PM to inaugurate activities related to 'Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav' & flag off Padyatra from Sabarmati Ashram today

New Delhi, March 11 (PIB) Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will flag off the 'Padyatra' (Freedom March) from Sabarmati Ashram, Ahmedabad tomorrow (March 12) at 10.30 am & inaugurate the curtain raiser activities of the 'Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav' (India@75). Prime Minister will also launch various other cultural and digital initiatives for the India@75 celebrations and will also address the gathering at Sabarmati Ashram. Governor of Gujarat, Shri Acharya Devvrat, Union MoS(I/C) Shri Prahalad Singh Patel

and Chief Minister of Gujarat, Shri Vijay Rupani will also be present. **Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav** Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav is a series of events to be organised by the Government of India to commemorate the 75th Anniversary of India's Independence. The Mahotsav will be celebrated as a Jan-Utsav in the spirit of Jan-Bhagidari. A National Implementation Committee headed by the Home Minister has been constituted to chalk out policies and planning of various events to be undertaken under the Commemoration. The

curtain raiser activities are beginning from 12th March 2021, 75 weeks prior to 15th August, 2022. **Padyatra** The Padyatra to be flagged off by PM, will be undertaken by 81 marchers from Sabarmati Ashram in Ahmedabad to Dandi in Navsari, a journey of 241 miles that will end on 5th April, lasting for 25 days. India will take on England in the first T20I at the Narendra Modi Stadium here tomorrow (March 12) at 7 pm. The match will be the first of the five-match series that promises to be an intensely-contested affair. England are the top-ranked T20 side in the world but that counts for little against an Indian side that has the potential to outfire any team on its day.

Dr. A K Mandal, Director ANIIMS, speaking as the guest of honor lauded the Health Department for organizing the IHIP training programme as a precursor to the launch of Integrated Disease Surveillance Platform on 1st April, 2021 in A & N Islands with the rest of the country.

Dr. Samarendra Biswas, SMO, WHO-NPSP briefed about the importance of Integrated Health Information Platform and informed that the platform has been developed by WHO with the request from the Govt. of India.

Earlier, Dr. Avijit Roy, Nodal Officer (IHIP) welcomed all the participants and dignitaries present on the occasion. He also narrated the COVID-19 pandemic experiences and the role of Disease Surveillance system in the Islands and in the country. He further briefed on the technical aspects of surveillance, flow of reporting, early warning system, outbreak reporting and investigation.

Dr. Mahesh Waghmare, Deputy Director, NCDC, MoHFW, Delhi as a facilitator explained that IHIP has revamped to a real time web enabled system called Integrated Health Information Platform (IHIP), IHIP is near-real-time, web enabled electronic health information system intended to capture facility level case based disease surveillance data and simultaneously ran the PPT on IHIP.
