## President Kovind launches Pulse Polio programme for 2019

New Delhi, March 9  
President Shri Ram Nath Kovind on Saturday launched the Pulse Polio programme for 2019 by administering polio drops to children on the eve of the National Immunization Day at the Rashtrapati Bhawan. More than 17 crore children of less than five years across the country will be given polio drops as part of the drive to sustain polio eradication from the country. Speaking on the occasion,



Health and Family Welfare Minister Shri J P Nadda said Universal Immunization Programme is focusing to protect children from more diseases than ever before. He said the programme

has introduced several new vaccines like Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine, Rotavirus vaccine, and Measles-Rubella vaccine in the recent past. The Minister said that the government has also introduced the injectable Inactivated Polio Vaccine into its routine immunization programme to provide additional protection to children. Shri Nadda informed that strengthening of immunization programme

has contributed significantly in decline of Infant Mortality Rate from 39 per thousand live births in 2014 to 32 in 2017. He elaborated that more than 3.39 crore children and 87 lakh pregnant women have been vaccinated under Mission Inradhanush.

### APPEAL

It is matter of pride that India has remained free of wild polio cases since January 2011. India's unprecedented progress against Polio has led to its certification as Polio free in March, 2014. For protection against re-introduction of Polio virus, the Pulse Polio Day is being organized on 10th March 2019, covering all the children in the age group of 0-5 years of age.

I appeal to all sections of society, especially PRI members, Non-Government Organization and people at the grass root level to extend their whole-hearted and vigorous co-operation to make the Intensive Pulse Polio Immunization Campaign on 10th March 2019 resound a success.

Out of the total 611 pre-litigation bank recovery cases, 928 pre-litigation BSNL recovery cases and 167 cases pending in

different courts at Port Blair referred to the National Lok Adalat, 19 pre-litigation bank recovery cases, 27 pre-litigation BSNL recovery cases and 47 Criminal cases pending in courts have been settled and finally disposed of by the National Lok Adalat at Port Blair. Disposing of 19 bank recovery cases, the involved amount of Rs. 1670507.18 have been settled at Rs.62,6000/- thus

**All eyes on Rishabh Pant as India take on Australia in Mohali**

Young Rishabh Pant will strive to seal a slot in the World Cup squad even as India fret about their top-order woes ahead of the fourth ODI against Australia, on Sunday. Providing opportunities to all Cup hopefuls would be on Virat Kohli's mind and the team management is expected to ring in a few changes in the playing XI in the remaining two matches of the series.

Mahendra Singh Dhoni seems to have played his last international game in Ranchi and now Pant gets a chance to book his boarding pass for the London-bound flight. In earlier ODIs, Pant had played purely as a batsman but with Dhoni being rested, Pant will get a chance to don the big gloves. The Indian playing XI will also have Bhuvneshwar Kumar on Sunday as he replaces Mohammed Shami, who was hit on the leg in his follow through during the third match.

Shami completed his spell but since he will be sharing the new ball with Jasprit Bumrah in England, it is natural to give him precautionary rest. "We will have a few changes in the next couple of games but the



idea is to tell the boys to put in match-winning performances and the boys will be looking to be in top form before the flight to England," Kohli said after the third ODI. However, what will keep the Indian team worried is the batting form of the top-order, save skipper Kohli, who has been lock, stock and barrel above everyone in his team. Kohli has 283 runs in three games with two hundreds and the next best in the Indian team is Kedar Jadhav with 118 runs. Rohit Sharma is undergoing a rare slump in ODIs, having scored only 51 runs in three innings. Even worse is Ambati Rayudu's performance at No 4 with an aggregate of 33 runs in three games. Shikhar Dhawan's struggles are

**Steve Smith, David Warner omitted from Australian ODI squad against Pakistan**

UAE, Mar 9  
Steve Smith and David Warner will have to find form in the Indian Premier League (IPL), to win places in Australia's squad for the World Cup after being left out of the final warm-up series against Pakistan in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).



Selectors named an unchanged 15-man squad for the five ODI matches in the Gulf and said it had been agreed, that the Twenty20 competition in India was the 'best pathway' for the pair as they each recover from elbow injuries and serve out the final weeks of their ball-tampering bans. "Cricket Australia will continue to liaise with both Steve, David and their IPL clubs to monitor progress as we build towards the ICC World Cup and the Ashes," selector Trevor Hohns said in a media release. The pair's ball-tampering bans

expire on March 28, which would have made them eligible to play in the final two matches of the UAE series in Dubai on March 29 and March 31. Smith will play for Rajasthan Royals, with Warner to feature for Sunrisers Hyderabad in the IPL, which starts March 23. The 15-man squad for the World Cup will be named on April 23. In a blow for Australia's hopes of building momentum for the World Cup in England starting late May, pace spearhead Mitchell Starc has been ruled out of the squad after a setback

during his recovery from a left pectoral strain. 

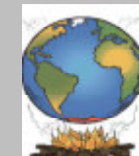
