have been intensified to ensure strict adherence to Model Code of Conduct.

In a series of proactive actions, the N&MA Police has conducted regular excise raids and jungle raids to crack down on any illegal activities that may undermine the

sanctity of the electoral process. These actions have led to significant results, such as the recent discovery and seizure of 110 bottles of IMFL by the PS Billiground team. After MCC, a total of 237 bottles of IMFL& 103.5 litres of illicit liquor have been confiscated from various locations, resulting in the registration of 50 cases under the Excise Regulation.

In another successful raid, PS Baratang seized 100 kg of illicit Handia, bringing the total amount seized to 154 kg since the commencement of MCC. These seizures demonstrate the

commitment of the N&MA Police to combat the illegal distribution of alcohol, which has the potential to influence voters and disrupt the electoral environment.

Furthermore, during jungle raids aimed at dismantling illegal operations, 2877 litres of lehan have been destroyed so far. Additionally, 98 bootleggers have been booked under 110(g) Cr. PC, further strengthening the efforts to eliminate sources of illegal liquor and maintain law and order in the region, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.

CCS seizes 515 grams of ganja; two persons arrested

In the midnight of April 6 & 7, 2024, acting on specific intelligence received from a reliable source, a police team comprising of Inspector Girish Kumar, SHO, PS Central Crime Station (CCS), Sub-Inspector Parvash, Head Constable Sanjit Madhu, Sanjay Kujur, Venkateshwar Rao, Shibani Biswas, Constables K. Rajendran and N. Thangaraj of CCS Police Station led by Shri Kumar Abhishek, Dy.SP (CID), conducted a raid in Tushnabad. During the operation, the team seized 405 grams of Ganja from

the possession of one Vishal Singh, S/o Shri Sikander Singh, R/o Tushnabad. Vishal Singh was promptly arrested on the spot following the due legal procedure. The raid was conducted under overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID). Accused Vishal is a habitual offender with previous involvement in five cases.

A case under relevant sections of NDPS Act-1985 has been registered at PS CCS and investigation is in progress. During investigation accused Vishal was put under sustained joint interrogation and on his disclosure co-

accused R. Thiru Murugan, S/o Late V. Rajendran, R/o Calicut was arrested on 08/04/2024 and recovered 110 grams of ganja from his possession. Further investigation is going on.

ORDER

- Whereas, Section 61 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides that with a view to preventing personation of electors, so as to make the right of genuine electors to vote under section 62 of that Act more effective, provisions may be made by rules under that Act for use of Electors Photo Identity Card for electors as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling; and
- Whereas, Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, empowers the Election Commission to direct, with a view to preventing personation of electors and facilitating their identification at the time of poll, issue of Electors Photo Identity Card to electors bearing their photographs at State cost; and
- Whereas, Rules 49H (3) and 49K (2) (b) of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, stipulate that where the electors of a constituency have been supplied with Electors' Photo Identity Card under the said provisions of Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, the electors shall produce their Elector Photo Identity Card at the polling station and failure or refusal on their part to produce those Elector Photo Identity Card may result in the denial of permission to vote; and
- Whereas, a combined and harmonious reading of the aforesaid provisions of the said Act and the Rules, makes it clear that although the right to vote arises by the existence of the name in the electoral roll, it is also dependent upon the use of the Elector Photo Identity Card, where provided by the Election Commission at State cost, as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling and that both are to be used together; and
- Whereas, the Election Commission made an Order on the 28th August, 1993, directing the issue of Electors' Photo Identity Card (EPIC) to all electors, according to a time bound programme; and
- Whereas, Electors' Photo Identity Card have been issued to approximate 100% electors in the country, and
- Now, therefore, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal and factual position, the Election Commission hereby directs that for the **current General Election to the Lok Sabha and Legislative Assemblies of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Odisha & Sikkim, 2024 and Bye-elections to 26 Assembly Constituencies in 13 States (as per Annexure-I) to be notified on 20.03.2024, 28.03.2024, 12.04.2024, 18.04.2024, 26.04.2024, 29.04.2024, 07.05.2024** all electors who have been issued EPIC are expected to produce the EPIC for their identification at the polling stations before casting their votes. Those electors who are not able to produce the EPIC shall produce one of the following alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity: -
 - Aadhaar Card,
 - MNREGA Job Card,
 - Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office,
 - Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour,
 - Driving License,
 - PAN Card,
 - Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR,
 - Indian Passport,
 - Pension document with photograph,
 - Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt./PSUs/ Public Limited Companies,
 - Official identity cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs, and
 - Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card, M/o Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India
- In the case of EPIC, clerical errors, spelling mistakes, etc. should be ignored provided the identity of the elector can be established by the EPIC. If an elector produces an EPIC which has been issued by the Electoral Registration Officer of another Assembly Constituency, such EPIC shall also be accepted for identification provided that the name of that elector finds place in the electoral roll pertaining to the polling station where the elector has turned up for voting. If it is not possible to establish the identity of the elector on account of mismatch of photograph, etc. the elector shall have to produce one of the alternative photo documents mentioned in Para 7 above.
- Notwithstanding anything in Para 7 above, overseas electors who are registered in the electoral roll under Section 20A of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, based on the particulars in their Indian Passport, shall be identified on the basis of their original passport only (and no other identity document) at the polling station.

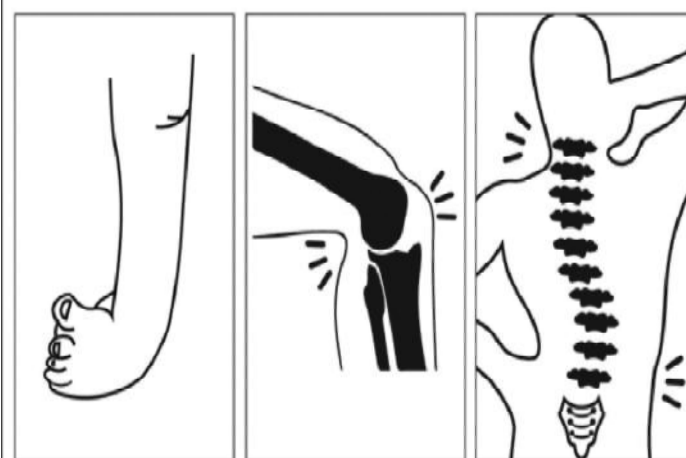

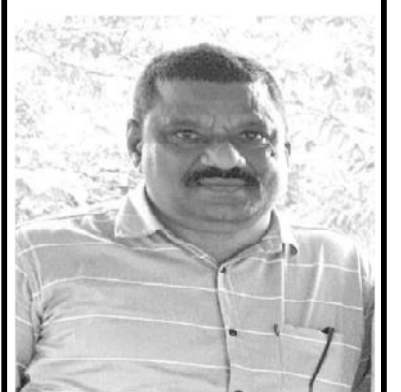
