An official release said, with this commendable scientific achievement, India has crossed an important milestone in building its overall capability towards enhanced security against incoming ballistic missile threats. The country has entered an exclusive club of four nations with developing capabilities to secure its skies and cities against hostile threats. DRDO sources said, the interceptor is a 7.5-metre-long single stage solid rocket propelled guided missile equipped with a navigation system, a hi-tech computer and an

electro-mechanical activator would intercept a target, mimicking an incoming enemy missile, mid-air. Defence sources said today's test was mainly to assess the weapon's killing capability. The Advanced Air Defence interceptor, dubbed as Ashwin, will destroy the incoming missile in the endo-atmospheric region at a low altitude of less than 30 kilometres.

DLSA organizes Lok Adalat in different parts of Isles

Disposes off large number of cases providing relief to litigants

Port Blair, Feb 11 The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman and Nicobar Islands organized Lok Adalat at Port Blair, Mayabunder, Diglipur, Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay today. As many as 385 criminal cases, 79 civil cases and 318 pre-litigation disputes involving different banks at Port Blair were placed before the National Lok Adalat at Port Blair for which three Benches headed by Shri Siddhartha Kanjilal, District and Sessions Judge & Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Shri Debasish Bandyopadhyay, Additional District and



Sessions Judge and Shri Amitabha Das, Chief Judicial Magistrate Port Blair were constituted. The National Lok Adalat at Port Blair disposed of as many as 36 pre-litigation cases of different banks at Port Blair with their defaulting loan customers involving an amount of Rs.

80,11,895 which was settled at Rs. 43,43,844 thus getting a huge benefit of Rs. 36,68,051 by the loan customers. The Banks got a sum of Rs. 1, 57,000 on the spot in the Lok Adalat. Besides pre-litigation cases, the National Lok Adalat also disposed of 73 criminal cases and three motor

accident claim cases pending in the courts and MAC Tribunals. Out of the 73 criminal cases disposed of, government revenue of Rs. 19,350 was imposed and realized as compensation. 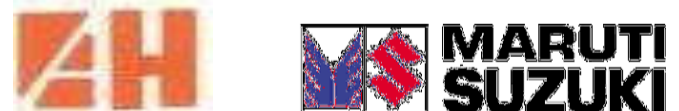
