PM to go on day-long fasting today; MP seeks people's support

Port Blair, April 11
Due to continued interruptions by the opposition in Lok Sabha/Rajya Sabha during entire second part of Budget Session from 5th March, 2018 to 6th April, 2018, the normal legislative & other business which was meant for discussion on important issues related to common man, could not be transacted. The opposition has been consistently disrupting Parliament and did not allow the Government to bring important legislations which are aimed at making India stronger and a better nation.

The expenses towards business of the Parliament is around Rs. 2.5 Lacs per minute. In this budget session, total lapse of business was for 128 Hrs. Therefore, a loss of Rs. 192

Ayushman Bharat Diwas on April 30, Kisan Kalyaan Diwas on May 2 and Aajeevika Diwas on May 5.

Conference of Lt Governors/Administrators of UTs held Reviews progress made in implementation of various schemes of Govt of India

Best practices among UTs to be shared; SOPs to be developed

Port Blair, April 11

A conference of Lt Governors / Administrators of Union Territories & review meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Governor of Punjab and Administrator of UT Chandigarh, Shri V.P.Singh Badnore at the Megapode Nest here today in the presence of Lt. Governor of Puducherry, Dr Kiran Bedi and Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd). The meeting was also attended by Shri Inder Jit Singh, Secretary (Coordination), Cabinet Secretariat, Shri Parimal Rai, Advisor to the Administrator of Chandigarh and Shri P.K. Srivastava, Additional Secretary (UT), Ministry of Home Affairs.

The meeting reviewed the decisions taken in the meeting held on 13.10.2017, the implementation of various schemes of UTs, to share best practices being followed by UTs and to devise an implementation mechanism for 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan'. This meeting also presented an opportunity for networking amongst the UTs and to learn and replicate good practices being followed amongst various constituents. The Governor of Punjab, Shri VP Singh welcomed the gathering and highlighted the expectations of the Prime Minister from the UTs with regard to various Govt. of India schemes. He also highlighted the best practices adopted in UT of Chandigarh wherein new cycle tracks are being developed to encourage cycling as a mode of transport. Also a mobile special education facility called 'Kalam Express', using CSR funds has been started for 'Divyang' children.

The Lt Governor, Puducherry, Dr Kiran Bedi, while thanking Andaman & Nicobar Administration for taking the initiative for building strong network of UTs, highlighted the positive works being taken up in Puducherry and explained that the financial health of the UT has improved. She highlighted the better utilization of funds from Centrally Sponsored Schemes. The various activities taken up by the Raj Niwas in Puducherry to make it people friendly was showcased as a best practice.

The Lt Governor of A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi highlighted various challenges related to



logistics in Andamans and also informed the major infrastructure projects being taken up in the road, power and tourism sectors which would bear fruits in the next three years. He also highlighted the scheme for providing incentives for collection of plastic waste. The ambitious programme for solarization of power and to substantially reduce highly polluting diesel generation was elaborated upon. Amongst the good practices, the framing of Regulation for Sports Fishing Activities was highlighted.

Thereafter, the Additional Secretary (UT), Shri PK Srivastava made a presentation regarding performance of the UTs on the various PM monitored schemes. The review covered performances under Swachh Bharat Mission, PMAY, DBT, Jan Dhan Yojana, NHM, SSA etc. The Senior Officers of the UTs gave reports on the actions initiated by them to ensure timely completion of the activities. It was also felt that aggressive publicity for all the schemes needs to be done to ensure universal

coverage as per eligibility criteria for all the schemes. The publicity would need to be done through AIR, Doordarshan, local media and intensive word of mouth publicity through PRIs etc.

The Secretary (Coordination), Shri Inder Jit Singh explained the Gram Swaraj Abhiyan, being launched by the Prime Minister on 14th April and the timelines set for various UTs. He informed that across the country 21058 villages have been selected wherein the Schemes would be rolled out. The schemes covered 7 pro-poor initiatives namely Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (LPG Connections for eligible families), Saubhagya (Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana), Ujala Scheme (Unnat Jyoti by Affordable LEDs for All), Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana and Mission Indradhanush (Immunization of children under 2 years & all pregnant women). It was informed that 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan' is an

intensive focused mission for saturation of coverage with the partnership of Central Government, UT Administration, local governments and Self Help Groups. For effective implementation of the Abhiyan, all Departments concerned have been given specific responsibilities and a monitoring dashboard has been created for daily update on progress made by each UT. Shooter Shreyasi Singh gives India its 12th Gold medal of Commonwealth Games; India maintains third position

Gold Coast, Apr 11

India's shooters have continued to carry the country's flag high, with one gold medal and two bronze, increasing the overall medal tally to 24 during day seven of the 2018 Commonwealth Games. Topping the list of winners was the 2014 Glasgow Games silver medalist Shreyasi Singh, who upgrading her colour to gold by winning the women's double trap final. Om Mitharval won his second bronze of the Gold Coast Games, finishing third in the 50m pistol men's finals, before India's top ranked double trap shooter Ankur Mittal also claimed bronze in the double trap men's finals. Shreyasi's medal has taken India's overall gold tally at the CWG to 12, and with five-time world champion and Olympic bronze medalist MC Mary Kom today progressing to the final of the women's 45-48kg boxing event, more can be expected.

