Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Bill, 2016 passed in the Parliament

Maternity leave to increase from present 12 weeks to 26 weeks for first two children

New Delhi, Mar 12
The Lok Sabha has passed the Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Bill, 2016 on Mar 9, 2017. The Bill had already been passed by the Rajya Sabha during the Winter Session. With this, the Bill stands passed in the Parliament. The bill increases maternity leave from 12 weeks to 26 week, protects employment during pregnancy. The Bill had already been passed by the Rajya Sabha during the Winter Session.

The Bill seeks to amend the Maternity Benefit Act, 1961 to provide maternal leaves for working women from 12 weeks to 26 weeks for the first two children. However, any maternal leave beyond the second child will continue to be 12 weeks.

According to an official statement, Maternity leave of 12 weeks will be available to mothers adopting a child below the age of three months as well

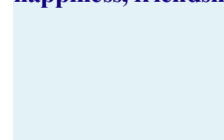

DLSA organises legal awareness camp at Mannarghat

The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman and Nicobar Islands held a legal awareness camp at the Community Hall of Mannarghat Gram Panchayat yesterday. Shri Debasis Bandyopadhyay, Additional District and Sessions Judge, Andaman and Nicobar Islands was the chief guest on the occasion.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Bandyopadhyay mainly highlighted the rights of the women folks and children of the society. He highlighted various legal rights the women are entitled to and how they should protect their children from the unscrupulous hands. He shared some of his experiences he gained



while trying cases as Special Judge, under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO Act) and cases involving exploitation of women and tender aged girls, to the

gathering.

He stated that cases involving exploitation or rape upon minor girls punishable under the POCSO Act are on a much higher side in A&N Islands in comparison to

those in the mainland. He opined that minor girls must not fear and disclose such incidents to their parents or even to their teachers. Mothers and female teachers are the best friends of girl students and the mothers at home and female teachers at school must play a pivotal role if they notice any unusual demeanor on the girls and establish friendly relations with their daughters and girl students.

FPIs infuse Rs 10,288 cr in capital markets so far this month

Mumbai, Mar 12

Foreign funds pumped-in over 10,200 crore rupees in the Indian capital markets so far this month. According to depository data, Foreign Portfolio Investors, FPIs, infused a net sum of 9,628 crore rupees in equities, during March 1 to 10 and another 660 crore rupees in the



debt segment, translating into a combined inflow of 10,288 crore rupees.

The latest net inflow comes following a net

investment of 15,862 crore rupees in the capital markets last month. So far this year, Foreign Portfolio Investors have invested 18,354 crore rupees in equities and 4,301 crore rupees in the debt, taking the total inflow to 22,655 crore rupees.

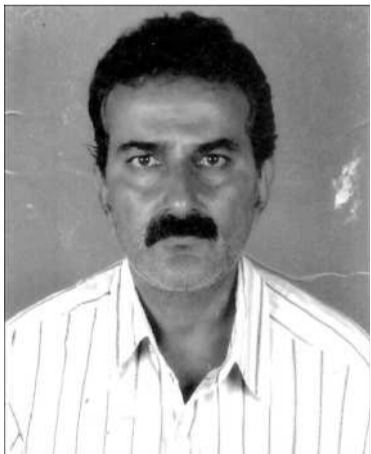

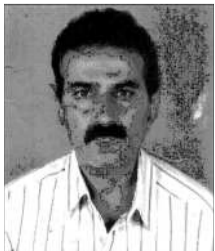

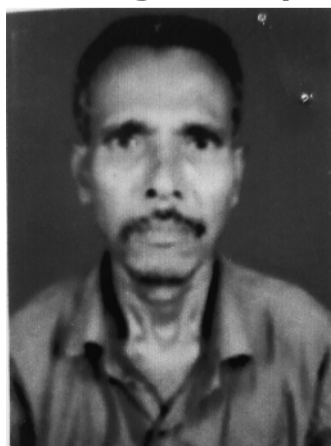

Kohli sees little home-advantage in Ranchi

New Delhi, Mar 12
If Virat Kohli was asked to give his opinion on what he dislikes most about the ongoing series against Australia, the chances are the India captain would bemoan the introduction of three new Test venues across the four matches. In the opening Test in Pune, Steve O'Keefe and Nathan Lyon combined to punch holes in the popular perception that Indian batsmen were the masters of spin as Australia won by a whopping 333 runs. Back in the friendlier and familiar confines of the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bengaluru, Kohli's men prevailed in a four-day slugfest

