PM Modi, Russian Prez Putin dedicate first unit of Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project to the nation Senior Citizens Maintenance and Welfare Tribunal, South Andaman District constituted

New Delhi, Aug 10
The first unit of the ambitious Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project has been dedicated to the nation by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and Russian President Mr Vladimir Putin.

The 1000 megawatt facility is India's single largest nuclear generation unit and was dedicated by the leaders through video conferencing from Delhi and Moscow.

They were joined by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Ms J. Jayalalithaa from Chennai. The VVER type light water reactor and its ancillary equipment were supplied by Russian atomic agency Atomstroyexport under an Indo-Russian agreement of

In persistence to the continuing effort of District Administration to regulate the quarrying and crushing activities in South Andaman District and to stop all such illegal quarry and stone crushing units functioning in the South Andaman District, the Eviction Team of Port Blair Tehsil today raided various Stone Crushing Units functioning in Prothrapur and Brookshabad village of Port Blair Tehsil under the supervision and control of the District

Administration. Following complaints, the Team comprising of Revenue Inspectors area Patwaris and other revenue officials conducted surprise raids at Stone Crushing units of Prothrapur and Brookshabad village and confiscated the conveyor belts of four such illegal functional/non-functional crushing units and the materials so seized were handed over the SHO, Pahargaon for watch and ward. Legal action has also been initiated against all such units of that area. 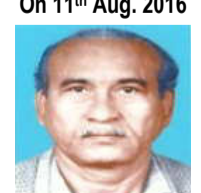

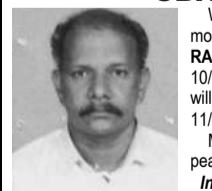

Rio 2016: Sealed with a kiss as Michael Phelps makes it 21 golds

Rio De Janeiro, Aug 10
Michael Phelps captured his 20th Olympic gold medal in devastating fashion on Tuesday, sealing victory with a kiss, before adding a staggering 21st before the night was over.

The American crushed rival Chad le Clos to regain his 200 metres+ butterfly title, celebrating victory in a race bristling with tension by pointing to the sky and gesturing to the Rio crowd to "bring the noise" - an order they duly obeyed. Katinka Hosszu and Katie Ledecky struck further blows for girl power, but again it was all about Phelps, who later anchored the American 4x200 freestyle relay team to gold as the clock edged toward midnight local time.

Milking the acclaim of the Brazilian crowd, Phelps climbed past the massed bank of poolside photographers to kiss fiancée Nicole and baby Boomer after an emotional medals ceremony. Entering the arena like a gladiator, his face a granite mask of concentration, Phelps dominated a grudge final le Clos had billed as "Ali versus Frazier" to become the oldest



individual swimming gold medalist in Olympic history at 31. South African Le Clos, who won by a fingertip four years ago in London to rob the American of a hat-trick of titles, faded badly down the stretch to finish out of the medals. World record holder Phelps, the most decorated athlete in Olympic history, clocked 1min

53.36sec to add to his staggering title tally as Japan's Masato Sakai came through for a surprise silver in 1:53.40. Hungary's Tamas Kenderesi took bronze in 1:53.62. Competing in his fifth and final Olympics, victory was twice as sweet for Phelps after clashing with le Clos in the media since losing to the South African in their epic tussle in London.

India vs West Indies: ICC sanctions two T20s in USA on August 27 and 28

Dubai, Aug 10
The ICC today sanctioned the two T20 International matches between India and the West Indies to be held at Fort Lauderdale in the USA on August 27 and 28.

In light of American cricket governing body USACA's current suspension from membership of the ICC, the responsibility of determining whether cricket matches staged in the USA lies with the ICC.

ICC chief executive David Richardson said: "The ICC has approved these matches

because we believe they can play a significant role in the long term development of cricket in the USA and our ongoing efforts to unify the USA cricket community.

"Having the ICC World T20 Champions playing India in Florida will undoubtedly inspire both existing and new fans and players, but perhaps more importantly, the sanction fees will be invested into the ICC's ongoing work to lay a sustainable foundation for the development of cricket in America.

"This, along with ongoing

investment from the ICC to help grow the sport in the USA will be used for specific programmes as part of the ICC's long-term strategic framework in the USA. In line with this strategy we are working with our stakeholders in the USA on the development of a new constitution and governance structure that the entire USA cricket community can unify behind."

Ben Kavenagh of ICC Americas explained how the ICC and sanction fee investment is having an impact in the US.

nuclear energy saying it is a clean source. In Kudankulam, the second unit has already attained criticality and is expected to get connected to the grid in a month's time. Preliminary works are also going on for the construction of third and fourth reactors with Russian technical expertise.

The first unit of Kudankulam nuclear power plant attained criticality in July 2013. Till now more than 10,800 million units of power has been generated from the first unit.

The 1000 Mega watt nuclear power plant was built with Russian expertise following a pact between the then Prime Minister Shri Rajiv Gandhi and Soviet leader Mr Mikhail Gorbachev in November 1988.
