EOI - Agencies for geothermal assessment, development in Andaman & Nicobar Islands

The Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) has published a call for Expressions of Interest (EOI) to identify and evaluate the assessment of agencies for geothermal resource assessment, exploration, development, and utilization of geothermal power projects in the union territory of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands in India. EOIs will be accepted only until 18th September, 2026. For interested parties, there will be a pre-submission meeting on 17th August, 2026. As stated in the tender documents, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands has been identified by the National Policy on Geothermal Energy as one of the geothermal provinces in India with geological characteristics considered suitable for

geothermal exploration and possible development. Due to the geographical isolation of the islands, it is also particularly vulnerable to dynamic fossil fuel prices and the related logistical challenges. Thus, developing geothermal as an indigenous,

renewable, baseload power source is considered a potentially transformative opportunity for the territory.

The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has further emphasized international cooperation for geothermal

development with global geothermal leaders in the fields of technology transfer, joint research and development, and deployment of proven geothermal technologies suitable for conditions in India.

Through this EOI, SECI intends to identify technically capable and financially sound agencies possessing demonstrated expertise in geothermal resource assessment, geothermal drilling, subsurface characterization, geothermal power generation systems and integrated project execution capabilities. Parliament passes Bankers' Books Evidence Bill to recognise digital banking records as legal evidence

New Delhi, Aug. 10

Parliament has passed the Bankers' Books Evidence Bill, 2026, with the Rajya Sabha approving it today. Lok Sabha has already passed the Bill. Union Finance Minister, Ms. Nirmala Sitharaman moved the Bill, which aims to modernise the legal framework to meet the requirements of the present banking system. The Bill seeks to provide a law relating to evidence with respect to bankers'



books and to align it with contemporary digital banking practices. The Bill also has a provision that an electronic or digital record of a banker's book will be admissible, valid,

and legally enforceable as evidence.

Two escaped Myanmar nationals apprehended after coordinated search operation

The Andaman & Nicobar Police has successfully apprehended two Myanmar nationals, namely Wai Phyoo and Aye Tun, who had escaped from the Open Distress Camp (ODC), Prothrapur on the intervening night of 25/26 July, 2026.

Immediately after the escape, an intensive search operation was launched by the Andaman & Nicobar Police. Search teams carried out extensive combing operations in and around Prothrapur and other adjoining

areas. Multiple teams were deployed round the clock and all available resources were mobilized to trace and apprehend the absconding individuals.

After sustained and relentless efforts, the escapees were successfully apprehended through the coordinated action of the South Andaman District Police and India Reserve Battalion (IRBn). Pashu Pushti kits distributed to farmers with pregnant cattle under Embryo Transfer Programme

The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services (AH&VS) distributed Pashu Pushti Kits to three farmers whose cattle were confirmed pregnant following Embryo Transfer (ET). The kits were specially provided to support proper nutrition, healthy fetal development and maintenance of the dam throughout the gestation period. These nutritional support packages are aimed at improving the overall

health of the pregnant animals, reducing the risk of nutritional deficiencies and ensuring better pregnancy outcomes under the advanced Embryo Transfer Technology programme being implemented in the Islands.

During the distribution, the farmers were thoroughly briefed about the proper dosage, method of administration and benefits of each nutritional supplement included in the kit. They were also advised on



scientific feeding practices, provision of adequate clean water and regular health monitoring of the pregnant animals for successful calving and healthy offspring.

This initiative forms part of the Department's continuous efforts to provide focused nutritional support to high-value animals under the Embryo Transfer Technology programme. By ensuring better care of the recipient animals during gestation, the Department aims to

improve the success rate of the programme and contribute to genetic improvement and higher productivity of the livestock population in the Islands.

A Living Link to History: 103-year-old Ms. Naw Phwamya recalls her remarkable journey 'Education and hard work can build a better future,' says Centenarian

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 10

Few people have the privilege of witnessing more than a century of history. Fewer still leave behind a legacy that inspires an entire community. Meet this remarkable 103 years old, Karen woman Ms. Naw Phwamya of Lucknow, Mayabunder who has lived through times of hardship, change and hope with extraordinary resilience and grace. Her life is a testament to courage, faith and unwavering determination. She was born on 14th January, 1923 in Myanmar (Erstwhile name Burma). In an exclusive interview with DT, she reflects on her remarkable journey, shares cherished memories and offers timeless wisdom for today's generation. Her story reminds us that a life well lived is measured not only by years but by the values, kindness and inspiration we pass on to others.

Q. Looking back over the years, what is the happiest memory that still brings a smile to your face?

A. My happiest memories are the simple moments I spent with my family, all of us living together under one roof. I remember accompanying my parents to the fields



and helping them with whatever little work I could. Those moments may have seemed ordinary at the time, but looking back now, they are some of the most precious memories of my life. I also cherish the joy of going for song practices with my siblings during Easter, Christmas and New Year. We would spend time together, sing, laugh and enjoy each other's company. Those were beautiful days filled with love, togetherness and innocence. As the years have passed, those moments have become even more precious to me. They are memories I carry in my heart

and I will cherish them for the rest of my life. Q. What are the biggest changes you've witnessed in the world and which one has surprised you the most?