marked by verbal volleys and animated send-offs to level the series with a 75-run victory. "We can't do much about the Ranchi pitch, you know how it's always been," the 28-year-old said after the victory in Bengaluru, effectively conceding any thoughts of a 'home advantage' when the rivalry resumes. "It's always been slow and low, they know exactly what to expect there and we know what to expect as well. It's how you mentally prepare, mentally what kind of zone you are in as a team." Kohli, however, expects his spearhead slow bowlers R. Ashwin and Ravindra Jadeja

to continue what they have been doing over a successful home season. "The spinners have been outstanding and they will definitely look to back their strengths and dominate the home season as they've done so far," the India captain added of the top-ranked bowlers in Test cricket. As for more tips on the vagaries of the new pitch, Kohli would do well to contact India's last captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni, who inspected the ground on Thursday. The fourth and final match will also be played at a new venue when the teams line-up at Dharamshala on March 25.

Mirza, Strycova storm into quarter-finals of Indian Wells Masters

Wells, Mar 12
In Tennis, Sania Mirza and her Czech team-mate Barbora Strycova have stormed into the quarter-finals of the Indian Wells Masters in California. The fourth-seeded pair defeated the Italian-Polish team of Sara Errani and Alicja Rosolska, in straight sets, 6-2, 6-3. However, in the Men's Doubles, Leander Paes and his Argentinian team-mate Juan Martin Del Potro made an exit in the opening round after losing to the American-Luxembourgish duo of Sam Querrey and Gilles Muller, 3-6, 4-6. Rohan Bopanna and his



partner Pablo Cuevas had earlier bowed out. In the Singles, world number one Andy Murray crashed out in the second round. He was stunned by qualifier Vasek Pospisil of Canada, 4-6, 6-7. Frenchman Jo-Wilfried Tsonga almost made an exit. Stanislas Wawrinka, Tomas Berdych, Angelique Kerber, Venus Williams, Agnieszka Radwanska and Simona Halep were among those who progressed to the third round.

Indian challenge ends in Indian Wells with Leander's exit

Indian Wells (USA), Mar 12
Leander Paes and his Argentine partner Juan Martin de Porto crashed out in the opening round of the men's doubles event to bring an early closure to India's challenge at the ATP Indian Wells Masters, here. Paes and Del Porto were no match for Luxembourg's Gilles Muller and American Sam Querrey as they suffered straight sets 3-6 4-6 defeat to make early exit from the ATP Masters event. A break of serve in each set was enough for Muller and Querrey to pocket the comfortable win. The Indian-Argentine pair, however, had their chances in

as they had as many as eight opportunities to break their opponent's serve the second set but failed. In contrast, Muller and Querrey converted one out of the three break point opportunities that came their way in the second set to seal the affair in little over an hour. With Leander's loss, India's campaign came to an end in the tournament as Rohan Bopanna and Pablo Cuevas have already been shown the door in the opening round. Bopanna and his Uruguayan partner Cuevas fought hard before losing 6-2 3-6 10-7 against Serbian combination of Novak Djokovic and Viktor Troicki.

New Zealand's Taylor out of second Test

Dunedin, Mar 12
Injured New Zealand batsman Ross Taylor has been ruled out of the second cricket Test against South Africa which starts in Wellington on Thursday and there is a question mark over Trent Boult. Taylor suffered a calf tear early in his first innings of the first Test in Dunedin and a team spokesman confirmed today he would definitely miss Wellington. Whether he played in the third and final Test in Hamilton the following week would depend on his rate of recovery. Bowling spearhead Boult, who suffered a leg injury in Dunedin, was continuing to undergo treatment with no decision on his future

availability, the spokesman said. The first cricket Test, meanwhile, ended in a draw after rain washed out final day's play.

Shahzad surpasses Kohli as 4th highest run getter T20s

New Delhi, Mar 12
Afghanistan's wicketkeeper batsman Mohammad Shahzad has now surpassed Indian skipper Virat Kohli for most T20 runs. The news came within few minutes of the start of the third T20 match between Afghanistan and Ireland at Greater Noida stadium on Sunday. It was the second ball of the first over, with Barry McCarthy into the attack.

