## Lt. Governor visits Ward No. 1, 2 & 8

### Directs concerned Departments for timely completion of ongoing projects



Port Blair, Jul 10

The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi today visited PBMC Ward No. 1 & 2 at Haddo & Ward No. 8 at Buniyadabad. The OSD to LG, Shri PK Singh, Chairperson, PBMC, Shri B. Eswar Rao, Councilor, Ward No. 1, Shri Karunakaran, Councilor, Ward No. 2, Shri R. Someshwar Rao, Secretary, (Edn./ Sports), Smti. Tanvi Garg, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Udit Prakash Rai, CE, APWD (i/c) Shri Shivrama Subramanyam, Joint Secretary, PBMC, Shri Santosh Prakash, SE, APWD, Shri Tej Bahadur Singh, Officers from Education Department and other Senior Officers of the Administration were present during the visit.

The visit commenced from Sunder Colony at Haddo where the Councilor, Ward No. 2, Shri Someshwar Rao apprised the Lt. Governor

of the need to develop a playground at Sunder Colony. The land for the proposed playground belongs to Revenue Department but is under occupation of Agriculture Department. Accordingly, the Lt. Governor directed PBMC to develop a playground in the vacant land as part of the Smart City Project for which the Agriculture Department would part with the land.

During the visit to Buniyadabad diggi area, the Councilor, Ward No. 8, Shri K. Ganeshan briefed the Lt. Governor about the pending project pertaining to development of a pond near Coast Guard Residential Area, Panipat Road, with facilities such as footpath, hand railing, benches/ steps and Kiosk etc. Accordingly, the Lt. Governor issued direction to PBMC to find out about availability of the fund, to be used for the project. If not, new fund from Smart City Project can be used for this project, he said.

The Lt. Governor further directed PBMC to complete the work by Dec 31, 2017, for its inauguration by the first week of Jan, 2018. The PBMC has assured that tender will be floated in a month's time; and the work will commence within two months.

While inspecting the dilapidated vacant wooden quarters of APWD at Haddo, the Lt. Governor directed APWD to furnish status report of all the quarters available in the Islands. He further directed that no new flats shall be constructed by APWD until and unless all vacant quarters are renovated and allotted. Therefore, the demand put forth by the Councilor, Ward No. 1, Shri Karunakaran, for construction of playground at the same site shall be taken up after considering the comprehensive development plan of APWD, the Lt. Governor said.

Thereafter, the Lt.

Governor visited Peter Barrack, PWD quarters at Haddo, where he noticed encroachment of the area. Accordingly, the Lt. Governor has fixed responsibility on APWD to take action against the persons who do not take any step to vacate the encroached area.

This was followed by a visit to 'Nature Park and Interpretation Centre' at Haddo. The PCCF and Pr. Secy, Department of Environment and Forests, Shri M.S.Negi and the APCCF(P&D), Shri D.M. Shukla appraised the Lt. Governor about the upcoming park which will be a public utility space dedicated to showcasing biological richness of the Islands, in a recreational way. The Lt. Governor expressed happiness on the pace of development of the park and appreciated the concept of the project. He also gave directions for further beautification of the spot. The Lt. Governor directed the Forest Department to establish the park with highest standard and quality with people

friendly amenities. He desired that the development of the park be completed at the earliest.

At Govt. Middle School at Laltha Singh Ground, Haddo, the Lt. Governor interacted with the students and teachers. He also directed the Secretary (Edn. / Sports) to ensure that the students after passing out from class X, are allowed to continue studying in the same school, upto class XII, and the process of their re-admission, in class XI in the same school be done away with. He said, admission to class XI in the same school is a direct process and cannot be denied, except in cases of change of school.

The Secretary (Edn. /Sports), Smti Tanvi Garg also briefed the Lt. Governor about the plan for construction of a Mini Stadium at Laltha Singh Ground, Haddo, Ward No. 1. Accordingly, the Lt. Governor directed the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman for

### Smooth transition of students from Class X to Class XI

#### Education Deptt directs all schools to comply with directions

Port Blair, July 10

The Directorate of Education has directed all schools of this UT (Govt./ Govt. Aided Private schools/Private Unaided/ local body schools) to comply with its directions to ensure smooth transition of students from Class X to Class XI. In a press release received here today, the Dy Director Education, (Admn)/ HoO stated that it has been brought to the notice of the Directorate of Education that students from some schools are facing

difficulties/inconvenience for their transition from Class X into Class XI in the same school where they studied upto Class X.

