Govt urges scientists to increase social acceptability of projects

New Delhi, Aug 12
 Minister for Space and Atomic Energy Dr Jitendra Singh has urged scientists to increase the social acceptability of projects. Releasing the new application services of BHUVAN, the Geospatial platform of Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO on National Remote Sensing Day today in New Delhi, Dr Singh said, ISRO's projects have been highly helpful especially in

disasters like Jammu and Kashmir floods and Hudhud cyclone in Andhra Pradesh last year. Lauding ISRO for launching BHUVAN and adding new features every year, Dr Singh said, BHUVAN is India's Google as it focuses on various aspects of Indian subcontinent. He said, it is in line with the Prime Minister's Make in India initiative. The Minister informed that two halls for Space and Atomic Energy will be established in

the Pragati Maidan in the national capital. He said, due to space technology, MeT Department is providing accurate forecast. Speaking on the occasion, Director of ISRO's National Remote Sensing Centre, V K Dadwal said, ISRO has tied up with the Union Urban Development Ministry for mapping over 500 towns and cities, to make a base plan for better planning and management.

Multispecialty health camp benefits people of Kamorta Island

Port Blair, Aug 12
 A multispecialty health camp with special emphasis on school children was conducted at Kamorta Island by INHS Dhanvantari and INS Kardip under the aegis of Headquarters Andaman and Nicobar Command last week. The camp was coordinated by INS Kardip with support from civil health authorities of Community Health Centre Kamorta. Medical screening was carried out prior to the multispecialty camp in various schools of Kamorta in order to screen children requiring specialist medical attention.



The Medical Team included an ENT Specialist, an Ophthalmologist and a Dental Surgeon from INHS Dhanvantari. It was augmented by doctors and paramedic staff from Air Force Station Carnic and INS Kardip.

Apart from school children, tribal and local population also benefitted

Over one million consumers say no to LPG subsidy

New Delhi, Aug 12
 Running a sustained audio-visual campaign to encourage people, the three public sector oil companies have managed to convince over one million consumers across India to surrender their LPG subsidy, says a senior official of a state oil company.

Around 15.3 crore consumers

are registered with the three companies, Indian Oil (Indane), Bharat Petroleum (Bharat Gas) and Hindustan Petroleum (HP Gas), which incur a total subsidy cost of nearly Rs 40,000 crore on providing 12 LPG cylinders per year to each domestic consumer.

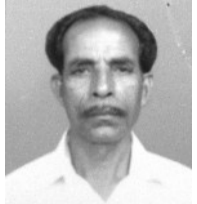

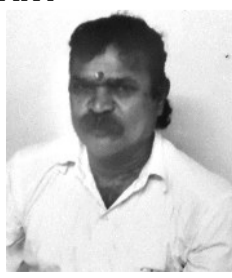

India's premier spinner recorded his best overseas figures of 6 for 46 in 13.4 overs to trigger a collapse that saw the islanders being shot out in just 49.4 overs in their first innings after skipper Angelo Mathews opted to make first use on a track that had turned on offer on the first day itself. At stumps, India looked in

Shikhar Dhawan seemed to continue from where he left off in Bangladesh as he stroked his way to an unbeaten 53 while skipper Virat Kohli looked supremely confident during his undefeated knock of 45. India are only 55 runs short of Sri Lanka's first innings total and will be looking to build a sizeable lead on a pitch that is offering substantial turn at times. The first day panned out exactly in the manner that skipper Kohli might have wanted it to be. Ishant Sharma (1/30 in 11 overs)
