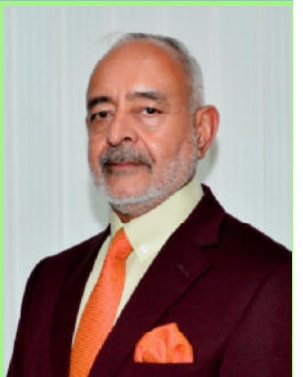

Training on Comprehensive New Born Birth Defects under RBSK organized for Medical & Nursing Officers

Training on Comprehensive New Born Birth Defects under RBSK was organized for Medical Officers/ Nursing Officers' in the Conference Hall, AYUSH Hospital, Sri Vijaya Puram on Oct. 25, 2024.



The training aimed to identify physical malformations such as cleft lip or palate, chromosomal abnormalities such as Down syndrome, functional defects including sensory deficits such as congenital deafness and congenital cataract, metabolic defects including inborn error of

metabolism or Haemoglobinopathies, neurodevelopmental disorders, and complications related to prematurity.
