## Govt working to ensure digital format of degrees, certificates from 2017: HRD Minister

New Delhi, Sept 11  
 Government is working to ensure that degrees and certificates are given to students in digital format from the 2017 academic session onwards. Talking to reporters at a conference on National Academic Depository in New Delhi recently, Human Resource

Development Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar said, every student will also get an opportunity to upload their other certificates and awards. Shri Javadekar said, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi wants to make whole apparatus as digital as part of Digital India campaign.

The creation of a digital database will benefit recruiters who want to get the credentials of applicants and will also eliminate the need to physically approach the university. All academic records will be available in digital format, to curb the menace of fake educational degrees and marksheets.

## Complete ban on use of polythene in all national monuments & tourist destinations from 2nd October

New Delhi, Sept 11  
 Tourism Minister, Shri Mahesh Sharma has said there will be a complete ban on use of polythene in all national monuments and tourist destinations from 2nd October. He said this in New Delhi on Friday that in an initiative to carry forward the Swachh Bharat

Mission, the government chose the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi to impose this ban. The Minister said the trial phase of the initiative will be launched immediately. He however, clarified that plastic bottles would not

be banned but tourists would be asked to place them in the recycle container at the tourists destinations. The ban would be applicable to the protected zone or 100-m radius of the monuments.

## Medical shop owners cautioned against selling cough syrups, other tablets to children

Port Blair, Sept. 11  
 A meeting with the owners of Medical Shop of Port Blair was held in the office of Sub Divisional Police Officer (South Andaman) recently. Around 14 Medical Shop owners of Port Blair attended the meeting to discuss the issue of consumption of

narcotic drugs/tablets by children, especially school going students. The shopkeepers were asked not to sell drugs like cough syrups and other tablets etc. to the children. They were asked to maintain proper register about the sale & stock of medicines and get it regularly

inspected by concerned authorities. Further, they were asked to share any information regarding anyone running a shop without licence or selling/demanding for huge quantity of banned drugs/tablets etc, a communication from the SP, South Andaman District said.

## Occurrence of fruit sucking moth and its management; farmers advised

Port Blair, Sept. 11  
 Some incidences of severe outbreak of Fruit Sucking Moth have been noticed in Diglipur recently causing damage to fruits by puncturing the skin of the fruit and feeding upon the juices of the fruits. An adult moth would generally attack a number of fruits on a single night.

The Directorate of Agriculture has suggested the farmers a number of measures to control this menace. These include collection and destruction of rotting or fallen fruit which will reduce the number of secondary moths, destruction of larval hosts (alternate host) around orchards, bagging fruits with brown paper covers, oil paper covers to prevent the moth attack. Repelling the moths from feeding the fruits by use of indigenous plant products viz. neem oil and neem seed

kernel extract is found to be effective. All the farmers of South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman, Car Nicobar zone and Campbell Bay Zone have been advised to be vigilant and undertake these measures to control pest population. For further information if any required, farmer may contact the nearest Agriculture Sub-Depot, Zonal Agriculture office or call Kisan Call Centre (Ph. 243434) for getting appropriate solution, a communication from the Director of Agriculture said.

shop owners/ general public are also requested not to dispose-off animal waste/ dead animals in the nallahs/ creeks as it would attract crocodiles and subsequently it may become permanent resident of the crocodiles. In case of any crocodile is sighted, they may contact the Range Officer, Tushnabad or Range Officer, Lohabarrack Wildlife Sanctuary at their mobile No. 9434296161 and 9474209433 respectively, a communication from the DFO, South Andaman said.

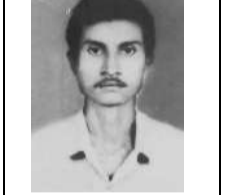

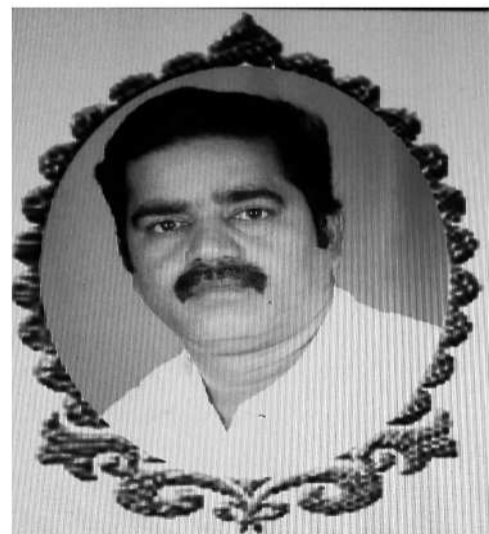

**Focus on Rohit Sharma as selectors meet to choose Test squad against New Zealand**

Mumbai, Sept 11

The below-par Test record of Rohit Sharma is expected to be the focus of discussion when the selection committee, headed by Sandeep Patil, picks the Indian cricket squad for the home Test series against New Zealand, here tomorrow. Despite Rohit's poor form in the Tests, he has the confidence of captain Virat Kohli, who feels that the ODI specialist should be given a longer run to prove himself in the Test format. The star Mumbai batsman, who holds the world record for the highest score in ODIs, could never settle down in the longest format during his delayed 18-Test career that began with a bang -- with back-to-back tons against the West Indies in 2013

