President inaugurates 2nd Indian Rice Congress

Rice is the cornerstone of food security in India and also a key factor for our economy: President

Cuttack, Feb.11 (PIB)

Rice is the cornerstone of food security in India and also a key factor for our economy, said the President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu. She was speaking on the occasion of inauguration of the 2nd Indian Rice Congress at ICAR-National Rice Research Institute, Cuttack today. The President said that though India is the leading consumer and exporter of rice today, the situation was different when the nation became free. In those days, we were dependent on imports to meet our food requirements, and often the nation lived what was called a ship-to-



mouth existence. If the nation could overcome that dependency and has become the largest exporter, a lot of credit goes to the National Rice Research Institute. The Institute has contributed immensely to India's food security and also in improving farmers' lives.

The President said that in the last century, as irrigation facilities

expanded, rice came to be grown in new places and found new consumers. The paddy crop requires high amounts of water but many parts of the world are facing severe water shortages due to climate change. Droughts, floods and cyclones are now more frequent, making rice cultivation more vulnerable. She said that even as rice has

broken new ground, there are places where traditional varieties are facing challenges. Thus, the task before us today is to find the middle path: preserving and conserving traditional varieties on one hand, and maintaining ecological balance on the other. Another challenge is to save the soil from excessive use of chemical fertilizers, which are considered necessary for modern rice cultivation. We need to reduce our dependence on such fertilizers in order to keep our soil healthy. She expressed confidence that scientists are at work to devise eco-friendly rice

The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman & Nicobar Islands held National Lok Adalats in the District Court Building, Port Blair, ADR centre-PRAYAS", Port Blair and Sub-Divisional Court Complex at Mayabunder and Diglipur today by adopting all COVID SOPs issued by the MHA from time to time.

The Judicial Officers of this judgship were present to mark the commencement of the



National Lok Adalat at Port Blair, Mayabunder and Diglipur.

Out of the total 390 pre-litigation cases including 100 pre-litigation BSNL recovery cases and 520 cases pending in

different courts at Port Blair were referred to the National Lok Adalat, out of which, 63 pre-litigation bank recovery cases, 1 MACT Case and 470 Criminal cases were disposed of by the National Lok Adalat at

Port Blair. Disposing of 63 bank recovery cases, the involved amount of Rs. 1,82,75,774.78/- have been settled at Rs.1,07,23,500/-, thus paving a benefit of Rs.75,52,274.78/- to the bank loan borrowers. A sum of Rs.5,33,000/- was realized on the spot. Disposing of 01 MACT case, the claim was settled at Rs. 1,80,000/-. Disposing of 470 Criminal cases a sum of Rs. 26,800/- was realized as fine.

production systems.

The President said that as rice forms the bedrock of our food security, we must consider its nutritional aspects too. Large sections of low-income groups depend on rice, which is often the only source of daily nutrition for them. Therefore, delivering protein, vitamins and essential micronutrients through rice can help combat malnutrition. She was happy to note that ICAR-NRRI has developed India's first high protein rice, called CR Dhan 310 and NRRI has also released a high-zinc rice variety, called CR Dhan 315. She said that development of such bio-fortified varieties is an ideal example of science in the service of society. More and more of such efforts would be needed to support the increasing population amid a changing climate. She expressed confidence that India's scientific community would rise to the challenge.

The common problems of the body, which often require physiotherapy, are sometimes solved in yoga as well. That's why You must also know yoga along with physiotherapy. As a big part of the physiotherapy profession is connected with senior citizens, the Prime Minister stressed the need for experience and soft-skills and asked the profession to document and present them via academic papers and presentations before the world. Shri Modi also requested the profession to develop ways of video consulting and tele-medicine.
