India and Australia have reaffirmed their commitment to a peaceful and prosperous Indo-Pacific, based on mutual respect and cooperation. In a joint statement issued in New Delhi today, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and his Australian counterpart Mr. Malcolm Turnbull agreed to draw on the strengths of each country to create jobs and investment and raise living standards. Both leaders agreed that Australia's resources and experience could support India's ambitious economic reform path and that India's strong growth offered opportunities for Australian investment looking for long term stable returns.



Recognising that an economically prosperous Indo-Pacific region is underpinned by stability and security, the two leaders underscored the importance of respecting

the maritime legal order based on the 1982 United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS). The Prime Ministers committed to deepening the bilateral defence and

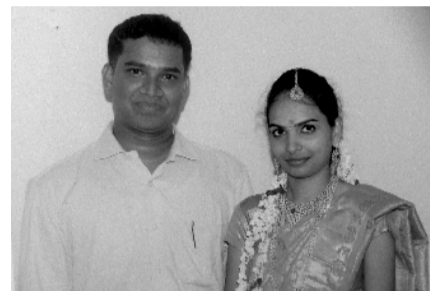

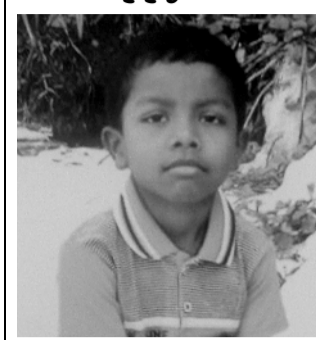

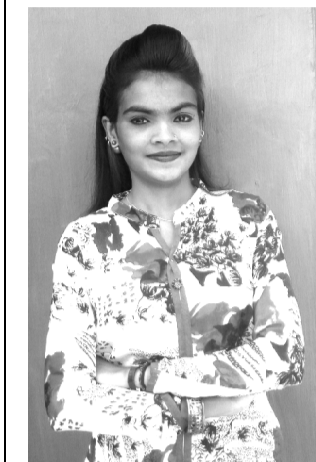

Saina, who had won the Malaysia Masters Grand Prix Gold in January after recovering from a career-threatening knee injury, had bowed out of the opening

round at Malaysia Open last week after losing narrowly to Japan's Akane Yamaguchi.
