UIDAI advises residents to not share Aadhaar openly in public domain

New Delhi, Dec. 31
The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has advised residents not to share their Aadhaar openly in the public domain, particularly on social media and other public platforms. Electronics and IT Ministry said, Aadhaar card holders should not disclose their Aadhaar OTP to any unauthorized entity and refrain from sharing m-Aadhaar PIN with anyone. It has asked the card holders to use Aadhaar confidentially to avail benefits and services, but observe the same level of caution as they do in the case of any other identity document. Aadhaar is a resident's digital ID, and it works



as a single source of online and offline identity verification for residents across the country. Residents can use their Aadhaar number to verify and validate their identity credentials either electronically or through offline verification.

The 18th Round of HIV Sentinel Surveillance (HSS) 2022-23 will be carried out in Andaman & Nicobar Islands from 1st January, 2023 to 31st March, 2023 along with the rest of the country. Surveillance is an ongoing, systematic collection, analysis interpretation and dissemination of data regarding a health related event for the use in public health action to reduce morbidity and mortality and to

PMEGP scheme - generating employment opportunities in rural & urban areas Financial assistance available for activities like dairy, poultry, aquaculture, sericulture including bees

Port Blair, Dec. 31
The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MoMSME) has conveyed some modifications in the existing Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) scheme. The main objective of the PMEGP scheme is to generate employment opportunities in rural as well as urban areas of the country through setting up of new self-employment ventures/projects/micro enterprises. The maximum cost of the project/unit admissible for margin money under subsidy has been increased from Rs. 25 lakhs to Rs. 50 lakhs whereas the same has been increased from Rs. 10 lakhs to Rs. 20 lakhs for Services/trading sector with a Govt. Subsidy upto 35% of the total project cost. Any individual above 18 years of age is eligible to avail the benefits under the

scheme with minimum educational qualification of VIII pass for projects above Rs.10 lakhs under manufacturing and above Rs.5 lakh under services/trading sector. Along with the other existing activities under the services sector, financial assistance can also be availed under PMEGP scheme for few more activities like dairy, poultry, aquaculture and sericulture including bees. An additional component namely expanding/upgrading the existing unit set up under PMEGP/REGP/MUDRA has been added, wherein the units already setup under PMEGP/REGP/MUDRA and performing very well in terms of turnover, profit making and loan repayment will be eligible for availing further financial assistance of up to Rs.1 crore for Manufacturing units and up to Rs. 25 lakhs for service/trading units through banks with uniform subsidy of 15% by the Government. Govt. hikes interest rates on small savings schemes

New Delhi, Dec. 31
Government has increased interest rates on various small savings schemes for the fourth quarter of the current Financial Year starting from 1st January, 2023. The interest rate of five year National Saving Certificate has been increased to 7 per cent from 6.8 per cent.

The Finance Ministry said, the interest rate on senior citizen saving scheme increased to 8 per cent from 7.6 per cent. The Monthly Income Account Saving has also been increased to 7.1 per cent from 6.7 per cent.

The interest rate on Kisan Vikas Patra will now be 7.2 percent and will mature in 120

months. The interest rate of small savings deposit of one year time period has been increased to 6.6 per cent from 5.5 per cent.

However, the interest rate on the Public Provident Fund scheme, Sukanya Samriddhi Account Scheme, and Saving Deposit have been kept unchanged. (Source: india.gov.in)

in COVID cases in few countries including China, Japan, South Korea, Singapore and Brazil. It was informed that as many as 1,716 International Flights have been screened and over five thousand samples collected for COVID-19 testing.

Principal Secretary to Prime Minister was informed that guidelines for International Arrivals has been revised on 29th of this month. As per the guidelines, all International arrivals from China, Singapore, Hongkong, South Korea, Thailand and Japan will undergo mandatory pre-departure RT-PCR testing from tomorrow. The passengers of these countries have to submit and upload negative RT-PCR test reports as well as self-declaration form on Air Suvidha Portal.

During the review meeting, it was stated that whole genome sequencing is being strengthened ensuring that larger number of samples are sent to Indian SARS-CoV-2 Genomics Consortium (INSACOG) Network. Around 500 samples received during this month are currently being genome sequenced by INSACOG Labs across the country. (Source: india.gov.in)
