The Hon'ble Minister of Earth Sciences, Shri Kiren Rijiju today laid the foundation stone for the Marine Fish Rearing Facility at Atal Centre for Ocean Sciences and Technology for Islands (ACOSTI-NIOT) at a function held at the ACOSTI-NIOT complex, Dollygunj. The Hon'ble Minister unveiled the plaque marking the laying of foundation stone in the presence of Admiral DK Joshi, PVS, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency. The Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Fisheries), A&N Administration, Smt. Nandini Paliwal, Director NIOT, Dr. G.A. Ramadass, Group Head, MBT-NIOT, Dr. G. Dharani, and Officer-in-Charge, ACOSTI, Dr. Dilip Kumar Jha and senior officers of the A&N Administration and the staff of ACOSTI-NIOT were also present on the occasion.

Addressing the gathering, the Hon'ble Minister said that the

advancement of science and technology has a direct impact on a nation's economic prosperity. NIOT is a world-class institute where scientists are untiringly working to accomplish the vision of the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. The deep ocean mission was a huge task before MoES and under that mission, MoES has started various projects that can transform the life of the people. The Hon'ble Union Minister of Earth Sciences, Shri Kiren Rijiju today laid the foundation stone for the new Office Building of Meteorological Centre, Port Blair at a function held at the premises of Meteorological Office at Shadipur. The Hon'ble Union Minister unveiled the plaque marking the laying of the foundation stone for the new Office Building in the presence of Admiral D K Joshi, PVS, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency, the Chief Secretary, I/C, A&N Administration, Shri Nikhil Kumar, Head, RMC Kolkata, Dr. Somnath Dutta and senior officers of the A&N Administration and the staff of Meteorological Office, Port Blair.

Addressing the gathering, the Minister said, today yet another foundation stone is being laid and expressed happiness that the

Ministry is taking step to ensure the safety and security of the life of the common people. This Meteorological Centre will provide critical services to all our daily activities. He stated that these Islands are very important and critical for whole of the country and we have to ensure that these Islands become a fulcrum of development and also fully equipped with all necessary modern amenities.

The Minister mentioned that the whole world knows that climate change is a real thing and we must focus our attention to arrest global warming. The global community has to come together, specially for the people living in coastal area and we are taking many steps for the protection of the environment.

The Minister remarked that foundation stone laid for this Meteorological Centre in A&N Islands will provide basic information about the weather forecast to the Mainland besides it will also give service to the neighbouring countries. Now, India has already become the country to provide tsunami warning information to all other countries in the Indian Ocean region and also about the Ocean Atmospheric phenomenon which is affecting the life of fishermen and everybody who are using the sea route either by flight or ship. The Minister said that functioning of INCOIS in Hyderabad and IMD Centres are basically same. One is providing service on the ocean side and another is providing service in the land side. The pattern of service providing is almost same. Since Andaman is an Island State, we need to collaborate with the Centres. We have lots of high-tech machineries and mechanisms which need to be integrated while providing services to the people. Once we have the Doppler Radar established in the Met Centre in A&N Islands, it will have a range close to 150 kilometer distance because all the weather forecast is based on the observations. The more observation, we will have more data, and then the accurate forecast and other predictions can be provided. We must be able to give a long term weather forecast to the maximum level of accuracy. We are really advancing in so many fields when comes to the atmospheric science, the Minister added.

