The Minister said, there is a great opportunity for partnerships between India and France across various sectors. The Minister said, the proposed policy will completely revamp the Industrial Policy of 1991.

India wins Best Exhibitor Award
Berlin, Mar 12
India has won the Best Exhibitor Award at ITB - Berlin on its last day. ITB-Berlin World Tourist Meet was convened at German capital Berlin from 7th to 10th of this month. India was represented by Tourism Minister Shri K. J. Alphons along with Ministry officials. Over 100 countries participated in the ITB-Berlin meet. India's Incredible India presented a short film named 'Yogi of the Racetrack' in the meet. The short film got 3.2 million hits in 60 hours.

Plane crash in Nepal
Kathmandu, Mar 12
The death toll in Nepal's plane crash has risen to 49. A plane carrying 71 passengers and crew has crashed on landing at Nepal's Kathmandu airport. Rescuers pulled bodies from the charred wreckage of the plane, operated by Bangladeshi airline US-Bangla, after a raging fire was put out. Flight BS211 veered off the runway while landing today afternoon.

PM Modi, French President Macron jointly inaugurate solar power plant in UP

Lucknow, Mar 12
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and visiting French President Mr Emmanuel Macron today jointly inaugurated 101 megawatt solar power plant at Dadar Kala village in Mirzapur district of Uttar Pradesh. One of the largest solar projects in the country, this plant has been set up by French company ENGIE.



The company was awarded the project in 2016 with the cost of 680 crore rupees. Solar Energy Corporation of India has signed Power purchase agreement for 25 years with the

company. One hundred and fifty seven million Unit Power will be produced per year from the project and about one Lakh houses

are likely to be served from this clean Power project. Commercial production will begin from next month. UP Chief Minister

Shri Yogi Adityanath, Union Minister of Renewable Energy Shri R K Singh and several other leaders were present on the occasion. After the function, Shri

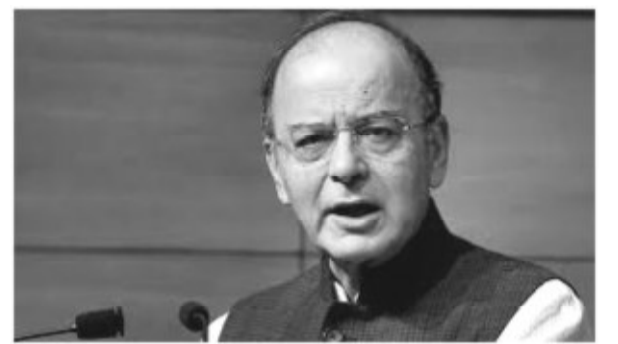

Existing system of filing GST returns extended by 3 months: FM

New Delhi, Mar 12
Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley has said that existing system of filing GST returns has been extended for another three months till the new return system is finalized.

Briefing reporters after the 26th meeting of GST Council in New Delhi on Saturday, Shri Jaitley said, GST implementation Committee has been tasked with the work of redressing the grievances caused to the taxpayers arising out of IT glitches.

He said, tax exemptions to exporters have also been extended by six months to September. The Minister said, Electronic way or E-way bill for movement of goods between states will be implemented from 1st of



next month.

However, for intra-state movement, the E-way bill would be rolled out in a phased manner beginning 15th of April and will cover all the states by 1st of June this year. E-way bill is an electronic way bill for movement of goods which can be generated on the GSTN (common portal). Movement of goods of more than 50 thousand rupees in value cannot be made by a registered person without an E-way bill.

