As A&N Islands slowly picks up its pace in revival of tourism industry after being hit hard by the pandemic, efforts are on to complete the ongoing major developmental projects which will be a game changer for the socio-economic development of the Islands. One of the much awaited major projects is the construction of New Integrated Terminal Building at Veer



Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair by the Airports Authority of India at an estimated cost of around Rs.710 Crores. The project will be a stepping stone for expansion of tourism activities in the Islands,

thereby opening new vistas of job opportunities in varied sectors. The footfall of domestic and international tourists will further boost tourism industry in the Islands. The upcoming terminal will have

all modern facilities that are pertinent of international standard across the globe. The Airports Authority of India has decided to construct this New Integrated Terminal Building considering the inflow of visitors to the Islands. The new terminal is being constructed in the shape of a shell structure inspired by nature. This terminal building will be capable to handle 1200 passengers per

Value Added Tax Regulation 2017 who have been provided with provisional registration certificate are required to obtain fresh registration certificate by depositing the fee and security amount as prescribed under Annexure-I and Rule 20 & 21 of the said Rules failing which,

Guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution issued by MHA to be in force upto Jan. 31

Chief Secretary issues Order for implementation of guidelines in whole of A & N Islands

Port Blair, Dec. 31

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 10 (2) (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive Committee (NEC) vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 25.11.2020 had issued guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution, which will be in force upto 31.01.2021.

Consequent upon this Order, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act 2005, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration in the capacity as Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee, for the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has ordered that the Guidelines for surveillance, containment and

caution issued by MHA vide order dated 25.11.2020, shall remain in force upto 31.01.2021 for the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The Deputy Commissioners and Departments concerned may issue necessary Standard Operating Procedures to implement the orders. DC (SA) approves 42 projects under PMMSY

Port Blair, Dec. 31

The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Govt. of India has approved 23 beneficiary oriented activities and sanctioned an amount of Rs. 2 crore (Rs. 1.60 crore for General category and 0.40 crore for ST category) for implementation of the component/activities in A & N Islands under CSS Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY). This programme provides subsidy @ 40% for General category and 60% for ST / women on the

respective unit cost of components/ activities.

The District Level Committee of PMMSY under the Chairmanship of Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman selected and approved 42 applications in various activities under PMMSY on Dec. 29. The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman urged more participation of local fishermen, fish farmers, fish vendors and entrepreneurs of Islands to come

The Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) is an attempt to make the rural areas socially, economically and physically sustainable. The Mission strives to strengthen rural areas by providing economic, social and infrastructure amenities. In A & N Islands, the Ferrargunj Block was selected by the Administration as the 'Rurban Cluster'. Landing Centre, Guptapara under Rurban Mission.

Fish Landing Centre, Guptapara is situated 18 km south of Port Blair, in Ferrargunj Tehsil of South Andaman District. There is a very narrow creek near Guptapara through which the fishing craft land the catch during high waters. initially designed for 84 engine fitted boats and 10 nos. of local made dinghies.

The fishermen community were demanding additional works for accommodating more number of fishing boats which include providing compound wall with security room on the left side of R.C.C ramp to protect the Department land from Mangroves, providing a canal with retaining wall for smooth movement of at least of 2 fishing boats at a time on the left side of FLC, clearance of heap in front of R.C.C ramp for safe / smooth movement of fishermen shed, providing 2 water tanks having 2000 litres capacity, providing six 5000 litres capacity syntax over the R.C.C. platform.

Based on the demand of the fishermen community, a proposal was initially taken up with National Fisheries Development Board, Ministry of Agriculture, GOI under the 'Blue Revolution: Scheme'. As the project was getting delayed, the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration approved the proposal under Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Rurban Mission. An amount of Rs. 126.63 lakh was sanctioned during October, 2020 for the additional works and the works have been taken up by ALHW.

This additional works will further facilitate safe berthing of 120 fishing boats with 258 registered fishermen of the area. On completion of the above mentioned facilities, the fisher folk can land their fish catch in an organized manner, sorting & packing of the fishes in hygienic conditions, safe berthing of fishing boats and undertake repairing & construction of fishing boats. This will also boost more fish catch, easy transportation and enhance the frequency of fishing fleet of the fishing boats. The fishermen of the area who were mainly using traditional fishing boats have started improving their fishing boats with modern equipments so that they can undertake long voyage of fishing. With the completion of this work, the socio-economic condition of the fishermen will further improve, a press release from Directorate of RD said.

hour (600 pax Arrival + 600 pax Departure) and about 5 million (Domestic + International) passengers per year. Once completed, this new terminal building will be a game changer for the Islands, particularly in Aviation sector. It will be provided with 3 Aerobridges, 6 Escalators and 10 Elevators for all Departure & Arrival areas, 5 Conveyors for Baggage Handling System, 28 Check-in-Counters with inline X-ray machines, 20 Immigration Counters and 10 Custom Counters.

