MoHUA recommends holistic planning for pedestrian friendly market spaces in consultation with stakeholders

Pedestrianisation in Market Places

New Delhi, June 10 (PIB)

The Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs has recommended holistic planning for pedestrian friendly market spaces in various cities and municipal areas in the country in consultation with stakeholders.

The advisory issued by Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to all states/cities/municipal corporations has also suggested the million plus cities to select at least three market places for

pedestrianisation & non-million plus cities to select at least one market area for pedestrianisation in market places.

The following steps have been suggested for adopting the Pedestrianisation in Market Places -

> Selection of Market Location - Million Plus Cities may select at least 3 market places and notify them for Pedestrianisation. Non Million plus cities may select at least one market area for pedestrianisation.

> Holistic Planning of the Area - The planning for pedestrian

friendly market space may be done in consultation with the stakeholders - Vendors, Municipal Officers, Traffic Police, parking facility owners, Shop Owners and consumers. This will require proper survey of space used in the present scenario by various stakeholders. A movement/direction plan has to be prepared to see that there are designated walking paths where visitors are able to follow social distancing. Plan could be made keeping the trees and other greens intact, adding tree canopy to improve

walkability with clear spaces demarcated for vending, waste collection and access to toilet facilities. Plan should also incorporate interactive spaces for public to be carved out of contiguous unclaimed and under-utilized public spaces in the vicinity of the selected market area.

> Once the plan is made and firmed up cities may start implementation in two phases - short term and long term.

> Short-term recommendations include interventions that are quick,

temporary, easy to install, and ensure safety to commuters after the lockdown. The market spaces could be rearranged with quick ad temporary measures such as barricades, road closure for vehicles., etc.

> On-street parking space or even carriageway lanes can be repurposed to provide more walking and waiting space.

> Cities may consider providing improved access through additional streets.

> Cyclists may be allowed with dedicated/

The Town Vending Committee (TVC) constituted under the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Scheme, 2016 convened a meeting yesterday under the chairmanship of Secretary, PBMC and discussed on kick start of PM Street Vendors AtmaNirbharNidhi (PM SVANidhi). The TVC also deliberated on identification and



declaration of No-Vending Zones & Restricted Vending Zones in Port Blair City.

In the meeting, the Secretary, PBMC informed the Committee that the Ministry of Housing &

Urban Affairs, Govt. of India through a video conference held on June 8 has directed all States and UTs to take up the PM SVANidhi scheme for street vendors on top priority and shall be implemented from July



2020 to March 2022. Further, the Secretary PBMC added that the Certificate of Vending (CoV) for the 124 nos. identified eligible street vendors will be issued by June 2020 and they can avail the working capital loan

from various Banks. The PBMC will facilitate between Bankers and Street vendors to achieve the objective of PM SVANidhi scheme.

ICC approves replacements in test cricket, bans use of saliva to shine ball

New Delhi, June 10 International Cricket Council, ICC on Tuesday has approved substitution in case a player shows symptoms of COVID-19 during a Test match besides ratifying the interim ban on using saliva to shine the ball. ICC has also re-introduced non-neutral umpires for bilateral series as part of its interim playing regulations to tackle the threat posed by the COVID-19 pandemic.

In the five new regulations, recommended by the Anil Kumble-chaired Cricket Committee, and ratified by the Chief Executives Committee (CEC), the teams will also be allowed an additional DRS call as home umpires will now be officiating in bilateral Test series. The ICC in a press release said that a 32-inch additional logo would also be permitted on the players' jerseys, for Boards to make up for financial losses due to pandemic. However, the regulation for COVID-19 replacements will not be applicable in ODIs and T20Is, it added. The ICC said, ban on use of saliva was taken as it is considered to be a transmitter of novel coronavirus unlike sweat which will still be allowed to shine the ball. Repeated violation of the ban would at first invite a warning before a five-run penalty is imposed, it added. A team can be issued up to two warnings per innings but repeated use of saliva on the ball will result in a 5-run penalty to the batting side. Whenever saliva is applied to the ball, the umpires will be instructed to clean the ball before play recommences.

ear-marked pathways.

- > Provision of access to motor vehicles for residents of the area to commute should be clearly delineated.
- > Municipal Bodies may increase the width of foot paths of the streets leading to the market.
- > Adequate provision of high frequency public transit may be ensured for citizens to access the market area in a comfortable manner.
- > The design of the vending spaces provides a good opportunity for innovations.
- > Long term permanent structures for promoting pedestrianisation can be developed after temporary short-term measures are found working.