Navjot Kaur climbs to No.2 in world wrestling rankings

New Delhi, Mar 12
Reigning Asian champion Navjot Kaur was rewarded for her recent gold medal effort as she became world No 2 in the women's 65kg category in the latest rankings released by the United World Wrestling. Navjot became the first Indian woman to win a gold medal at the recent Asian Championship in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. This is Navjot's career-best ranking. The pole position in the 65kg category belonged to 2015 World Championship silver medalist Petra Olii of Finland. Both Olii and Navjot have 18 points each. Among other Indians, Vinesh Phogat is ranked second in the 50kg category behind Lei Chun of China. Vinesh has 22 points



in her kitty while Chun is on top with 24 points. In the 59kg category, Sangeeta Phogat with 18 points is ranked fifth in the world. Olympic champion Sakshi Malik is currently world No 4 with 18 points in the 62kg category. In the men's freestyle section, only two Indian grapplers are in the top-10 list. Sharvan is world No 8 in the

61kg while Bajrang Punia is world No 4 with 22 points in the 65kg category. In the Greco-Roman category, Rajender Kumar is world No 4 in the 55kg, Vikram Kurade is world No 8 (63kg), Manish (world No 8, 67kg), Kuldeep Malik (world no 5, 72kg), Harpreet Singh (world No 4, 82kg) and Naveen (8th, 130kg).

Vijay Singh gets 1st individual win on PGA Tour Champions

New Port Beach, Mar 12
Vijay Singh got up-and-down for birdie with a putter from off the green on the final hole for a one-shot victory in the Toshiba Classic today. The 55-year-old Hall of Famer edged Tommy Tolles, Tom Pemice Jr. and Scott McCarron to win for the first time as an individual on the PGA Tour Champions. He teamed with Carlos Franco to win last year's Bass Pro Shops Legends of



Golf. Singh has played a limited schedule on the 50-and-over

tour while continuing to compete on the PGA Tour, where he has 34 career victories.

India top medals tally in historic ISSF World Cup outing

New Delhi, Mar 12
A podium eluded them on the final day but India had done enough to finish their best-ever campaign at the ISSF World Cup in Guadalajara, Mexico, at the top of the medals tally with four gold, one silver and four bronze. Two-time Olympic champion Vincent Hancock of the USA won the men's skeet competition, the concluding event of the year's first International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) World Cup. Among the three Indian shooters in the fray, Smit Singh shot 116 in the qualifying to be placed 15th, Angad Bajwa shot 115 to end in 18th spot while Sheeraz Sheikh secured the 30th spot with a score of 112. India, however topped the medals tally for the first time in

an ISSF competition with four gold, one silver and four bronze for a total of nine medals. Hancock, who had won gold at the Beijing and London Olympics, had gone into a bit of a slump after winning the 2015 World Championships and made a comeback of sorts with this win. He did it in style by first topping qualification with a sublime 123 out of 125 and then followed it up in the final, with a world record equalling 59 out of 60. He was matched by Paul Adams of Australia and finally got the better of him 6-5 in a shoot-off for gold. Italy's Tammaro Cassandro won bronze with 49 hits in the final. India's Smit was placed seventh in the beginning of the day and stood a chance of

qualifying but rounds of 22, 23 and 23 put paid to all such hopes. Angad Bajwa returned rounds of 24, 25 and 24 but had dropped too far behind on day one of qualifying and Sheeraz Sheikh did not look in his element in this competition. The failure on the last day notwithstanding, India will return home with happy memories. Shahzar Rizvi, Manu Bhaker, Akhil Sheoran and Om Prakash Mitharval won the gold medals in the competition, Anjum Moudgil bagged a silver, while established names such as Jitu Rai, Ravi Kumar finished with bronze. Though he did not win a medal, Sanjeev Rajput too shot very well and missed out by a whisker.