A. One of the biggest changes I have witnessed is in the field of medicine and healthcare. In those days, there were hardly any medical facilities available. Childbirth usually took place at home and many illnesses and ailments were treated at home with whatever remedies were available. Today, with the advancement of science and technology, there are modern medical facilities and medicines available for many different illnesses. The progress in healthcare has been remarkable and this is one of the biggest changes I have witnessed in my lifetime.

Q. What values or principles have guided you throughout your life?

A. My greatest influences have always been my parents, who were simple farmers. They taught me the values and simple principles that guided their lives and those lessons have stayed with me throughout my own journey. This has been my greatest influence in life and I continue to live by the principles my parents taught me. I am grateful that their simple way of life and the values they instilled in me have become a lasting part of our family's legacy. (Contd. on last page)

Q. Can you tell us about your childhood and what daily life was like when you were young?

A. I don't remember much about my childhood, but I remember spending time at home with my parents. Life was simple and our days were centered around family and the work we had to do to make a living. My parents were simple farmers and I grew up learning from their way of life. Their simplicity, hard work and the values they lived by became an important part of who I am.

Q. What challenges did you face during your life and how did you find the strength to overcome them?

A. During those days, jobs were scarce and we faced many challenges. We worked as lumbermen, both in the fields and in the forest, doing whatever work was available to make a living. Sometimes we were paid very late. Even when the work was difficult and the pay was delayed, we could not simply leave the job because finding another source of income was not easy. We had to endure the hardships and continue working because it was how we supported ourselves and survived. The strength to continue came from necessity, perseverance and the values my parents had taught me.

Q. What do you believe is the secret to living a long, meaningful and healthy life?

A. I don't really know the secret to my longevity. However, I believe that it is by God's grace that I am still alive and well today. Perhaps I have done some good in my life and that is why God has blessed me and allowed me to live to this age. I also believe that the kind of food I have eaten throughout my life has played a part. My diet has always been simple, with very little oil and few spices. I have mostly eaten fresh, homegrown, organic food. This simple way of eating has helped sustain me and kept me healthy all these years.

Q. Who has had the greatest influence on your life and why?

A. My greatest influences have always been my parents, who were simple farmers. They taught me the values and simple principles that guided their lives and those lessons have stayed with me throughout my own journey. I have passed those same values on to my children and they, in turn, have passed them on to their children. In this way, the wisdom and principles of my parents have continued from one generation to the next.

Q. What advice would you give to the younger generation?

A. My advice to the younger generation is to value education and be willing to work hard. When they neglect their education and responsibilities, they may end up making life more difficult not only for themselves but also for their parents. I would encourage every young person to attend school, take their education seriously and work hard to build a good livelihood. Education and hard work can open many doors and give them the opportunity to create a better and more secure future for themselves and their families.

Q. Is there something you've always wanted to do but never had the chance to, or a dream you're still proud of?

A. I have not had many dreams in my life, but there is one dream that has stayed with me throughout the years. I always wished that, after my marriage and after having children, I would one day be able to see my parents again. My parents had gone back to Burma, but sadly, I never got the opportunity to see them again. That remains the one dream in my life that was never fulfilled. Even today, I think about them and wish that I could have had the chance to see them one more time.

Q. When you think about the legacy you want to leave behind, what do you hope people will remember most about you?

A. I would not want people to remember only me. I would also want future generations to remember all those who came to the islands, leaving behind the comfort and livelihood they knew to begin a new life. They faced many challenges and hardships along the way, but they accepted them with humility, courage and strength. I want people to remember the sacrifices of those who came before us and the struggles they endured to build a life here. Their stories, their values and their perseverance should not be forgotten. As one of the few, perhaps the only one, still living who came from Burma to the Andaman Islands, I hope people will remember me as part of that generation. I would like them to remember not only my life, but also the principles I lived by and the values that guided me throughout my journey.

which will help the country move forward at a faster pace. She highlighted that the Bankers' Books Evidence Act was framed in 1891, when banking systems were entirely paper-based. Ms. Sitharaman said, today, India has demonstrated remarkable progress in digitising its economy. She said, banking and financial transactions are now largely driven by digital platforms, often accessible through a simple click on a mobile phone. The Minister said that in such a scenario, it is imperative that the country's legal framework evolves to keep pace with these advancements. She noted that the existing 1891 Act relies heavily on certified copies of physical bank records as admissible evidence in legal proceedings. Ms. Sitharaman said that the Bill establishes a technology-neutral legal framework for bankers' records, which formally recognises electronic and digital banking records and ensures their admissibility in legal proceedings. It also standardises the certification process and allows authentication through manual, digital, and electronic signatures. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)
