Delegation of students of constituent colleges of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Institute of Higher Learning meets officials of A&N Administration

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 10

Amid the ongoing agitation by the students of the constituent colleges of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Institute of Higher Learning, a delegation of students met with officials of the A & N Administration: **1. Whether there will be any change from the present fee regime.**

Ans. There shall be no fee hike. Fees will remain nominal to ensure accessibility. NSCBIHL, DTBU is fully funded by grants of UT

Administration. **2. Whether the existing infrastructure will be withdrawn from the constituent colleges.**

Ans. No, the constituent college shall continue to function as it is with the existing infrastructure. A & N Administration shall ensure further augmentation of infrastructure/facility for improving the quality of education under NSCBIHL.

3. Whether,

the stipends paid to the students of the constituent colleges shall be stopped or not.

Ans. No, the existing system of payment of stipend to the students of constituent colleges shall not be stopped.

4. Will the A & N Administration fund the proposed Deemed to be University even after the five years of its establishment.

Ans. Yes, the UT Administration shall continue to fund the Institution

Deemed to be University even after the five years of its establishment.

5. How the examination and evaluation will be carried out?

Ans. For the students admitted in the year 2025-26, the examination and evaluation shall be carried out by NSCBIHL with the help of Pondicherry University / Mentor Institute under an MoU executed by A&N Administration.

6. Whether the Deemed to be University will

have NIRF and A A C accreditation.

Ans. Yes, it is a mandatory requirement as per UGC (IDTBU) Regulations, 2023.

7. What if the reputation of the Deemed University be poor at the end of five years.

Ans. The Institution Deemed to be University shall ensure to maintain quality benchmark set by UGC and NEP 2020 by participating in NAAC/ NIRF/NBA ranking fostering research, ensuring accountable

process and industry aligned curricula.

In addition to above, the NSCBIHL shall deliver timely, relevant and high-quality higher education within the Islands, reducing migration and aligning learning with the unique needs of Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

Further, shall provide avenues to the students of these islands for research activities in these Islands, a press release from Director (Hr. Edn.) said.

Govt. notifies amendment rules formally recognising MNS personnel under re-employment rules

New Delhi, Feb. 10

The Government has notified the Ex-servicemen (Re-employment in Central Civil Services and Posts) Amendment Rules 2026. The Ministry of Defence said that the amendment formally recognises the Military Nursery Service (MNS) personnel under the re-employment rules, and strengthens rehabilitation and second-career opportunities for a

wider segment of former defence personnel.

It said that the move removes earlier ambiguity whether MNS officers, who are commissioned officers, were entitled to the same re-employment benefits as other veterans. A&N Administration steps up road infrastructure development State Highway No. 8 connecting Guptapara Junction and Manglutan Junction to be upgraded

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 10

In a major boost to infrastructure development and regional connectivity, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration has accorded administrative sanction of Rs.4.16 crore for the comprehensive improvement of a 1.75 km stretch of State Highway No. 8, connecting Guptapara Junction to Manglutan Junction. The project aims to strengthen a critical transport corridor that serves as a lifeline for several enroute villages and directly benefits over

3,722 residents. The upgraded stretch will significantly improve access to key public institutions, including the Manglutan Primary Health Centre (PHC), Humfrygunj Police Station, and the Guptapara Gram Panchayat Bhavan, thereby enhancing essential service delivery and overall travel convenience.

Beyond its local importance, State Highway No. 8 plays a pivotal role in supporting the tourism sector of the Andaman Islands. The highway serves as the primary access route to

internationally acclaimed tourist destinations such as Wandoor, Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park, Jolly Buoy, and Red Skin Islands, which collectively attract an average of 2,500 tourists every week. Improved road infrastructure along this stretch is expected to enhance travel safety and comfort for visitors, further strengthening the tourism-driven economy of the region.

The sanctioned works include the extension of 22 RCC box culverts,

construction of 02 new RCC box culverts, and construction of RCC retaining walls to ensure durability and resilience of the roadway. This strategic investment underscores the commitment of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration towards sustainable infrastructure development, improved connectivity, and inclusive economic growth, while reinforcing the region's preparedness to support increasing traffic and tourism demand, a press release from APWD said.