The Centre coming up in Port Blair in a place which is popularly known as Hawaghar Jn. and once we install Doppler Weather Radar and other building components are completed, the common people can visit the Met Office. The Minister urged the IMD officials to set up a Selfie Point at the Met Office premises, so that the students who are inclined towards climate science can come to this centre and take advantage from it. This Centre should act as Common Visiting Centre for everybody so that people can understand the common weather pattern,

The National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT) is among the premier institutes in the country to develop reliable indigenous technology for harnessing marine living resources through advanced engineering and biotechnological tools. In the Deep Ocean Mission, which was announced in September 2021, 4 out of 6 verticals are spearheaded by NIOT. He stated that India will be the 6th Nation to develop an underwater manned submersible, MATSYA 6000, which can carry 3 people to a depth of 6000 meters for exploring deep-sea resources. Various activities are being undertaken in these Islands also at the institutional and community levels. About six percent of children are born with Birth Defects every year worldwide. The birth defects spectrum includes association with many risk factors like genetic factors, maternal conditions like diabetes and obesity, maternal age, viral infections like chicken pox, rubella, zika, environmental and drugs. Being aware of the

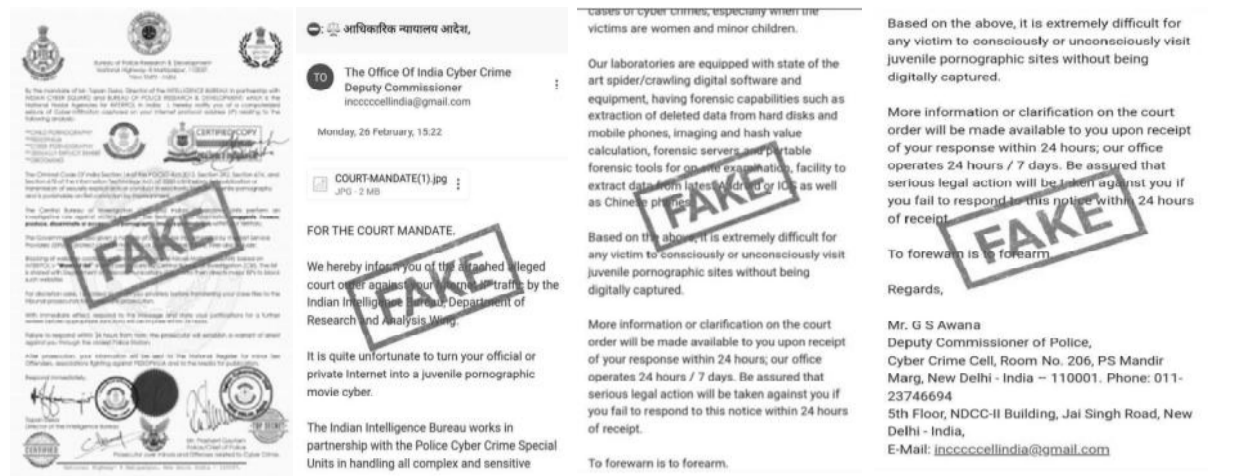

(ii) The deputationist officer including those who are presently on deputation would be deemed to have been relieved on the date of expiry of the deputation period unless the competent authority has with requisite approvals, extended the period of deputation, in writing, prior to the date of its expiry. It will be the responsibility of the immediate superior officer to ensure that the deputationist does not overstay. In cases, where officers are on deputation on the date of issue of these orders and the normal tenures are getting over in a period of six months, the concerned officers/ organizations may be allowed an extension of not more than one month, on a case to case basis with the approval of the DOPT.
(iii) That in the event of the officer overstaying for any reason whatsoever, he is liable to disciplinary action and other adverse civil/service consequences which would include that the period of unauthorized overstay shall not count against service for the purpose of pension and any increment due during the period of unauthorized over stay shall be deferred, with cumulative effect, till the date on which he rejoins his parent cadre.
2. Written consent of the officer concerned shall be taken to the terms and conditions of deputation (inclusive of the conditions in Para 1 (ibid) before the deputation orders are issued. The contents of these instructions will be conveyed to all officers presently on deputation for information/compliance.
3. These instructions will apply to all deputationists including state government officers/all India services officers joining central government posts on deputation and to officers proceeding on deputation to state government/autonomous & statutory institutions/foreign bodies, etc.
4. If the borrowing organizations would like a relaxation from these terms, they should obtain approval of DOPT to it, prior to the start of deputation.


