Hon'ble Prime Minister chairs 11th Governing Council Meeting of NITI Aayog

Vision of Viksit Bharat should become the collective resolve of every State, district, block and village: Hon'ble PM

Hon'ble PM highlights the need for coordinated efforts to address emerging social challenges such as drug abuse and cyber fraud

New Delhi, June 11 (PIB)

Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi chaired the 11th Governing Council Meeting of NITI Aayog at Rashtrapati Bhavan Cultural Centre, New Delhi, earlier today. This year's theme was Inclusive Human Development for Viksit Bharat@2047. It was attended by Chief Ministers, Lt. Governors and Administrators representing 28 States and 5 UTs. This was the first time when Chief Ministers of all 28 States participated in the Governing Council Meeting of NITI Aayog.

Hon'ble Prime Minister noted that at a time when many major economies are facing uncertainty and economic challenges, India's growth story continues to inspire the world. He emphasized the need to further strengthen the nation's resolve towards self-reliance and highlighted the importance of adopting and implementing



global best practices, particularly in the renewable energy sector.

Underscoring the importance of cooperative federalism, Hon'ble Prime Minister stated that the Centre and the States must work together to achieve the goal of a Viksit Bharat. He stressed that the vision of Viksit Bharat should become the collective resolve of every State, district,

block and village. Highlighting the strength of India's demographic profile, Hon'ble Prime Minister observed that the country's youth constitute its greatest asset, with nearly 70 crore Indians below the age of 25 years. Calling this a demographic dividend, he urged States to focus on transforming it into a development dividend through education,

skilling and capacity-building initiatives that prepare young people for future opportunities and challenges. Referring to India's recently concluded trade agreements with several countries, Hon'ble Prime Minister encouraged States to create opportunities for youth and MSMEs and to equip stakeholders to effectively leverage the benefits arising from these agreements. He

also urged States to actively attract investments from partner countries. Emphasizing women-led development, Hon'ble Prime Minister called upon States to work towards increasing the number of Lakhpati Didis from 3 crore to 6 crore and stressed the importance of ensuring a safe and secure environment for Nari Shakti.

Hon'ble Prime Minister urged States to focus on One District One Product (ODOP) initiatives and develop export-oriented strategies around it. He also identified defence manufacturing as an emerging sector where India is establishing a distinct identity and encouraged States to formulate policies to leverage the opportunities arising from its growth.

Minister highlighted the need for coordinated efforts to address emerging social challenges such as drug abuse and cyber fraud through preventive measures, awareness campaigns and effective governance. Hon'ble Prime Minister also drew attention to concerns arising from El Niño conditions and appealed to States to promote water conservation and

encourage natural and organic farming practices. He noted that the purchase of 11 lakh tonnes of organic manure by farmers during the current Kharif season reflected growing confidence in sustainable agriculture. Hon'ble Prime Minister emphasized the need to evaluate progress at the district level, particularly through aspirational district parameters. Hon'ble Prime Minister suggested that on similar lines, 100 districts should be identified in the field of agriculture to bring positive results. He urged the States to take lead in this pursuit so that a phenomenal change can be achieved through the aspirational approach.

Hon'ble Prime Minister emphasised the need for a monitoring framework and targeted 100-day and five-year goals towards achieving the vision of Viksit Bharat@2047. (Contd. on last page)

Hon'ble Member of Parliament, A&N Islands, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, today met Dr. Satish, Director, CGHS HQ, at New Delhi to pursue the long-pending proposal for the establishment and operationalisation of a CGHS Wellness Centre at Sri Vijaya Puram for the benefit of retired Government employees and pensioners of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration.

During the meeting, the Director, CGHS



informed the Hon'ble MP that the issue raised by him has already been processed by the CGHS HQ making necessary recommendations for the creation of a CGHS Wellness Centre at Sri Vijaya Puram. Subsequently, Hon'ble MP also further

enquired the matter with the Employees Health Scheme Division under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare regarding the status of the proposal received from the CGHS HQ. It was informed that the matter is presently under active

consideration of the Ministry for taking an appropriate policy decision on the establishment of a CGHS Centre within the available resources in the Health Department of A&N Administration.

The proposed CGHS Wellness Centre would enable eligible beneficiaries to avail cashless treatment at CGHS-empanelled hospitals across the country in accordance with CGHS norms, thereby providing

For just a fleeting moment under the pristine water of Swaraj Dweep, a group of divers converted months of hard work into a world record. Together, they managed to set up the tallest human pyramid under the water, breaking a record and earning themselves a place in the Guinness World Records.

This was a difficult task that needed great coordination among the participants. Not only were they required to form such a tall structure, but they were also supposed to stay perfectly balanced underwater. This record-setting experience also demonstrated the growing



popularity of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands as a tourist destination.

It is now a common trend among tourists to go for something new and unusual. As

adventure tourism continues to expand across the islands, record-breaking underwater activities are attracting visitors seeking experiences that go beyond traditional beach holidays. How a record-breaking underwater human tower made Guinness World Records history

World Records, the structure reached an official height of 22.3 metres (73.16 feet), setting a new world record for the tallest human stack underwater.

Guinness World Records states:

"The tallest human stack underwater measures 22.3 metres."

Building a human tower on land requires strength and balance. Recreating one underwater introduces an entirely different set of challenges. Divers must carefully control buoyancy, maintain positioning and remain coordinated despite limited visual references beneath the surface.

The successful attempt demonstrated not only physical skill but also meticulous planning and teamwork, establishing a new benchmark for underwater record attempts.

Why the Andaman Islands are becoming a leading destination for diving and adventure tourism

Although the event received attention worldwide, the project had an underlying goal. According to Guinness World Records, the project was meant to showcase the Andaman and Nicobar Islands as a top diving destination in the world.

According to the record's official submission statement, the project aimed at:

"Promoting Andaman and Nicobar Islands as a premier global diving destination."

The Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been known for years as being one of the best destinations for diving due to the presence of clear water and diverse coral reefs. The islands have some of the best-known dive locations in India.

The most recent Guinness World Record has only served to enhance the profile of this area internationally, and it now draws attention to the natural beauty and tourism value of the Andaman Islands.

The cooperation, leadership, and preparation for the world-record dive

The record-breaking required huge amounts of logistics that included training and preparation of divers, diving safety, and coordination underwater. Each person had to maintain their position perfectly while helping maintain the balance of the formation underwater.

One of the most notable aspects of the achievement was the participation of Admiral D.K. Joshi (Retd.), Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Guinness World Records confirmed that he took part in the successful record attempt alongside the diving team. The organisation noted that his involvement reflected the administration's commitment to promoting tourism and raising global awareness of the islands.

Yet the record was about more than numbers. It showcased what can be achieved when preparation, discipline, and teamwork come together in pursuit of a shared goal. For the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the achievement represents not only a place in the record books but also an opportunity to introduce one of India's most spectacular marine destinations to a wider international audience. MALARIA मलेरिया
