Strengthening AYUSH systems of medicine through infrastructure development in A&N Islands

First phase of new AYUSH Hospital at Junglighat nearing completion

Port Blair, July 9
The AYUSH systems of medicines are quite popular among the people from all walks of life in A&N Islands. To meet the increasing service need, particularly the in-patient care, the A&N Administration decided to construct a new State of the Art- 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital at Junglighat. It may be recalled that the foundation stone of the project was laid by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi during his visit to the Islands on 30th December, 2018.



The civil work is being completed in two phases with the combined funding under NAM and UT Health Budget. The first phase of the triple-storied building is having a provision of adequate space for Shatkarma (Yogic cleansing), Halls for Yoga practice, Central Medical Depot of Ayurveda &

Homoeopathy, QMS Store, Admn. Block, Seminar Hall etc. The land and budget of Rs. 4.35 Crores has already been made available for the civil works of the first phase. The construction of the building is nearing completion.

The second phase of the building has a provision for 50-bedded wards, Nursing Rooms,

Ayurvedic Panchakarma, Naturopathy, Physiotherapy with adequate space for OPD block, OT, and all accessory facilities as per norms. The land has been allotted for the Second Phase; and work of the compound wall around the land is nearing completion with the approved budget of Rs. 35 lakhs released by Ministry of AYUSH. The building plan for the triple storied building of Phase-II has also been approved and estimation of budget is under process.

The proposal for required HR for the upcoming 50 bedded AYUSH Hospital has been submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH for phased approvals

Media briefed on COVID-19

Vaccination of beneficiaries above 45 + with first dose almost reached saturation: Secretary (Health)

Port Blair, July 9

The Secretary (Health), Shri Ram Niwas Sharma while addressing a COVID-19 media briefing held in the conference hall of IP&T today, said that the RTPCR test conducted on 367 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no corona positive case was detected. Similarly, 168 persons bound for Middle & North Andaman were tested at Ferrargunj and no corona positive case was detected. The mobile testing team visited Bachra Pahad (Chouldari) wherein 103 persons were tested and all were found negative. He said, 1 flight with 156 passengers arrived today and their RTPCR reports are awaited. Six persons were tested at helipad while 95 persons were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty today and no corona positive case was detected. He informed that the

number of corona positive patients admitted in the G. B Pant Hospital is presently 3 and two of them are on oxygen support. The Secretary said, there are 13 corona active cases in South Andaman District as on 8.07.21. There are no

corona positive cases in North & Middle Andaman as well as in Nicobar District, he added.

The Secretary stated that 40.40% population has been vaccinated with first dose of COVISHIELD till yesterday, out of the

total population of 4,00,000. He said, till yesterday, 2,12,003 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in Isles against the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603. He said, first dose have been given to

South Andaman Police cracks double murder case within hours

CCTV footage of nearby shop played key role in nabbing accused

Port Blair, July 9
An information was received at PS Aberdeen on 8th July, 2021 at about 2125 hrs, that two persons were lying unconscious in a pool of blood in the Gandhi Market complex. Upon this, a team of PS Aberdeen rushed to the spot and identified the two persons as Shankar @ Chennai Mistry, (45) yrs, an Auto Mechanic based at Gandhi Market

and K. Arumugam, S/o Kali Kujan (40) yrs, R/o Brookshabad. The crime scene was secured and all the evidences were lifted and seized scientifically. Then, a key evidence in the form of CCTV footage was obtained from a nearby shop. Acting swiftly on this lead, multiple search teams were formed to nab the accused.
Within a few hours,

the dedicated staff of PS Aberdeen apprehended the accused Abdul Azeem and recovered the weapon used for committing the murder at the instance of the accused. The preliminary investigation revealed that the victims were brutally beaten to death with a metal pipe by the accused Abdul Azeem following a

Be safe, get vaccinated

2,18,848 eligible beneficiaries vaccinated in Isles so far

56,837 in the age group of 18 to 44 years vaccinated

Port Blair, July 9

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. Accordingly, the vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with comorbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