The City side area of the Airport will be developed with adequate parking facilities for car, taxi and buses along with the landscaping.

The Integrated Terminal Building is a large span (120 Mtr) structural steel framed building provided with aluminum sheet roofing and cable net glazing all around. The building will be having three floors with lower ground floor as a remote arrival, departure area and service area. The upper ground floor will have access to the terminal building as well as way out for inbound passengers while the first floor will have a



waiting lounge for international passengers. The total built up area of the terminal is 40,837 Sqm. The building will be completely air-conditioned with efficient chillers, AHUs and cooling system. Safety provisions of Fire Fighting and Integrated Sprinkler System, Fire Alarm System, BMS System will also be provided. Power saving efficient LED lights will be used in this Terminal Building. Despite the challenges posed by COVID-19, this prestigious project which commenced in Jan. 2017 is targeted to be completed by end of 2021.

IAF helicopter evacuates 34 COVID-19 patients by air since July 2020 in Isles



Port Blair, Dec. 31

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands, while being host to some of the most scenic Islands on this planet, encounters myriad challenges for connectivity with the mainland in general and within the Islands in particular. This predicament became more glaring and predominant during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic which necessitated prompt evacuation of patients from various Islands to Port Blair.

The Indian Air Force helicopter flight at Air Force Station Car Nicobar under the Andaman & Nicobar Command was entrusted the responsibility of airlifting critical patients to Port Blair and have flown numerous missions by day as well as night since June this year.

A dedicated team of pilots and technicians were earmarked as the COVID-19 Evacuation Crew and kept in a state of readiness round the clock so as to get airborne at short notice. The maintenance team have ensured high operational readiness of the helicopters by working 24x7 to enable safe evacuation flying.

Strict COVID protocols and preventive measures were instituted for these Air Warriors which included stringent isolation for long periods so as to ensure the crew is available for 'COVID Safe' flying for evacuations at any time.

Innovative measures by creation of partitions ensured that the patient and crew were isolated from each other thereby reducing the risk of the infection to the aircrew during the flight. Despite the physical and mental challenges, these motivated professionals displayed exemplary dedication to duty and have been the 'flying angels' for our citizens evacuating nearly 34 COVID-19 patients by air since July 2020.

In the past few months, the helicopters have also been actively involved in medical evacuation of other critical patients and have evacuated patients which includes five ladies with complications in advance stages of pregnancy endorsing the adage associated with the helicopters of IAF - 'Aatsu Mitram' meaning a 'Friend in Distress', a press release from HQANC said.

launched ranged from accessing transport related services to electricity online billing and e-payment services by District Administration, South Andaman, DBT services to beneficiaries of various schemes launched by the Govt., Municipal tax payments, Swachhta related facilities, Scholarships schemes implemented by Social Welfare, Education besides common online admission portal for colleges and teaching-learning process. An application for exclusive use of Education Department related to students viz. Mark Statement, Conduct Certificate, Duration Certificate, Transfer Certificate etc. have also been launched and as on date about 262 schools in the Islands are using the application.

These online services being implemented by various Departments viz. Agriculture, Labour, Revenue, Health, Education, A&N Police, have revolutionized the functioning of Administration by making itself transparent and accessible by the citizens from any part of the Islands.

As we bid adieu to 2020 and usher in the year 2021, it is expected that more developmental projects are likely to become operational while some major ones are already progressing well and is forging ahead towards its completion.

The Zonal Fisheries Office, South Andaman is implementing the 'Beneficiary Oriented Component/Activities under CSS Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in South Andaman District for the year 2020-21.

Altogether 62 applications were received in the Zonal Office under various activities such as construction of ice plant, cold storage, refrigerated vehicle, purchase of deep sea fishing vessel, purchase of motor cycle/ three wheeler with ice box, fish feed mill, construction of new ponds for brackish water aquaculture, construction of bio-floc ponds for brackish water areas, establishment of small RAS/ bio-floc culture system, establishment of new fin fish hatcheries etc., out of which the DLC (PMMSY) approved 42 projects.

