About 3.5 lakh cases settled in National Lok Adalats across country

New Delhi, Feb 12
About 3.5 lakh cases were settled in the National Lok Adalats held at all levels ranging from district to high courts across the country in a day, yesterday. National Legal Services Authority, NALSA, said that as per the figures received till 5 in the evening, more than 3.5 lakh

cases, including 1.9 lakh pending and 1.6 lakh pre-litigation cases, have been settled. The total value of the settlement amount reached today is Rs 1,185 crores. The National Lok Adalat, organised by the NALSA along with the respective State Legal Services Authorities.

ISRO to launch record 104 satellites in single mission on Feb 15

New Delhi, Feb 12
Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO's workhorse PSLV - the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle - will carry a record 104 satellites in a single mission on Wednesday from Sriharikota. ISRO said, PSLV in its 39th flight (PSLV-C37), will launch the 714 kg Cartosat-2 series satellite for earth

observation along with 103 co-passenger satellites, together weighing about 664 kg at lift off. The co-passenger satellites will be of India, US, Israel, Kazakhstan, the Netherlands, Switzerland and UAE. Last year, ISRO had launched 20 satellites. The highest number of satellites launched in a single mission is 37 by Russia in 2014.

Parl makes efforts to promote women for active participation in public life: LS Speaker

New Delhi, Feb 12
Lok Sabha Speaker Smt Sumitra Mahajan today said the Indian Parliament is making consistent efforts to promote women for their active participation in public life involving policy making, legislature and executive. Participating as Chief Guest at the valedictory programme of the three-day National Women's Parliament at the holy confluence of Rivers Krishna and Godavari in Andhra Pradesh, Smt

Mahajan said for achieving millennium development goals and sustainable development goals, participation of women is necessary. She opined that for a resurgent India, participation of women in legislature is a must. Comparing woman to welfare, Smt Mahajan said women of today are change makers in the global affairs. She said a woman is never particular about equality but she has to be there in the driving seat to navigate a family to safer

shores as she is a good manager. Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Shri N Chandrababu Naidu said that women who are more than 50 per cent of the country's population should be economically stronger and self dependent. He advocated equal opportunities for women in society on equal footing with that of their male counterparts in all walks of life which will guarantee self-esteem and dignity of life to women.

EC asks HRD Ministry to introduce electoral literacy curriculum in schools

New Delhi, Feb 12
In a bid to educate 15 to 17-year-old future voters, who would enrol as voters when they turn 18, the Election Commission has asked the Union HRD Ministry to introduce 'electoral literacy' in the curriculum at the secondary school level. And till the time the subject becomes part of the curriculum, the Commission has asked the HRD Ministry to ask the

NCERT to bring out a booklet on elections and electoral process that may be included in the list of supplementary reading material for schools at appropriate level. In India, over 62 million persons fall in the age group of 15 to 17 years and have been described as 'future voters' by the Election Commission. Last July, Chief Election Commissioner Nasim Zaidi had written to HRD

Minister, Shri Prakash Javadekar requesting him to include 'electoral literacy' in the curriculum.

ORDER No. 185

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 18 of the Energy Conservation Act, 2001 (Central Act 52 of 2001), read with Notification No. S.O.593(E) dated 24.04.2006 issued by GOI, Ministry of Home Affairs the Lieutenant Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands is pleased to issue the following directions for efficient use of energy and its conservation in the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, namely:-

- I. **Mandatory use of Solar Water Heating Systems.**
The use of BIS marked Solar Water Heating Systems will be mandatory in the following categories of buildings, namely:
 - (1) Industries & establishments where hot water is required for processing.
 - (2) Hospitals and Nursing Home including Government Hospitals.
 - (3) Hotels, Motels, Restaurants, Banquet Hall and Guest Houses.
 - (4) All Government Buildings, Residential Schools, Educational Colleges, Hostels, Technical / Vocational Educational Institutes, District Institutes of Education and Training, Tourism Complexes.
 - (5) Housing Complexes / Flats set up by builders / group having societies.
 - (6) All Residential Buildings / Flats having a total plinth area of more than 100m²
- II. **Mandatory use of LED Lamps in Government Buildings / Government Aided Institutions / Boards / Corporations.**
 - (1) The use of Incandescent Lamps / CFL in all buildings / institutions constructed in Government Sector / Government Aided Sector, Boards and Corporation / Autonomous Bodies is banned with immediate effect.
 - (2) It will be mandatory that in existing building the defective Incandescent Lamps / CFLs, when replaced would be replaced only by LEDs.
 - (3) Electricity Department to make necessary modification in the new connection application forms and agreements within two months time from the date of issue of this order to promote the use of LEDs instead of conventional bulbs / CFLs while releasing / sanctioning new connection.
- III. **Mandatory use of ISI Marked and Star Rated Electrical Devices / Appliances**
 - (1) All electric connections; the use of ISI Marked wires, cables, switches, capacitors is mandatory.
 - (2) All Fans, Air Conditioners, Fridge / Deep Freezers, Motors, Pump Sets etc., Star Rating is mandatory.
 - (3) Electricity Department to make necessary amendments in the new connection forms and agreements for electric connections within two months time from the date of issue of this order to ensure use of only ISI marked equipments and accessories in A&N Islands.
- IV. **Promotion of Energy Efficient Building Design by including Renewable Energy Technologies with immediate effect as per the following schedule.**

The installation of Solar Photovoltaic Power Plant for the category of building/areas mentioned in Column 2 as per the capacity mentioned against it under column-3 of the schedule below shall be mandatory.