As per data available, a total of 2,18,848 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 6845 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. A total of 56,837 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

Today, 3018 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 536 were in the age group



of 18-44 years. In North & Middle Andaman District, 3390 beneficiaries were vaccinated. In Nicobar District, 437 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 14 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

Meanwhile, the Nodal Officer, COVID-19, Dr. Avijit Roy informed that the slot for vaccination of beneficiaries in the age group of 18-44 will remain open from 9.30am onwards from tomorrow (July 10) onwards for six days booking. Vaccination will be effective from July 12, 2021. The booking of slot is only done for vaccination at JNRM vaccination centre, a press release from DHS said.

In addition to the regular OPD care, AYUSH units carry out a range of field activities including free health camps, poshan camps, yoga classes, awareness meetings at community level for preventive, promotive and curative health of the public.

1,61,602 beneficiaries covering 57.39 percent of the targeted population. The second dose has been given to 50,401 beneficiaries the percentage of which stands at 31.19, the Secretary said adding that number of second dose beneficiaries is increasing day by day as they are taking the vaccination as per their due date.

The number of eligible persons who have been inoculated with first dose in the age group of 45 plus are 1,05,315, which, he said, is moving towards saturation. He said that the number of beneficiaries in the age group of 18-44 is 1,75,000 and so far, 56,287 eligible beneficiaries have been vaccinated with first dose till yesterday.

The Secretary further said that the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly and till 3 pm today, 951 beneficiaries were vaccinated in JNRM vaccination centre, out of which, 249 persons were in the age group of 18-44 years and rest were above 45. The Secretary, on behalf of the A&N Administration has once again urged the left out beneficiaries above 45 plus, if any, to come forward and get themselves vaccinated.

Squally weather over Andaman Sea; fishermen advised

Heavy to very heavy rain (7-20 cm) and thundersquall with wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph is likely to occur at one or two places over A & N Islands on July 10 & 11. On July 12, heavy rain (7-11 cm) and thundersquall with wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph is likely to occur at one or two places. Similarly, on July 13, heavy rain (7-11 cm) & thunderstorm with lightning and gusty wind (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places.

Meanwhile, due to squally weather over Andaman Sea and adjoining East Central Bay of Bengal, the wind speed is likely to exceed 45 kmph. Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea till July 12.

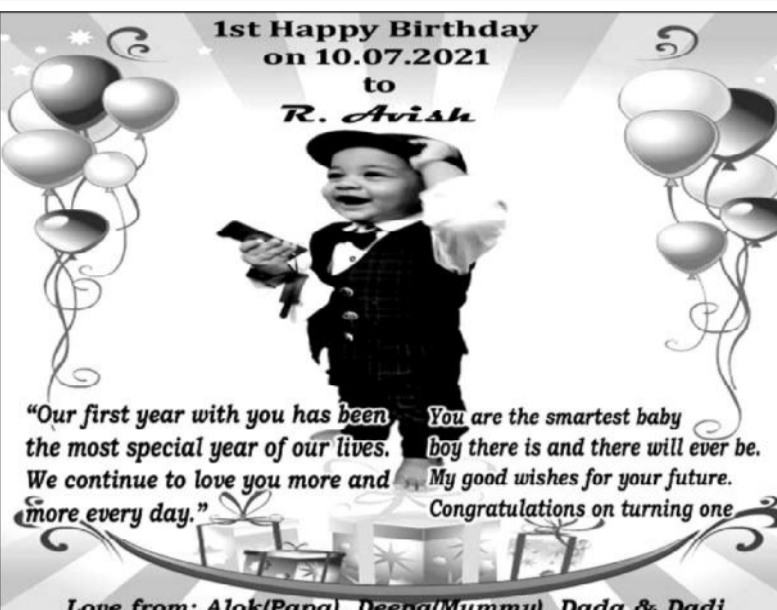
