The ceremony was held at the Conference Hall,

Lok Niwas, Sri Vijaya Puram. The Institute was inaugurated by Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency. The event was graced by Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration; Shri Hargobinder Singh Dhaliwal, IPS, Director

General of Police, A&N Islands; senior officers of the Administration and Police Department; and other distinguished guests. The renaming of the Institution after the great freedom fighter Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose reflects a tribute to his indomitable spirit, leadership, and commitment to national service. The institute will serve as a premier

Hon'ble MP meets Hon'ble Union Minister of Road Transport & Highways



Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 12 Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, A&N Islands met Shri Nitin Gadkari, Hon'ble Union Minister of Road Transport & Highways, today and apprised him about the condition of several stretches of the National Highway in North & Middle Andaman District in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. the matter to expedite the ongoing works, including the Baratang bridge project, and to ensure that the National Highway works from Baratang to Diglipur are completed within the timelines fixed by the Ministry. Officials representing the Islands also highlighted that efforts are underway to formulate a dedicated Film Tourism Policy for the Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The proposed policy aims to simplify filming permissions, provide facilitation support and promote the Islands as a competitive international shooting destination. The Islands' pavilion attracted significant attention from

mapping for sustainable groundwater management in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Dr. Jai Sunder, Director, Central Island Agricultural Research Institute as the guest of honour emphasized on the importance of integrated water resource management to support sustainable agriculture management and promoting livelihood of the farmers in A&N Islands. He also stressed the urgent need to adopt integrated farming system with precision agriculture to ensure optimal utilization of the precious freshwater resources with minimum wastage.

During the inaugural session, the NAQUIM reports prepared by CGWB and published in the years 2023, 2024 and 2025, were formally released.

Technical deliberations on outcomes of NAQUIM Phase-I and Phase-II were discussed in details by Scientists from CGWB, ER, Kolkata during both the sessions. The topics covered aquifer mapping and management with focus on groundwater hydrology, groundwater resources assessment, integrated water resources management with involvement of the stakeholders, groundwater geophysics, hydro-meteorology, groundwater quality, agricultural water resources management, climatological forecasting and its relevance in water resources management and relevance of desalination by an industry expert. Scientists from CGWB, Eastern Region, presented findings from NAQUIM Phase-I and Phase-II studies conducted in South Andaman district, North and Middle Andaman district, and Nicobar Islands.

Experts from Institutions such as Pondicherry University, Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, and various Departments of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration like APWD, Agriculture Department and Forest Department shared their insights on local issues on groundwater resources management and agricultural water management in the island ecosystems.

The programme concluded with an interactive feedback and question-answer session, during which representatives from Departments such as APWD, Agriculture, MES, DBRAIT, ANIIDCO, and Municipal authorities discussed the practical application of NAQUIM outcomes for groundwater planning and sustainable water resource management in the islands.

The one-day Union Territory Level Workshop served as an important platform for scientists, policymakers, and stakeholders to deliberate on groundwater challenges and to strengthen coordinated efforts toward sustainable water management in the A&N Islands, a press release from APWD said.

veterinary staff.