Timelines: Selection of City Market spaces for Pedestrianisation may be done by June 30, 2020. The holistic planning of the area through stakeholder consultation can be undertaken in next 3 months, i.e. September 30, 2020. Survey of the vendors and other users of the market space could be carried out and completed by July 31, 2020. By the end of September, 2020, a Plan may be formalised to start implementation. Short term measures such as temporary barricading, closure of roads for traffic, earmarking spaces, etc. to assess the plan on the field may be started in the first week of October 2020. The assessment of the implemented Plan through short term measures may be done by November 2020 and amendments as required may be completed by November, 2020.

Technique

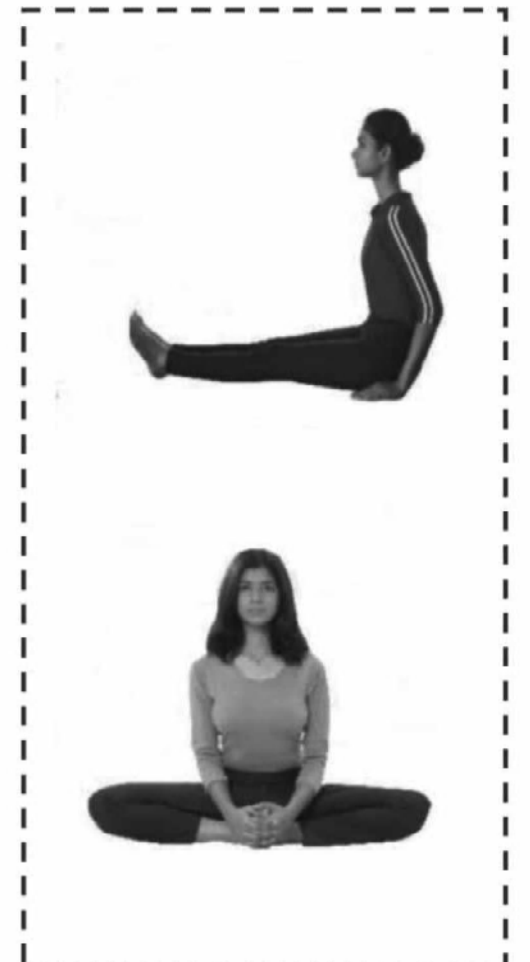
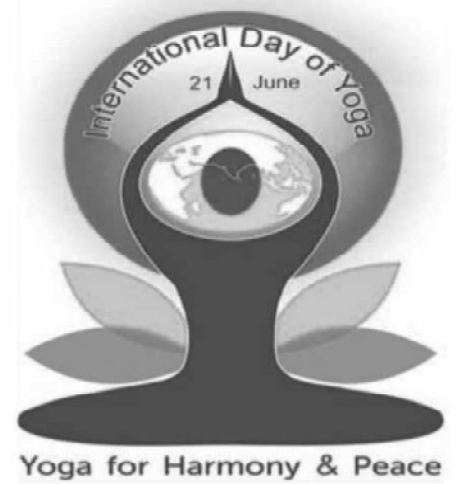
- ♦ Sit straight with legs stretched out in the front.

- ♦ Exhale and clasp your hands together over your toes. Inhale, pull your heels as close as possible up to perineum region. If your thighs are not touching or are not close to the floor, place a soft cushion underneath the knees for support.
- ♦ This is the final position.
- ♦ Stay in this position for some time with normal breathing.

Benefits

- ♦ Helps to keep the body firm and stabilizes the mind.
- ♦ Helps during pregnancy and relieves abdominal pain often experienced during menstruation.

Caution

- ♦ Avoid this practice in case of severe arthritis and sciatica.
- ♦ Do not try beyond limits and overdo the lateral stretch.
- ♦ If one cannot touch the feet, one can reach for the knees instead.

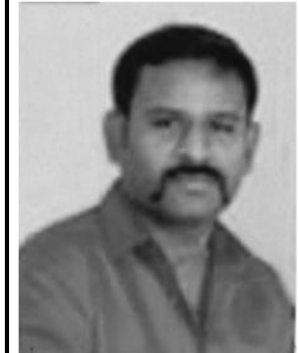
