President Shri Ram Nath Kovind Monday conferred the Padma awards on prominent personalities at a civil investiture ceremony in Rashtrapati Bhawan.

Padma Bhushan was presented to Malayalam actor Mohanlal, South African politician Pravin Gordhan, former Cisco head Jhon Chambers, Parliamentarians Hukumdev Narayan Yadav, Kariya Munda and Sukhdev Singh Dhindsa.

Renowned journalist Kuldip Nayar was also awarded Padma Bhushan posthumously.

Padma Shri was conferred on various personalities including Chess player Harika Dronavalli, Table Tennis player Sharat Kamal, Social Workers Bhagirathi Devi and Muktaben Dagli, Actor Prabhudeva, Music Director Shankar Mahadevan, former civil servant S Jaishankar, Agriculturist Rajkumari Devi and Babaul Dahiya, Archaeologist Dilip Chakravarty and Hematologist Mammen Chandy. This year, 112 personalities were selected for the Padma awards, which was announced on the eve of Republic Day. The remaining awardees are likely to be conferred the honour at another function to be held later this month.



## Pinaka guided extended range rockets successfully test-fired by DRDO

Pokhran, Mar 11

In a boost for Indian Army, the Defence Research and Defence Organisation on Monday successfully carried out two tests of Pinaka guided extended range rockets at Pokhran range. Both the rockets succeeded in hitting their targets at 90-km range, ANI reported.

"India today successfully carried out two tests of Pinaka guided extended range rockets at Pokhran range. Both the rockets hit their targets at 90-km range," The rockets were



monitored by radars, high precision electro-optical systems and telemetry systems at Proof and Experiment Establishment (PXE) through their flight path. "In both the missions, the weapon systems impacted the intended targets with high precision and desired accuracies. Telemetry systems tracked and monitored the vehicle all through the flight path. President of India Shri Ram Nath Kovind on Monday conferred the prestigious Padma Awards at the Rashtrapati Bhavan. Sportspersons including champion wrestler Bajrang Punia, veteran table-tennis players Sharath Kamal and chess grandmaster Harika Dronavalli were honoured with the Padma Shri by the President. Punia had a great year in 2018 as he won gold medals at the Commonwealth Games and Asian Games. He also bagged a silver medal at World Championships and a bronze medal at the Asian Championships last year. Sharath Kamal, who has been leading India's charge in men's table tennis for years had a highly rewarding 2018 too. He won as many as four medals at the 2018 Commonwealth Games, including a historic gold in the men's team event. Indian

said in a statement. Developed by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), Pinaka is a multiple rocket launcher which is used by the Indian Army. It is capable of firing a salvo of 12 HE rockets in 44 seconds. The system is mounted on a Tatra truck for mobility. Pinaka was used extensively during the Kargil War to destroy enemy positions on the mountain tops. Each Pinaka battery consists of: six launcher vehicles, each with 12 rockets; six loader-replenishment vehicles; three replenishment vehicles; two Command Post vehicle (one stand by) with a Fire Control computer, and the DIGICORA MET radar. A battery of six launchers is capable of neutralising an area of 1,000 m x 800 m.

## Past champions Rafael Nadal, Roger Federer advance at Indian Wells

Indian Wells, Mar 11  
World number two Rafael Nadal raced into the third round of the ATP Indian Wells Masters as Roger Federer made a less speedy but still successful start to his quest for a sixth title on Sunday. Nadal, a three-time Indian Wells winner, needed just 72 minutes to get past overmatched Jared Donaldson 6-1, 6-1. Federer, who is seeking to break out of a tie with top seed Novak Djokovic for most titles in the California desert, looked set for a similarly easy time of it, but had to turn back a second-set challenge from German Peter Gojowczyk in a 6-1, 7-5 win. Fourth-seeded Federer said he was relieved not to go to a second-set tiebreaker after



falling behind 3-1 to the free-swinging German who is ranked 85th in the world. The Swiss regained the break and, after saving four break points to make it 4-4, he broke Gojowczyk for a 6-5 lead, the German double-faulting on break point to give Federer a chance to serve it out. "I struggled a little bit with my serving in that second set and that gave him chances.

Because he was serving better he started to swing more freely and then it was tough," Federer said. "I'm really happy I found a way in that second set." Federer could find himself fighting for a fourth-round berth against fellow Swiss Stan Wawrinka, a three-time Grand Slam champion currently unseeded as he continues his return from injury.

On the request of the RO, the representatives of different political parties gave suggestions regarding the selection of venues for election campaigning, street corner meetings and taking out election rallies. The RO said that based on the suggestions, Tiranga Park at Mohanpura and other prominent venues in the city and its outskirts will be permitted in such a way that all political and Independent candidates get equal opportunity to take up election campaigning.

Interacting with the political party functionaries, the SP District, Shri Deepak Yadav said that the election rallies by the political parties should be carried out as per the laid down guidelines of the ECI. 