These schemes under CSS Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) would help in development of the Fisheries Sector in A&N Islands and also benefit the fishermen community of these Islands, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

CCS team arrests two ganja suppliers from Kolkata

Accused persons brought to Port Blair on transit remand and produced before Court

Port Blair, Dec. 31

In order to curb drug abuse and the issues arising out of this menace in these Islands, a chain of evidence was prepared in a professional manner and a team comprising SI Bisawjeet Prasad, Head Constable Upender Singh, Constable Hari Krishna Yadav and Samresh Mistry was deputed to mainland to arrest the drug peddlers from Kolkata, West Bengal who were assisting the drug peddlers of these Islands in supply of drugs.

On continuous follow up and technical analysis of the available evidence, the above mentioned team arrested one accused Chottu Sarkar on 23/12/2020 from Kolkata, West Bengal who used to supply ganja in these Islands. He was brought to Port Blair on transit remand and produced before the Hon'ble Court at Port Blair and remanded to judicial custody.

Earlier, on 09/12/2020 another accused namely Santanu Jana supplier of ganja to these

Islands was also arrested from Kolkata, West Bengal and is in judicial custody at Port Blair. This is the first time when such drug peddlers are being arrested from mainland and brought to Port Blair. The arrest of these 2 drug peddlers could be possible only due to the well co-ordinated supervision of Dy. SP CID and overall supervision of SP(CID) & SP(S/A), a press release from SP (CID) said.

Deadline for filing Income Tax Return extended further

storage and processing of dry and wet waste. The wet waste is being composted to organic manure, whereas the dry waste is sent for recycling. One Bailing machine has also been installed in the SWM cluster by the Department wherein all plastic and metal wastes are bailed for easy transportation.

Regular user-fees are also collected from households and commercial establishments for the management of solid waste.

Considering the unique ecology of the Islands, the Department is envisaging to ensure that zero waste goes to the landfill and that all wastes are properly treated and recycled, a press release from Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs said.

Development on these plots owned by the private individuals were not allowed and this leads to difficulty in taking up any development activities on their own private property. In order to resolve this issue, a modification proposal was finalized by the Administration by amending the Clause No. 5.2.3-H of Master Plan for Port Blair Planning Area and notified in A & N Gazette vide No. 6 dated 21/01/2020.

As per the Gazette Notification, a committee was constituted under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner (SA) with the representatives of Andaman Nicobar Command and Town & Country Planner, APWD as its members to examine the parcels of land demarcated to be excluded from the Defence land use zone as per the Master Plan for PBPA.

A meeting of the Committee was convened under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman District on 22/12/2020 to discuss the above matter and it was decided that the private/Govt. land falling outside the occupation of the Military and Defence Services which are inadvertently zoned as Defence Land use as per the Master Plan for PBPA shall be re-zoned as Public & Semi-Public land use as per the above Gazette Notification.

It is hereby informed that the private/Govt. properties located outside the Defence Area boundary which were earlier denied Planning Permission/Approval of Building Plan may resubmit their Plans in accordance with the Master Plan for PBPA for clearance, a press release from DC (SA) said.

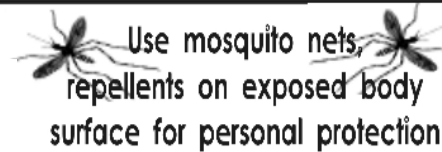

And whereas, as per Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 28.12.2020, it has been ordered by the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive Committee (NEC) that the above said guidelines will be in force upto 31.01.2021.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 24 (l) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned in the capacity as Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee, for the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby orders that the Guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution issued by MHA vide order dated 25.11.2020, shall remain in force upto 31.01.2021 for the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The Deputy Commissioners and Departments concerned may issue necessary Standard Operating Procedures to implement the orders.

Whereas, in exercise of the powers under section 6(2)(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has directed the undersigned to issue an order with guidelines for containment of COVID-19 in the country;

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers, conferred under Section 10(2)(1) of the Disaster Management Act 2005, the undersigned hereby directs that guidelines for surveillance, containment and caution, as annexed, will be in force upto 31.12.2020.

