PM inaugurates Asia's Mega solar project in MP's Rewa

Solar energy will be a medium of energy needs of the 21st century as solar power is sure, pure and secure: PM

New Delhi, July 10 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi dedicated to the Nation the Rewa Ultra Mega Solar Power project via video conference today. It is Asia's largest power project. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister said the Rewa project would make the entire region a major hub for pure and clean energy in this decade. The Prime Minister praised the effort stating that it will also supply power to the Delhi Metro, along with the entire region surrounding Rewa.

The Prime Minister said very soon Madhya Pradesh would be the main centre of Solar Energy in India, as such major projects are in progress in Neemuch, Shajapur, Chattarpur and Omkareshwar. The biggest beneficiaries of this would be the poor, the middle class, the tribals, the farmers of Madhya Pradesh, he said. Prime Minister said



Solar Energy would be a major medium for providing the energy needs of an aspirational India in the 21st Century.

The Prime Minister described Solar Energy as one which is 'Sure, Pure & Secure'. Sure because of the continuous supply of Energy from the Sun, Pure as it is environment friendly and Secure because it is a secure source for our energy needs. Prime Minister termed such Solar Energy projects are a true representation of Aatmanirbhar Bharat (Self-Reliant India).

The Prime Minister said the economy is an important aspect of self-reliance and progress. Referring to the regular dilemma whether to focus on Economy or Ecology, Prime Minister said India resolved such dilemmas by focusing on Solar Energy Projects and other environment friendly measures. Shri Modi said Economy and Ecology are not contradictory but complementary to each other. He said in all the programs of the Government, priority is being given to environmental protection as well as Ease of Living. He referred to programmes like Swachh Bharat, supply of LPG cylinders to the poor households, the development of CNG networks as one which focussed on Ease of Living and improving the lives of the poor and the middle class.

Registrar General of India releases Sample Registration System Bulletin of 2018

Significant achievement by A&N Islands in lowering Infant Mortality Rate

IMR drops to 9 from 14 compared to previous year

Port Blair, July 10

The Registrar General of India had recently released the Sample Registration System (SRS) Bulletin for the period of 2018. It is heartening to note that as per the report, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands has registered the highest decline in its Infant Mortality Rate by 5 points- in SRS 2018 as compared to SRS 2017. The Infant Mortality Rate in Sample Registration System 2017 was 14 whereas the Infant Mortality Rate in Sample Registration System 2018 stands at 9. This 5 points decline in the mortality rate is a significant achievement in the Health sector of A&N Islands. This is a positive achievement in the service extended for special care of the child in the age group between 0-1 year. The SRS 2018 reveals that in comparison with other Union Territories, Andaman and Nicobar Islands is the only territory, which has achieved a single digit IMR 9 whereas other Union Territories are in double digits between 11 to 16.



It is worth mentioning that the Infant Mortality Rate of A & N Islands is significantly lower than the National average. The National average of SRS 2018 is 32 while the national level average of IMR in SRS 2017 was 33.

The Infant Mortality Rate is calculated based on the number of deaths under one year of age occurring among the live births in a given geographical area during a given year, per 1000 live births occurring among the population of the given geographical area during the same year.

This noteworthy achievement has been possible due to series of awareness conducted by the Health Department of A&N Administration to assess the health status of all infants by involving stakeholders of departments of their respective

jurisdiction. Under the supervision of Medical Officer i/c of the respective Health Institutions, frequent home visits are being done by ANMs, Lady Health Visitors, Male Health Workers, ASHAs and Anganwadi Workers.

During the home visits, the field Health functionaries focuses specially on low birth weight babies, sick new born babies and Special Newborn Care Units (SNCU) discharged babies. Preferences are given to mother and children from hard to reach area, migrants, destitute, labourers, slum dwellers and disabled etc.

During meetings, mothers are counselled how to care for newborns. Special screening are also conducted for all newborn babies for birth defects at delivery points by health officials.

limited to just a few projects, but it is the Way of Life. PM said it is ensured that the determination towards clean energy is seen in every aspect of life, when launching large projects of renewable energy. Government is making sure that its benefits reach every corner of the country, every section of society, every citizen. He elaborated this with an example of how the introduction of LED bulbs has reduced the electricity bill. Nearly 40 million tons of carbon dioxide is prevented from going into the environment, due to the LED bulb. He said this also reduced the Electricity Usage by 6 Billion Units and accrued a saving of Rs 24,000 Crore to the exchequer. He said that the Government is working towards making our environment, our air, our water also to remain pure and this thinking is also reflected in the policy and strategy on solar energy.

Shri Modi said India's exemplary progress in the field of Solar Energy would be a major source of interest to the World. He said owing to such major steps, India is being considered as the most attractive market of clean energy. The Prime Minister said that the International Solar Alliance (ISA) was launched with the motive to unite the entire World in terms of solar energy. He said the spirit behind was One World, One Sun, One Grid. The Prime Minister expressed confidence that Madhya Pradesh's farmers will also make use of the Government's KUSUM Program and will install Solar Energy plants in their lands as an additional source of income. He expressed the hope that very soon India will be a major exporter of power. Prime Minister said India is also focussing on reducing its dependence on imports of various hardware needed for solar plants, like Photovoltaic Cells, Battery and Storage.

The Prime Minister said the work is progressing rapidly in this direction and the Government is encouraging the Industry, the youth, MSMEs and StartUps to not miss this opportunity and work for production and betterment of all the inputs required for Solar Energy.

Referring to the ongoing crisis owing to the pandemic COVID-19, the Prime Minister said for either the Government or the society, compassion and vigilance are the greatest motivators to tackle this difficult challenge. He said right from the beginning of the Lockdown, the Government ensured that the poor and needy are assured of supply of food and fuel. He said with the same spirit, the Government decided to continue the free supply of food and LPG till November this year, even during the phase of unlockdown. Not only this, the Government is also giving full contribution to the EPF account of millions of private sector employees. Similarly, through the PM-Swanidhi scheme, those who have the least access to the system get benefitted. He added that when people are moving out of their home to make Madhya Pradesh great, they should follow these rules - maintaining a distance of two yards, wearing a mask on the face and washing hands with soap for at least 20 seconds.

incorporate the global best practices, technological developments and India's International obligations in the field of Aids to Marine Navigation.

Union Minister of State of Shipping (I/C), Shri Mansukh Mandaviya said that this initiative is part of the proactive approach adopted by the Ministry of Shipping by repealing archaic colonial laws and replacing it with modern and contemporary needs of the maritime industry. Shri Mandaviya also added that suggestions from the public and stakeholders will strengthen the provisions of the legislation. He further added that the bill aims to regulate state-of-the-art technologies of marine navigation which was earlier used to tangle in statutory provisions of Lighthouse Act, 1927.

The draft bill provides for empowering Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships (DGLL) with additional power and functions such as Vessel Traffic Service, Wreck flagging, training and certification, implementation of other obligations under International Conventions, where India is a signatory. It also provides for identification and development of heritage lighthouses.

The draft bill comprises a new schedule of offences, along with commensurate penalties for obstructing and damaging the aids to navigation, and non-compliance with directives issued by the Central Government and other bodies under the draft bill.

With the advent of modern technologically improved aids to maritime navigation, the role of authorities regulating and operating maritime navigation has changed drastically. Therefore the new law encompasses a major shift from lighthouses to modern aids of navigation.