Leading the way for India's very strong boxing contingent was Mary Kom, who breezed into her final later this week. Making her CWG debut at the age of 35, the reigning Asian champion beat Sri Lanka's Anusha Dilrukshi 5-0.

Also progressing in boxing were Gaurav Solanki, who defeated Papua New Guinea's Charles Keama by a unanimous 5-0 verdict in the men's 52kg quarter-final, and Vikas Krishan by the same margin in his 75kg quarter-final versus Zambia's Benny Muziyo. Later in the day, Manish Kaushik also entered semi-finals after beating Calum French of England 5-0 in the men's 60kg category.

Elsewhere, Saina Nehwal got the badminton events underway with a crushing 21-3, 21-1 win over South Africa's Elsie de Villiers in the women's singles round of 32. Next up, World No 2 Kidambi Srikanth brushed aside Mauritius' Aatish Lubah 21-13, 21-10 to enter the round of 16. Making her first appearance at the Games, PV Sindhu dispatched of Fiji's Andra Whiteside 21-6, 21-3. Ruthvika Gadde followed with a 21-5, 21-7 win over Ghana's Grace Apitaka, as did HS Prannoy who beat Christopher Jean Paul of Mauritius 21-14, 21-6.

In the badminton mixed doubles event, the pairs of Satwik Rankireddy/Ashwini Ponnappa and Pranaav Chopra/Sikhi Reddy registered comfortable victories in their respective round of 32 matches. Rankireddy and Ponnappa beat Ben Lane and Jessica Pugh of England 21-17, 21-16, while Chopra and Reddy defeated Burt Molia and Karyn Gibson of Fiji 21-8, 21-9.

India men's hockey team, who has already booked its slot in the semi-finals, registered a thrilling 4-3 victory over England in its final group match and topped Pool B with 10 points. India went into half-time break trailing 0-1 and at one point, with just four minutes left in the game, they were behind again at 2-3. But the silver-medalists from Glasgow scored two goals in final two minutes and avoided Australia in the semis.

In the squash men's doubles, the pair of Vikram Malhotra and Ramit Tandon won 2-1 over Wales' Peter Creed and Joel Makin while the women's doubles pair of Joshna Chinnappa and Dipika Pallikal Karthik defeated the Welsh duo of Tesni Evans and Deon Saffery 2-1 in Pool C. Later in the day, Joshna and Dipika beat Malta's Dianne Kelas and Colette Sultana 2-0.

From the women's singles table tennis round of 32, India's Madhurika Patkar beat T&T's Rheann Chung 4-1 to enter the pre-quarters. In the women's doubles round of 32, Sutirtha Mukherjee and Pooja Sahasrabudhe defeated Mauritius' Ruqayyah Kinoo and Sanjana Alex Ramaswamy 3-0, after which Achanta Sharath and Sathiyana Gnanasekaran blanked Kiribati's Tauramoa Miita and Nooa Takooa 3-0 in the men's doubles round of 32. In the men's doubles round of 32, Harmeet Desai and Sanil Shetty defeated their Guyanese opponents 3-0 before Desai teamed up with Sahasrabudhe in the mixed doubles round of 32 match and lost 1-3 to Malaysia. Sharath and Mouma Das won their mixed doubles fixture 3-1. Manika Batra, who led the TT women's team to India's first gold medal at the CWG on Sunday, then paired Sathiyana to claim a 3-0 win over Malaysia in the mixed doubles. Adding another tick in the W column was the mixed doubles partnership of Shetty and Patkar, who blanked their Sri Lanka opponents 3-0.

In men's singles round of 32 contest, Achanta Sharath Kamal and Sathiyana Gnanasekaran progressed to the next round after registering contrasting victories. Kamal beat Javen Choong of Malaysia 4-3 in a seven-game thriller, while Gnanasekaran made a short work of Pakistan's Muhammad Rameez, winning the contest 3-0.

In lawn bowls, Krishna Xalxo lost 0-21 in the men's singles round 5 and the women's pairs team was beaten 17-19 by South Africa in round 4. In the TT6-10 (women's singles) event, Maitrayee Sarkar won 3-0 and Vaishnavi Sutar lost 0-3.