**Guidelines for Surveillance, Containment and Caution
[As per Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) Order No. 40-3/
2020-DM-I (A) dated 25th November, 2020]**

The country is at a critical juncture in its fight against COVID-19. The number of active cases has declined steadily over the last two months, from over 10 lakhs, on September 18, 2020, to less than 4.5 lakhs now. However, over the last few weeks, the number of new cases has been rising in some States and UTs, the confluence of certain factors, viz., the recent festival season and the onset of winter, and the laxity in observance of the COVID-19 guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) in certain parts of the country pose the risk of the situation becoming aggravated, thus putting a strain on the health infrastructure. In some States and UTs, the spike observed in the number of new cases has already led to re-imposition of restrictions such as Night Curfew, limitations on number of persons in gatherings, restricted timings of markets etc.

In the above context, with a view to consolidating the substantial gains that have been achieved against the spread of COVID-19, and to fully overcome the pandemic, the need of the hour is to maintain caution and strictly follow the prescribed containment strategy, focussed on surveillance, containment and strict observance of the guidelines.

Over the last few months, economic and other activities have been opened up in a phased manner, with the stipulation that the prescribed Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) be scrupulously followed. The essence behind graded reopening and progressive resumption of activities is to move ahead. However, there is a concomitant need to exercise due care. Every citizen must adopt COVID-19 appropriate behaviour, so as to ensure that the resumption of activities is successful and gains made in the management of the pandemic are not negated. The following guidelines are issued to be effective from 1st December 2020.

COVID appropriate behavior

1. State/ UT Governments shall take all necessary measures to promote COVID-19 appropriate behaviour. Strict enforcement of wearing of face masks, hand hygiene and social distancing must be ensured.
2. Wearing of face masks is an essential preventive measure. In order to enforce this core requirement, States and UTs may consider administrative actions, including imposition of appropriate fines, on persons not wearing face masks in public and work spaces.
3. Observance of social distancing in crowded places, especially in markets, weekly bazaars and public transport, is also critical for containing the spread of the infection. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) will issue a SOP to regulate crowds in market places, which shall be strictly enforced by States and UTs.
4. SOPs for regulating travel in aircrafts, trains and metro rails are already in place, which shall be strictly enforced. States and UTs shall issue necessary guidelines for regulating travel in other modes of public transport, e.g., buses, boats etc., and ensure that these are strictly complied with.
5. The National Directives for COVID-19 Management, as specified in Annexure I, shall be strictly followed throughout the country.

Surveillance and Containment

6. Effective demarcation of Containment Zones, in vulnerable and high incidence areas, is key to breaking the chain of transmission and controlling the spread of the virus. Containment Zones shall be carefully demarcated by the district authorities, at the micro level, taking into consideration the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in this regard. The list of Containment Zones will be notified on the websites by the respective District Collectors and by the States/ UTs. This list will also be shared with MoHFW.
7. Within the demarcated Containment Zones, containment measures, as prescribed by MoHFW, shall be scrupulously followed, as under:
 - i. Only essential activities shall be allowed in the Containment Zones.
 - ii. There shall be strict perimeter control to ensure that there is no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services.
 - iii. There shall be intensive house-to-house surveillance by surveillance teams formed for the purpose.
 - iv. Testing shall be carried out as per prescribed protocol.
 - v. Listing of contacts shall be carried out in respect of all persons found positive, along with their tracking, identification, quarantine and follow up of contacts for 14 days (80% of contacts to be traced in 72 hours).
 - vi. Quick isolation of COVID-19 patients shall be ensured in treatment facilities/ home (subject to fulfilling the home isolation guidelines).
 - vii. Clinical interventions, as prescribed, shall be administered.
 - viii. Surveillance for ILI/ SARI cases shall be carried out in health facilities or outreach mobile units or through fever clinics in buffer zones.
 - ix. Awareness shall be created in communities on COVID-19 appropriate behaviour.

8. It shall be the responsibility of local district, police and municipal authorities to ensure that the prescribed Containment measures are strictly followed. State/ UT Governments shall ensure accountability of the officers concerned in this regard. Strict adherence to the prescribed SOPs

9. All activities have been permitted outside Containment Zones, except for the following, which have been permitted with certain restrictions:

- i. International air travel of passengers, as permitted by MHA.
- ii. Cinema halls and theatres, with upto 50% capacity,
- iii. Swimming pools, only for training of sports persons,
- iv. Exhibition halls, only for business to business (B2B) purposes.
- v. Social/ religious/ sports/ entertainment/ educational/ cultural/ religious gatherings, with upto a maximum of 50% of the hall capacity, with a ceiling of 200 persons in closed spaces; and keeping of the size of the ground/ space in view, in open spaces.