We have got to beat India on skill: Wade

Ranchi, Mar 12
Australia wicketkeeper Matthew Wade today said his side will look to beat an aggressive Indian team in the third cricket Test "on skill". "Indian teams always go quite hard, if you give them a sniff they'll run with it. Our job is to make sure they can't get in the game so they can't get aggressive with us, and then really take the momentum away from us. But it's not really our issue. We've got to play good cricket, and beat them on skill," Wade said. He said he was shocked by a distinct change in India's approach between the first and second cricket Test in the ongoing series. "The change from the first Test to the second Test was

probably the initial shock. They certainly came out a little harder on day three (at Bengaluru), but we expect them to come hard," Wade said of the Test that was marked by controversy over skipper Steve Smith's dismissal. "When you've got a caged lion you expect them to come out pretty hard, to get away. Indian teams are always quite aggressive. Dhoni was a different captain to Kohli, but that's just personality." About his own approach to the game, Wade said, "I feel like I play my best cricket when I get in the contest. When you're back's against the wall you've gotta find a way to get up and about, so I still feel like that's a big part of my game."

SSP Chawrasia becomes second Indian golfer to retain Indian Open title

Gurgaon, Mar 12
SSP Chawrasia on Sunday became only the second Indian golfer to successfully defend the Indian Open, clinching a seven-stroke win at the redesigned DLF golf and country club in Gurgaon. Chawrasia, who was sharing the lead with Spain's Carlos Pigem and England's Eddie Pepperell after day 3, emerged as the sole leader after 42 of the 69 golfers who made the cut returned to complete the third round. "I am very happy. It is such a tough course, I think I got lucky this week," Chawrasia said after pocketing a winner's cheque of USD 291,660. "I'm glad my prediction of



10-under came true," added the Kolkata pro, who became the second Indian after Jeev Milkha Singh to bag four European Tour titles. This was his sixth win on the Asian Tour and overall sixth international victory. On the eve of the tournament, Chawrasia had predicted 10-under could be a winning score and his

prediction came true as the 38-year-old from Kolkata sunk four birdies and dropped three shots, including a last hole bogey, to card exactly 10-under 278. He became the third player to win back-to-back Indian Open. Jyoti Randhawa (2006, 2007) and Japan's Kenji Hosoishi (1967, 1968) were the other two golfers.

SCA appoints Subhomoy Das as batting coach

Singapore, Mar 12
The modern residential cricket coaching school has been under construction for around last six months at a place named Barasat in West Bengal. Subhomoy Das, the former wicket-keeper batsman of Bengal who also represented Jharkhand later has been the chief architect of this school and being one of the close associates. Das had already made former Indian skipper Mahendra Singh Dhoni to join this residential school as a wicket-keeping and batting mentor. But in a recent development, Subhomoy Das received another exciting offer. That is to join the cricket academy, run by Singapore Cricket Association (SCA) as its chief batting coach.

Chinese scientists create 4 synthetic yeast chromosomes

Beijing, Mar 12
In China, scientists have assembled four synthetic yeast chromosomes, making it the second country after the US capable of designing and building eukaryotic genomes. The findings were published in journal Science, marking a step closer to building synthetic life. Xinhua news agency reported that researchers with Tianjin University, Tsinghua University and BGI-Shenzhen have constructed the synthetic

active chromosomes through exactly matching the synthetic genome with the designed sequence for the first time. In 2010, the US scientists succeeded in implanting a synthetic genome in a prokaryotic bacterium, marking the first step in chemical synthesis of living organisms. The new effort is part of a larger project to redesign and re-engineer yeast chromosomes, called the Synthetic Yeast Genome Project.

Idea Cellular to offer free incoming calls on domestic roaming

Mumbai, Mar 12
Telecom operator, Idea Cellular today announced free incoming calls for both Pre-paid and Post-paid customers on domestic roaming. The company, in its press release, said that from April 1 onwards, Idea's 200 million customers will enjoy free incoming calls while roaming on company's 2G, 3G and 4G

network across 400,000 towns and villages in the country. Idea customers will be able to make outgoing calls and SMS freely at affordable rates while roaming anywhere in India. It further said mobile data tariffs and data pack benefits of home circle will be available while roaming within India at no extra charge.

Ceasefire Violation: Pakistani forces resort to shelling, firing along LoC

New Delhi, Mar 12
In Jammu and Kashmir, in yet another incidence of ceasefire violation, Pakistani forces today resorted to shelling and firing in Krishna Ghati sector along the Line of Control in Poonch district. According to Defence sources, the forces from across the border, started unprovoked firing and shelling, targeting some Indian Positions in Khadi-Kamada area around 12 this afternoon. The troops guarding the border retaliated the firing effectively and the intermittent exchange of fire was continuing when last

reports came in. Mortars and automatic weapons were being reportedly used in firing. There is no report of any causality or injury to the Indian side so far.
