## Car Nicobar's victory over active trachoma infection

### Efforts on to eliminate Trachoma by 2020

Port Blair, Feb 12  
It wasn't a smooth sail for the ophthalmic team of the Directorate of Health Services, led by Dr. Anita Shah, Dy. Director (Ophthalmology) and Joint Secretary NHM, to bring down the percentage of active Trachoma cases (0-9 years) among the Nicobarese community. Speaking to the DT Reporter recently, Dr. Anita Shah stated that the drastic change in a very short span of time is a positive sign and the team is striving hard to achieve the target of eliminating Trachoma by 2020.



Dr. Shah and her team braved all adversities to ensure that the younger generations of children are free from active infection and fortunately, their hard work paid off. As per the survey of Feb. 2017, the percentage of active Trachoma infection among children (0-9 years) has come down from 50.8% in 2010 to 1.6% in 2017. This

didn't know about the disease, but now they are aware about the disease, medicines and their acceptance has led to a lot of behavioral changes", remarked Dr. Shah. Dr. Shah further stated that since the active infection cases have been eliminated; now the focus is to reduce the lid complication Trachomatous Trichiasis (TT Load) in the community and the team desires to complete it by this year itself. Hence, de-worming is necessary for better growth of the children and parents must also take care of the nutritional need of their children for a healthy mind and body, she said adding that administering of Albendazole tablets in all

schools and Anganwadi centers to all children of the age group 1 to 13 years is being carried out today, which will be followed by mop up programme on February 15. Dr. R.P.C. Choubey, Director ANIIMS while speaking, informed that de-worming of children is necessary as it boosts vaccination effect and lead to early recovery of any ailments. Children must therefore be administered Albendazole tablets on a

**India vs South Africa, 5th ODI: After Pink ODI blues, visitors eye history**

Port Elizabeth, Feb 12  
India resume their quest for a historic series win in South Africa when they lock horns with the hosts in the 5th one-day international at St George's Park, Port Elizabeth. While the loss in the Pink ODI will serve as a big jolt to Virat Kohli and his troops what the Indian captain must keep in mind that yet another forecast of rain has been predicted at Port Elizabeth. However, the battle between the Proteas batsmen and the Indian wristspinners will most likely decide the outcome of the match. But if rain does become a factor then it will be interesting to see what combination the India think-tank opts for. Over the years the venue for the fifth match has witnessed low scoring encounters. While the average first innings score is 232 it dips to 198 in the second innings. Bowlers have generally ruled the roost at this ground. After being taken apart for runs in the previous match the Indian bowlers will look to make amends. However, one area of concern remains the option of the fifth bowler. With Kedar Jadhav suffering a



hamstring injury Kohli did seem to miss his services when the wristspinners leaked runs on Saturday. For South Africa, the attack seems to be the best form of defence. Putting fear aside they finally went out to express themselves in the Pink ODI and that seems the way forward. The return of AB de Villiers has also given the much-needed experience in the middle-order. Historically, South Africa hold the edge with only 11 losses in 32 matches while India have failed to register a single victory in 5 games. However, with a 3-1 lead, it is Team India who have the psychological advantage.

After commanding victories in the first two ODIs, Indian women lost by seven wickets in the third ODI here last Friday. The defeat definitely came as a jolt but India Women would look to shrug off the disappointment and make a winning start to their T20 campaign here. The visitors were at their dominating best in the first two ODIs, recording huge 88 and 178-run wins before slumping to the loss. While the Mithali Raj-led side in the ODI series, the T20s will witness a new captain in the explosive Harmanpreet Kaur. Harmanpreet will be assisted by in-form batswoman Smriti Mandhana. In Jhulan's absence, the Indian bowling attack lacked sting in the last match as Mignon du Preez scored a valiant 90 to pull off a consolation win for South

Africa. Du Preez was ably assisted by opener Laura Wolvaardt (59) as the duo laid the foundation for a successful run chase. Shah has sought the support of the Car Nicobar District Administration and accordingly letters were sent to the District Hospital and Health Centres to register the cases of TT and ensure the availability of medicines. She said, IEC activities will continue and once the report is received, camps will be conducted in Car Nicobar for lid correction surgery. Dr. Shah had recently attended a workshop at Delhi along with WHO officials and National Trachoma Elimination committee members. WHO is on the process to declare Nicobar as trachoma free area but as per WHO norms, two years surveillance and monitoring is required in order to be declared as Trachoma free area, she said. Dr. Shah also informed that except Car Nicobar, other districts of A&N Islands do not have a public health issue. The percentage of trachoma cases in South Andaman stands at 4.3 % while for N&M Andaman it is 2.1% and accordingly treatment is being done on case to case basis, she said adding that the TT load case is nil in South and North & Middle Andaman Districts. Attributing the reasons for the spread of the disease to the lifestyle of the community, Dr. Shah said the Nicobarese live in Tuhets, which is like cluster of huts in a village. The co-habitant with animals is one of the causes for higher incidence of active trachoma among the Nicobari population, she added.