However, based on their assessment of the situation, State/ UT Governments may reduce the ceiling to 100 persons or less, in closed spaces.

10. SOPs have been prescribed for various activities. These include: movement by passenger trains; air travel; metro trains; schools; higher educational institutions; hotels and restaurants; shopping malls, multiplexes and entertainment parks; yoga centres and gymnasiums; assemblies and congregations, etc.

11. For ease of reference, the list of activity wise SOPs with their web-links is given at Annexure II.

12. The SOPs shall be strictly enforced by the authorities concerned, who shall be responsible for their strict observance.

Local restrictions

13. States and UTs, based on their assessment of the situation, may impose local restrictions, with a view to contain the spread of COVID-19 such as night curfew. However, State/ UT Governments shall not impose any local lockdown (State/ District/ sub-division/City level), outside the containment zones, without prior consultation with the Central Government.

14. States and UTs also need to enforce social distancing in offices. In cities, where the weekly Case Positivity Rate is in more than 10%, States and UTs concerned shall consider implementing staggered office timings and other suitable measures, with a view to reduce the number of employees attending office at the same time, thereby ensuring social distancing.

15. There shall be no restriction on inter-State and intra-State movement of persons and goods including those for cross land-border trade under Treaties with neighbouring countries. No separate permission/ approval/ e-permit will be required for such movements.

Protection of vulnerable persons

16. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women, and children below the age of 10 years are advised to stay at home, except for essential and health purposes.

Use of Aarogya Setu

17. Aarogya Setu enables early identification of potential risk of infection, and thus acts as a shield for individuals and the community.

18. With a view to ensuring safety in offices and work places, employers on best effort basis should ensure that Aarogya Setu is installed by all employees having compatible mobile phones.

19. Organizations and Business entities with 50 or more employees are encouraged to avail the Aarogya Setu OpenAPI Service (<https://openapi.aarogyaasetu.gov.in>). OpenAPI feature will facilitate Organizations and employees to return to work in a COVID 19 risk free environment.

20. District authorities may advise individuals to install the Aarogya Setu application on compatible mobile phones and regularly update their health status on the app. This will facilitate timely provision of medical attention to those individuals who are at risk.

Strict enforcement of the guidelines

21. State/ UT Governments shall not dilute these guidelines issued under the Disaster Management Act, 2005, in any manner.

22. For the enforcement of social distancing, State/ UT Governments may, as far as possible, use the provisions of Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPc) of 1973.

23. All the District Magistrates shall strictly enforce the above measures.

Penal provisions

24. Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable. Extracts of these penal provisions are at Annexure III.

Annexure I

NATIONAL DIRECTIVES FOR COVID-19 MANAGEMENT

1. **Face coverings:** Wearing efface cover is compulsory in public places; in workplaces; and during transport.
2. **Social distancing:** Individuals must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet (2 gaz hi doori) in public places. Shops will ensure physical distancing among customers.
3. **Spitting in public places** will be punishable with fine, as may be prescribed by the State/ UT local authority in accordance with its laws, rules or regulations.

Additional directives for Work Places

4. **Work from home (WfH):** As far as possible the practice of WfH should be followed.
5. **Staggering of work/ business hours** will be followed in offices, work places, shops, markets and industrial & commercial establishments.
6. **Screening & hygiene:** Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash or sanitizer will be made at all entry points and of hand wash or sanitizer at exit points and common areas.
7. **Frequent sanitization** of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g. door handles etc., will be ensured, including between shifts.
8. **Social distancing:** All persons in charge of work places will ensure adequate distance between workers, adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc.

Annexure III

Offences and Penalties for Violation of Lockdown Measures

A. Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005

51. Punishment for obstruction, etc.-Whoever, without reasonable cause -

- (a) obstructs any officer or employee of the Central Government or the State Government, or a person authorised by the National Authority or State Authority or District Authority in the discharge of his functions under this Act; or
- (b) refuses to comply with any direction given by or on behalf of the Central Government or the State Government or the National Executive Committee or the State Executive Committee or the District Authority under this Act,

shall on conviction be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine, or with both, and if such obstruction or refusal to comply with directions results in loss of lives or imminent danger thereof, shall on conviction be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years.

52. Punishment for false claim.-Whoever knowingly makes a claim which he knows or has reason to believe to be false for obtaining any relief, assistance, repair, reconstruction or other benefits consequent to disaster from any officer of the Central Government, the State Government, the National Authority, the State Authority or the District Authority, shall, on conviction be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, and also with fine.

