These are Tribal Language: Santali (OI Chiki), Museology and Tribal Museum Management, Tribal Culture and Arts, Sustainable Tribal Culture - based Livelihood Practices, and Tribal Textiles. In addition, more than 50 free certificate courses are open to all learners.

programmes must hold a recognised undergraduate degree. The certificate courses are open to everyone. The programmes offer learning from tribal knowledge experts and artisans in a flexible hybrid mode. They include a one-month internship and are affiliated with Sampurnan and S a n s k r i t Vishwavidyalaya, Varanasi, under the UGC framework. The course fee is Rs 7,500

Aarogya Setu 2.0, launched by the Union Minister for Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India on 29th June, 2026, is an important Personal Health Record (PHR) application available under the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), bringing together a range of digital health services to make healthcare information and services more accessible and convenient for citizens.

Aarogya Setu 2.0 is a digital health application that helps citizens create and manage their ABHA (Ayushman Bharat Health Account) and securely access their digital health records. It provides consent-based sharing of health information, allowing users to control who can access their records. The app also uses AI and OCR technology to digitise



paper-based medical documents and convert them into structured digital records. Other features include Smart Reports, Scan &