in India.

Considered to be a batsman with a wide range of strokes, Rohit has been in and out of the playing XI since then with consistency not his forte in Tests. In the recent series against the West Indies in the Caribbean, he got a chance to play in two out of four games, one of which was washed out, and he mustered 9 and 41 in the two innings in the third Test at Gros Islet. How much patience will the selectors continue to have on the talented but underperforming 29-year-old batsman at the Test level is a matter of conjecture. Rohit also did not do well in the first innings of the ongoing

Duleep Trophy final in Greater Noida after being specifically included in one of the teams -- India Blue -- following his return from the West Indies and the USA. He made just 30 runs yesterday before throwing his wicket away. With quite a few talented youngsters like Shreyas Iyer, Manish Pandey and Karun Nair waiting in the wings, the selectors will have a tough task at hands. Another top-order batsman who has come under the scanner is Cheteshwar Pujara. He was dropped for the final Test against the West Indies, along with successful opener in past Test rubbers -- Murali Vijay --, by the tour management.

New Delhi, Sept 11

**Angelique Kerber wins US Open title**

New York, Sep 11

In season's final Grand Slam, the US Open, newly-crowned world number one Angelique Kerber of Germany beat Karolina Pliskova of Czech Republic to lift the Women's Singles title. In the summit clash played this morning, Kerber trumped Pliskova in a three set match, 6-3, 4-6, 6-4 to win her maiden US Open title. This is Kerber's second Major title. She won the Australian Open this year.



Pliskova, the runner up, had earlier defeated the likes of Venus Williams in quarter-finals and Serena Williams in semi-finals.

In the Men's Doubles final, Brit Jamie Murray and his Brazilian partner Bruno Soares defeated the unseeded Spanish pair of Pablo Carreno Busta and Guillermo Garcia-Lopez, 6-2, 6-3 to win the title.

**Chinappa rises to 10th in PSA rankings**

New Delhi, Sep 11

Indian squash player Joshna Chinappa rose to 10th while Deepika Pallikal remained static at 19th in the latest Professional Squash Association (PSA) rankings. Chinappa, who had slipped to 12th after initially breaking into top-10 in July, has regained the position even as Pallikal held on to the 19th position. In the men's rankings, Saurav Ghosal dropped to 21st from his previous perch of 17th. Mahesh Mangaonkar gained a position to be on 60th, while Vikram Malhotra remained 73rd. Harinder Pal Sandhu improved to 79th. In the women's section, Sachika Ingale slipped to 84.

**Glenn Maxwell moves to the top of T20I all-rounders**

Dubai, Sept 11

Following knocks of an unbeaten 145 off 65 balls and 66 in 29 balls in the two-match Twenty20 International (T20I) series against Sri Lanka, Glenn Maxwell, the Australian all-rounder, has moved up to the top position in the International Cricket Council (ICC) T20I rankings for all-rounders, while also reaching a career-best third spot for batsmen. Maxwell rose to the top of the all-rounders chart after the first T20I against Sri Lanka, leapfrogging Pakistan's Shahid Afridi and Bangladesh's Shakib Al Hasan. He managed to consolidate his No. 1 ranking following Australia's 2-0 series win on Friday (September 9). Maxwell, who gained 16 points with his spectacular

performance in the two matches, took his tally to 763 points, only eight shy of the second-placed Aaron Finch in the list of top T20I batsmen. Virat Kohli, the India Test skipper, still tops the batting charts with 820 points. Tillakararne Dilshan, who played his last international game at Pallekele, ended his career as the 19th-ranked batsman, while finishing at the 15th spot in the rankings for all-rounders. In the rankings for bowlers, Australia's left-arm all-rounder James Faulkner, with a career-best rating of 672 points, reached the fifth position after picking up four wickets in the Sri Lanka series, including a three-wicket haul in the second T20I. Mitchell Starc, who also bagged four scalps against Sri Lanka, re-entered the top-20.