Sl. No.	Category of Building / Area	Category of Solar Photovoltaic Power Plant to be installed
1.	All residential buildings built on a plot size of 500 Square Metre and above, falling within the limits of Municipal Council, Andaman & Nicobar Urban Development Authority, Andaman & Nicobar State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Sectors.	Minimum 1 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) OR 5% of connected load whichever is higher
2.	All Private Educational Institutes, Schools, Colleges, Hostels, Technical / Vocational Education Institutes, Universities etc. having connected load of 30 Kilo Watt (KW) and above.	Minimum 5 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) OR 5% of connected load whichever is higher
3.	All Government Buildings and Offices, Government Colleges, District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Government Educational Institutions, Universities having connected load of 30 Kilo Watt (KW) and above.	Minimum 5 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) OR 5% of connected load whichever is higher
4.	All private Hospitals and Nursing Homes, Industrial Establishments, Commercial Establishments, Malls, Hotels, Motels Banquet Halls and Tourism Complexes having connected load: (i) Of 50 Kilo Watt (KW) to 1000 Kilo Watt (KW). (ii) Above 1000 Kilo Watt (KW).	(i) Minimum 10 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) OR 5% of connected load whichever is higher (ii) Minimum 50 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) OR 3% of connected load whichever is higher
5.	All New Housing Complexes developed by Group Housing Society, Builders, Housing Boards on a plots size of: (i) 0.5 Acre to 1.0 Acre. (ii) More than 1.0 Acre to 2.0 Acres. (iii) More than 2.0 Acres to 5.0 Acres. (iv) More than 5.0 Acres.	(i) Minimum 10 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp). (ii) Minimum 20 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) (iii) Minimum 30 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) (iv) Minimum 40 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp)
6.	All water lifting stations of Irrigation Department having connected load of 100 KW and above	Minimum 50 Kilo Watt Peak (KWp) OR 3% of connected load whichever is higher

(i) All the line Departments like Town and Country Planning, Urban Local Bodies, Public Works Department (Buildings and Roads), Housing, Public Health, Andaman & Nicobar State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, Industries, Education, Social Welfare, Red Cross, Architecture, Housing Board, Andaman & Nicobar State Agriculture Marketing Board, Irrigation, Forest etc. shall implement the mandatory provisions of installation of Solar Photovoltaic Power Generation Plant and incorporate a relevant provision in this regard in their rules within a period of two months from the date of issuance of this order to make use of Solar Photovoltaic Power Plant compulsory.

(ii) **The New & Renewable Sources of Energy (NRSE) Division of Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands being a State Designated Agency (SDA)** for implementing Energy Conservation Act 2001 in the State shall provide all necessary technical support to the Government Department / Organisation in preparation of project proposal, cost estimates, installation of solar Power Plants and in obtaining the Central finance Assistant (CFA) from Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), Government of India (GoI), if available, from the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, government of India, fronttime to time.

(iii) The completion certificate in this regard shall be issued only after getting the No Objection Certificate (NOC) from **New & Renewable Sources of Energy (NRSE) Division of Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands**

(iv) The concerned departments shall designate a District and State Level Nodal Officer to monitor and to report the progress of enforcement of the said decision of the State Government to the **New & Renewable Sources of Energy (NRSE) Division of Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands** on quarterly basis in the format to be issued by Electricity Department through the Office of respective Assistant Commissioner.

(v) The above said organization / user categories shall ensure the compliance of above-mentioned mandatory provision, within one year from the date of issue of the notification, at their own cost, failing which, the penal action may be initiated under the Energy Conservation Act, 2001 (Central Act - 52 of 2001).

(vi) The systems installed shall strictly comply with the technical specifications prescribed by Ministry of New & Renewable Energy, Govt. of India / Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands / **New & Renewable Sources of Energy (NRSE) Division of Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands**.

(vii) The user categories of private sector may install the Solar Photovoltaic Power Plants either through the Channel Partners of Ministry of New & Renewable Energy through **NRSE Division of Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands** and for Govt. Department / Organization. **New & Renewable Sources of Energy (NRSE) Division of Electricity Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands** is the approved source being a State Designated Agency (SDA).

(viii) Detailed Guidelines regarding Procedure and applicable processing fee shall be issued separately.

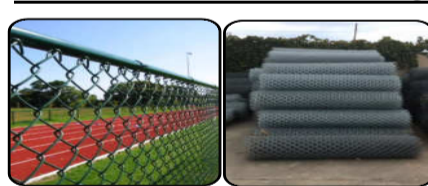

Reduce lending rates: RBI to banks