Accordingly, all the schools of this UT (Govt./Govt. Aided Private schools/Private Unaided/ local body schools) have been asked to strictly comply with the following to ensure smooth transition of students from Class X to Class XI:

All Class X Pass out students have to be given first preference in their own school or from the feeder

school as per the availability of stream (Science, Commerce, Arts, IT & FMM) and the merit of the students. Only after that the students from the catchment area of the concerned schools and outside shall be considered. Accordingly Class X pass out students are not required to take re-admission in Class XI in the same school.

Students once admitted in a particular school in class Pre-Primary/I or any other class must be retained in

### Admission to Class VIII in RIMC Dehradun; written examination at TGCE on Dec 1 & 2

Port Blair, July 10

The written examination for admission to Class VIII in Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC), Dehradun for the term commencing July-2018 will be conducted on Dec 1st and 2nd, 2017 at Tagore Govt. College of Education, Middle Point here.

Only boys are eligible to apply for admission to RIMC. At the time of admission to RIMC (i.e. on 01 Jan-2018), the boy should either be studying in Class

VII or should have passed Class VII form any recognized school. They should not be less than 11 1/2 years in age but should not have attained the age of 13 years as on 01 July-2018 i.e. they should not be born earlier than 02 July-2005 and not later than 01 Jan-2007.

**Ashwin, Jadeja continue to remain at top two positions in ICC Test bowlers' rankings**

Dubai, July 10  
India's spin duo of Ravindra Jadeja and Ravichandran Ashwin continue to remain at the top two positions in the ICC Test bowlers' rankings released in Dubai today. Jadeja is heading the table with 898 points, while Ashwin is placed at the second spot with 865 points. However, none of the other Indian bowlers figure in the top-10 list. In the all-rounders chart, Jadeja remains static at second place, while Ashwin is holding on to the third spot. As far as Indian batsmen are concerned, Cheteshwar Pujara remains at the fourth position, and Virat Kohli is static



at the fifth place. K L Rahul climbed up a place to ninth spot in the batting table, which is continued to be headed by Australia's Steve Smith. Meanwhile, England's Moeen Ali has received a rankings boost in both batsmen's and bowlers' list. Ali was declared the player of the match at the Lord's Test yesterday. He

**India tops medal tally at Asian Athletics**

Bhubaneswar, July 10  
In a stunning show of dominance, India clinched five gold to top the medal tally for first time in the history of Asian Athletics Championships, pushing China to second spot, in their most successful campaign in the continental flagship event on Sunday. With Sunday's 5 gold, 1 silver and 3 bronze, India ended the four-day championships on top with their highest ever medal haul of 29 medals in total. These include 12 golds, 5 silver and 12 bronze. India's best came way back in the 1985 Jakarta edition where they had won 22 medals including 10 golds. China ended this edition on second position with 8 gold, 7 silver and 5 bronze. India also suffered a huge setback after 800m runner Archana Yadav was disqualified, after being initially declared as the gold medal



winner, for pushing Sri Lankan rival Nimali Waliwarsha Konda from behind near the finishing line. The gold medal was then awarded to Konda and India thus lost a yellow metal in dramatic circumstances. It was heptathlete Swapna Barman who gave India the first gold of the day as she collected a total of 5942 points from the seven events. After that Lakshmanan Govinda took the centre stage as he grabbed his second gold of the championship by winning the men's 10,000m event in 29 minute and 55.87 seconds.

The Councilor, Ward No. 1, Shri Someshwar Rao also informed the Lt. Governor about the usage of unhealthy substances by students, which needs to be monitored thoroughly. Accordingly, the Lt. Governor directed the SHO, Chatham to keep strict vigil and ensure that no such activity prevails in the area.

For the first time in these Islands, the Andaman Nicobar Chess Association is going to conduct the National Under-25 Chess Championship at JNRM Port Blair from July 13th, 2017. The Andaman Nicobar Chess Association under the aegis of All India Chess Federation (AICF) is hosting the event which will be completed in 9 rounds starting from July 13 upto 19. The valedictory function of the Championship will be chaired by the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Prof Jagdish Mukhi at 5 pm on July 19. The Championship will be inaugurated by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar at 3 pm on July 13, 2017, informed the President, Andaman Nicobar Chess Association, Shri G.
