Cabinet passes resolution applauding Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi for becoming the longest serving elected Prime Minister for consecutive terms

New Delhi, June 10 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet today passed a resolution marking June 10, 2026, as an historic milestone in the journey of Indian democracy applauding Shri Narendra Modi for becoming the longest-serving elected Prime Minister of the country. By establishing a record of 4,399 days of continuous service as an elected PM, he has surpassed the previous record held by Shri Jawaharlal Nehru, who served for 4,398 continuous days from 1952 to 1964. The resolution states that this occasion stands as a symbol of India's democratic consciousness, public trust, and the power of public participation, reflecting the unprecedented support bestowed by the people upon a leader guided by the 'Nation First' resolve.

Extending its heartfelt congratulations and best wishes to the Prime



Minister, the resolution highlights that this achievement coincides with the NDA government completing 12 years under his leadership. It also notes that the Prime Minister is approaching the historic mark of 25 years of continuous service as Head of Government. Taking pride in a leadership characterized by sensitivity, restraint, intent, and decisiveness, the official text emphasizes that it is after six decades that the country has given a

mandate to the NDA government for a third consecutive term.

Outlining the Prime Minister's life as a symbol of continuous dedication to service and nation-building, the text recalls his 2014 declaration as the "Pradhan Sevak" committed to the mantra of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas'. Acknowledging that the welfare of the poor has been placed at the center of governance, the document details the unprecedented scale of amenities

delivered, including pucca houses, electricity, clean water, and direct benefit transfers, alongside free rations for over 80 crore citizens and free medical treatment for over 60 crore poor individuals. The resolution records that these efforts collectively boosted national self-confidence and enabled over 25 crore people to defeat poverty.

The resolution further maps the empowerment of key demographics. It recognizes the focus on

youth power that propelled India into becoming the world's third-largest startup ecosystem and a scientific power through Mission Chandrayaan. A new chapter of 'Women-Led Development' is detailed through comprehensive policies ranging from smoke-free kitchens and the Lakshmi Didi campaign to the historic 33 percent reservation for women in legislative bodies. Affirming farmers as a core pillar

'Great Nicobar project will serve strategic interests, emerge as maritime focal point'

The Rs 81,000-crore Great Nicobar Islands (GNI) project will serve India's strategic interests and emerge as a maritime and economic focal point due to its proximity to the international maritime routes and Sea Lanes of Communication (SLOCs), top defence sources said on Monday.

The mega infrastructure project,

comprises of an International Container Transshipment Port (ICTP), a joint-user Greenfield airfield and Naval Air Station, a township and a power plant. Sources said the Joint User Greenfield and Naval Air Station at GNI also enhances the ability to sustain the presence, move assets, support operations, monitor sea lanes, respond to crises and maintain logistics in a

forward location, adding that this strategic location accrues great advantages vis-a-vis range of operations and presence in this strategic region and enhances domain awareness, which cannot be provided by other bases even in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

They also said the majority of India's transhipped containers are handled

abroad (Colombo, Singapore, Klang) and Vizhinjam in Kerala is the sole domestic transshipment port, adding that Galathea in Great Nicobar reduces this dependency.

The sources said the project is dual-use by design, not commercial activity disguised as strategy. "A deep-water port providing naval logistics support is the established model for maritime nations. The

strategic value lies in the civil-military integration that a standalone airfield cannot replicate," they said.

According to the sources, the project shall reduce dependence on foreign transshipment ports on one hand and facilitate a stronger presence of India's defence forces on the other. (Source: <https://indianexpress.com/>)

obligations, age-based restrictions, the exemption status of certain cargo/container vessels, weather dependent sailing permission, loading of inspection requirements and the conditions governing the operation of vessels above 40 years of age during fair-weather windows, as stipulated below:-

> The scope of the pre-monsoon or monsoon-fitness survey shall be clarified to the effect that, where the annual or renewal survey is carried out between January and April, the monsoon-related checks may be conducted concurrently through IRS; otherwise, a separate pre-monsoon inspection may be undertaken one to two months prior to the onset of monsoon. The scope of pre-monsoon survey will be as per the guidance provided in the circular.

> It was clarified that vessels carrying the class notation "certified to carry containers" do not come under the ambit of the applicability of DGS Circular No. 58 of 2025, since the circular provides requirements for general cargo vessels.

> It shall be recorded and circulated to the Owners/Port Authorities that permission from MMD for monsoon-season operation will remain conditional upon local weather forecasts, and that both the Port Authority and the Master must satisfy themselves that the forecast is acceptable prior to departure; wind speed below 20 knots and wave height below 2 metres may be treated as the indicative threshold.

> In respect of vessels engaged in inter-island voyages of short duration, carriage of specified construction material such as stone (in bulk), sand (carried in bags) and other general cargo, where conditionally permitted, may be allowed by IRS/MMD subject to approved cargo stowage, due diligence by the Owner, and vetting of the loading plan.

> A vessel-specific approved loading plan shall be prepared by the Owners/Operators, and its verification shall be carried out by a third-party surveyor wherever available; in the absence of third-party surveyor, the standard loading condition, stability particulars, and loading plan shall be vetted and approved by IRS/MMD and the Harbour Master prior to departure.

> The Harbour Master, Port Officer and Master shall verify the load line and actual loading condition at the port of departure, including recording the date and time of departure and photographic evidence of the hatch condition before and after loading, and shall retain a copy of the master-certified actual loading condition. Copy of departure conditions to be submitted to the MMD.

> A compliance checklist, in the format prescribed by MMD Kolkata, shall be furnished by stakeholders prior to each voyage, a press release from DSS said.

of a 'Viksit Bharat', the text applauds initiatives like PM Kisan Samman Nidhi and the provision of Kisan Credit Cards to pastoralists and fishermen, which have helped propel agricultural exports past the Rs 5 lakh crore mark.

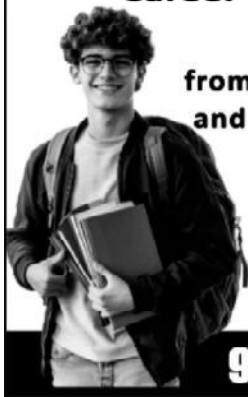

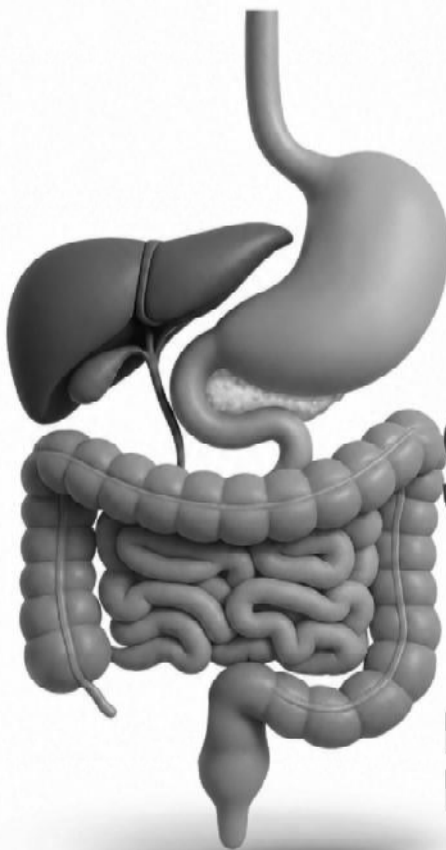