53. Punishment for misappropriation of money or materials, etc.-Whoever, being entrusted with any money or materials, or otherwise being, in custody of, or dominion over, any money or goods, meant for providing relief in any threatening disaster situation or disaster, misappropriates or appropriates for his own use or disposes of such money or materials or any part thereof or willfully compels any other person so to do, shall on conviction be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, and also with fine.

54. Punishment for false warning.-Whoever makes or circulates a false alarm or warning as to disaster or its severity or magnitude, leading to panic, shall on conviction, be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to one year or with fine.

55. Offences by Departments of the Government.-(1) Where an offence under this Act has been committed by any Department of the Government, the head of the Department shall be deemed to be guilty of the offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly unless he proves that the offence was committed without his knowledge or that he exercised all due diligence to prevent the commission of such offence.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1), where an offence under this Act has been committed by a Department of the Government and it is proved that the offence has been committed with the consent or connivance of, or is attributable to any neglect on the part of, any officer, other than the head of the Department, such officer shall be deemed to be guilty of that offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.

56. Failure of officer in duty or his connivance at the contravention of the provisions of this Act.-Any officer, on whom any duty has been imposed by or under this Act and who ceases or refuses to perform or withdraws himself from the duties of his office shall, unless he has obtained the express written permission of his official superior or has other lawful excuse for so doing, be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine.

57. Penalty for contravention of any order regarding requisitioning.-If any person contravenes any order made under section 65, he shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine or with both.

58. Offence by companies.-(1) Where an offence under this Act has been committed by a company or body corporate, every person who at the time the offence was committed, was in charge of, and was responsible to, the company, for the conduct of the business of the company, as well as the company, shall be deemed to be guilty of the contravention and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.

Provided that nothing in this sub-section shall render any such person liable to any punishment provided in this Act, if he proves that the offence was committed without his knowledge or that he exercised due diligence to prevent the commission of such offence.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1), where an offence under this Act has been committed by a company, and it is proved that the offence was committed with the consent or connivance of or is attributable to any neglect on the part of any director, manager, secretary or other officer of the company, such director, manager, secretary or other officer shall also, be deemed to be guilty of that offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.

Explanation.-For the purpose of this section-

- (a) "company" means anybody corporate and includes a firm or other association of individuals; and
- (b) "director", in relation to a firm, means a partner in the firm.

59. Previous sanction for prosecution. - No prosecution for offences punishable under sections 55 and 56 shall be instituted except with the previous sanction of the Central Government or the State Government, as the case may be, or of any officer authorised in this behalf, by general or special order, by such Government.

60. Cognizance of offences. - No court shall take cognizance of an offence under this Act except on a complaint made by -

- (a) the National Authority, the State Authority, the Central Government, the State Government, the District Authority or any other authority or officer authorised in this behalf by that Authority or Government, as the case may be; or
- (b) any person who has given notice of not less than thirty days in the manner prescribed, of the alleged offence and his intention to make a complaint to the National Authority, the State Authority, the Central Government, the State Government, the District Authority or any other authority or officer authorised as aforesaid.

B. Section 188 in the Indian Penal Code, 1860

188. Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant.

Whoever, knowing that, by an order promulgated by a public servant lawfully empowered to promulgate such order, he is directed to abstain from a certain act, or to take certain order with certain property in his possession or under his management, disobeys such direction, shall, if such disobedience causes or tends to cause obstruction, annoyance or injury, or risk of obstruction, annoyance or injury, to any person lawfully employed, be punished with simple imprisonment for a term which may extend to one month or with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees, or with both; and if such disobedience causes or tends to cause danger to human life, health or safety, or causes or tends to cause a riot or affray, shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to six months, or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees, or with both.

Explanation. - It is not necessary that the offender should intend to produce harm, or contemplate his disobedience as likely to produce harm. It is sufficient that he knows of the order which he disobeys, and that his disobedience produces, or is likely to produce, harm.

Illustration

An order is promulgated by a public servant lawfully empowered to promulgate such order, directing that a religious procession shall not pass down a certain street. A knowingly disobeys the order, and thereby causes danger of riot. A has committed the offence defined in this section.

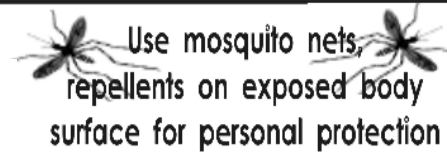