Kagiso Rabada takes centre stage as South Africa beat Australia

Port Elizabeth, Mar 12
Kagiso Rabada took 11 wickets in the match but may yet turn from hero to villain as South Africa beat Australia by six wickets in the second Test on Monday to level the four-match series. South Africa made heavy work of reaching their modest target before captain Faf du Plessis (2) and Theunis de Bruyn (11) guided them to 102 for four. The victory, however, is likely to be overshadowed by a ban for Rabada who was handed a new charge from the International Cricket Council (ICC) on Monday after already having a disciplinary hearing on Sunday. His presence in the remainder of the series remains under threat with match referee Jeff Crowe set to announce the outcome of a hearing into a level two charge against the seamer for brushing against Steve Smith after dismissing the Australian captain in the first

innings. If found guilty, Rabada, who has 15 wickets at an average of 16.80 in the series, will miss the final two games after accumulating eight demerit points to trigger an automatic suspension. Rabada was also slapped with a lesser level one charge on Monday for his exuberant celebrations when he dismissed

David Warner in the second innings. The 22-year-old Rabada was the outstanding performer on Monday as he ripped through Australia, who started on 180-5 with a 41-run lead. He completed figures of 6-54 and a match aggregate of 11-150, the fourth time he has taken 10 or more wickets in a Test.

Australia women beat India by eight wickets

Vadodara, Mar 12
Opener Nicole Bolton struck an unbeaten 100 off 101 balls after Australian spinners bamboozled the Indian batting to set up a crushing eight-wicket win in the opening game of the three-match series, which is part of the ICC Women's Championship. Bolton's fourth ODI hundred ensured Australia reached a modest 201-run target in just 32.1 overs. The experienced Ellyse Perry (25 not out) hit the

winning four. India would have been bowled out for far less if it was not for the 76-run partnership between Sushma Vema (41) and Pooja Vastrakar (51) for the eighth wicket, helping them muster 200 in 50 overs. Left-arm spinner Jess Jonassen led a stellar show from the Australian spinners, taking four wickets for 30 runs in 10 overs. Leggie Amanda-Jade Wellington picked up three wickets and Ashleigh Gardner removed Smriti Mandhana (12).

Sunil Chhetri's hat-trick against FC Pune City takes Bengaluru FC to ISL final

Bengaluru, Mar 12
Sunil Chhetri played like a man possessed as his superb hat-trick ensured a convincing 3-1 win for Bengaluru FC against FC Pune City in an entertaining second leg semi-final of this year's Indian Super League. The Indian captain reserved his best for the big day as he struck in the 15th, 65th and 89th minute to seal the issue for the ISL debutants. For Pune City, Jonatan Luca scored through a brilliant free-

kick in the 82nd minute to raise visions of a comeback which didn't happen in the end. An unmarked Chhetri opened the deadlock 15th minute after a nimble-footed Udanta Singh kept a neat cross on the far post. Chhetri got his 12th goal of the league and the second for his side in the 65th minute with a penalty. He cleverly stepped up and executed from the dreaded spot to beat Vishal Kaith. The skipper was brought down by his India teammate Sarthak Golui with a push from the back

after Chhetri had stole possession on the wide left before getting into the box. Dimas Delgado essayed a neat lob for Chhetri, who raced past a helpless Rohit Kumar before slotting past Kaith from the edge of the box to mark his 13th of the league in the 89th minute. Chhetri could have had another goal with a curler in the 72nd minute which was saved by a diving Kaith. Pune also had a couple of chances, before Bengaluru could settle down into the match.

Yuki Bhambri beats World No. 12 Lucas Pouille at Indian Wells

New Delhi, Mar 12
Yuki Bhambri picked up the biggest win of his career by beating Frenchman Lucas Pouille, ranked 12 in the world, in the second round of Indian Wells. In a match that spanned an hour and 21 minutes, Bhambri came out victorious by 6-4, 6-4 margin. He will next face American Sam Querrey in the third round. In August 2017, Bhambri beat World No 22 and Citi Open defending champion

Gael Monfils for what was then the biggest win of his career. This, in numbers speak, surely trumps it. That fact wasn't lost on Bhambri who punched the air in celebration and euphoria as Pouille's forehead sailed wide. Post the handshake, Bhambri once again took in the loud 'Yuki!' chants before going on to kiss the court. World No 110 Bhambri had beaten another Frenchman in Nicolas Mahut in the first round.




