PMFBY coverage for paddy crop in all Districts of A&N Islands

Farmers to get insurance protection without paying premium; cut-off date for enrolment is Aug. 31

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 11

Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) is one of the Flagship Schemes of the Govt. of India. The scheme is being implemented in these islands since 2016. The scheme envisages providing Insurance coverage to the registered farmers under PMFBY towards crop loss arising out of unforeseen events viz. drought, dry spells, flood, inundation, pests and diseases, landslides, natural fire and lightning, storm, hailstorm, cyclone, typhoon, tempest, hurricane and tornado etc. The scheme ensures flow of credit to the agriculture sector and stabilizes the income of the farmers.

The Paddy is the notified crops under PMFBY for Kharif 2026 seasons in all 3 Districts of this UT. The indemnity level for all notified crops is 80% for both Kharif 2026 seasons.

All farmers (loanee and non-loanee) enrolled under PMFBY



shall be eligible for coverage under the scheme. Farmers will not be required to pay any premium, as the entire premium is fully subsidized by the Government. The full actuarial premium shall be borne by the Government for all notified crops sown in the notified area.

PMFBY covers risks of losses arising from either of the possibilities of Prevented Sowing, Sowing to Harvesting (due to dry spells, flood,

inundation, pests and diseases, landslides, natural fire and lightning, storm, cyclone, etc), Post-Harvest Losses up to a maximum period of two weeks from harvesting, for those crops which are required to be dried in cut and spread/small bundled condition depending on crops in that area, in the field after harvesting against Cyclone, Cyclonic rains and Unseasonal rains.

All farmers including share

croppers and tenant farmers growing the notified crops in the notified area are eligible for coverage. Such farmers are required to submit the necessary documentary evidence of land records prevailing in the UT (record of right, land possession certificate) or other document notified/permitted by the UT. The cut-off date for the enrolment under the scheme for Kharif 2026 is 31.08.2026. The farmers have to approach the SBI or Co-operative Bank of concerned areas along with land records and enroll under the scheme or they may even register themselves in the National Crop Insurance Portal (NCIP) i.e. pmfby.gov.in.

After enrolment, any losses to the crop arising out of risks may be intimated Immediately (within 72 hours) by the insured farmer directly or through his own mobile or land line phone or any of his own media or toll free numbers, if any to the

Awareness prog. on dog bite prevention and management conducted at GSSS Campbell Bay

Campbell Bay, Aug. 11

The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services (AH&VS) organised and conducted an awareness programme on preventive steps for avoiding dog bites and dog bite management at Government Senior Secondary School (GSSS), Campbell Bay on Aug. 7. The programme was organised with the objective of educating school students and teachers about safe behaviour around dogs, prevention of dog bite incidents, and the importance of prompt action in case of animal bites. A total of 58 students of Class XI and 6 teachers participated in the session.

During the awareness programme, the participants were educated on understanding dog behaviour and warning signs, dos and don'ts to be



followed while encountering dogs, and the immediate steps to be taken in the event of a dog bite. Special emphasis was laid on avoiding provocation of dogs, maintaining a safe distance from unfamiliar animals, thoroughly washing the wound with soap and running water for at least 15 minutes, informing elders or teachers immediately, and seeking prompt medical attention along with Anti-Rabies Vaccination (ARV) without delay.

The session was interactive and the students actively engaged by asking relevant

questions and clarifying their doubts. The programme also highlighted the importance of responsible behaviour towards animals and the role of the community in effective stray dog management.

The Department of AH&VS continues to conduct such awareness programmes in schools across the Islands to promote public health, responsible behaviour towards animals, and effective prevention of dog bites and rabies among young students and the local community, a press release from Dept. of AH&VS said.

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 11 The Division of Fisheries Science, ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (ICAR-CIARI), Sri Vijaya Puram, organised a one-day workshop on "Biosecurity and Quarantine Protocols to Curb Aquatic Animal Diseases in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands" under the National Surveillance Programme for Aquatic Animal Diseases (NSPAAD) Phase-II project on August 10, 2026.

The objective of the programme was to create awareness and strengthen the capacity of fisheries stakeholders on aquatic animal health, disease prevention, farm biosecurity, quarantine and disease surveillance. Dr. Muruganandam, Head, Division of Fisheries Science, served as the Convener of the workshop which brought together a diverse group of stakeholders, including officials and field personnel of the

Department of Fisheries, shrimp farmers, aquarium and ornamental fish traders, cage-culture operators and other fisheries stakeholders.

Participants were sensitized on the importance of obtaining healthy stocks from reliable sources, maintaining appropriate quarantine facilities and conducting health screening before introducing new stocks into existing culture systems, a press release from CIARI said.

Earthquake mock drill conducted at DSS Marine dockyard

In order to strengthen preparedness and to promote discipline, the Directorate of Shipping Services today conducted Earthquake Mock Drill at DSS Marine Dockyard. The drill was conducted under the supervision of the Nodal Officer Disaster Management, DSS and saw active participation from all employees of Marine Dockyard along with Disaster Management Team of DSS. As part of the exercise, a total of 209 personnel were evacuated



to the designated shelter point. The mock scenario also included the rescue of one simulated injured person, who were promptly given first aid and evacuated by the response team.

The entire exercise was carried out in a coordinated manner, demonstrating efficient

response protocols and inter-agency cooperation under the overall supervision of Shri. L.T. Shiju Cheriyan, Deputy Director (i/c), DSS. Once the situation was declared normalized, all personnel returned safely to their respective workstations, a press release from DSS said.

Virtual training session on prevention & control of snake bite envenoming held

A virtual training session on prevention and control of snake bite envenoming was organised by Directorate of Health Services in association with National Health Mission on Aug. 6 in the conference hall of Directorate of Health Services with the aim of enhancing the clinical preparedness of frontline healthcare professionals in managing snake bite cases. Participants were Medical Officers/Chief Medical Officers

(Allopathy, Homeopathy & Ayurveda) of Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals of A&N Islands.

The session was conducted by the resource person, Dr. Shiv Shankar Singh, M.D (Medicine) who imparted a detailed training on the clinical management and response to snake bite. The training aims to enhance the knowledge and preparedness of healthcare professionals in

effectively managing snake bite cases, proper referral mechanisms, administration of anti-snake venom (ASV) and treatment associated with snake envenomation which is considered a critical aspect of emergency healthcare services.

The participants were earlier welcomed by Dr. Subrata Saha, State Nodal Officer (PCSBE). Around 100 participants benefitted from this training programme, a press release from DHS said.
