'Vande Mataram' transformed love for the motherland into a national duty

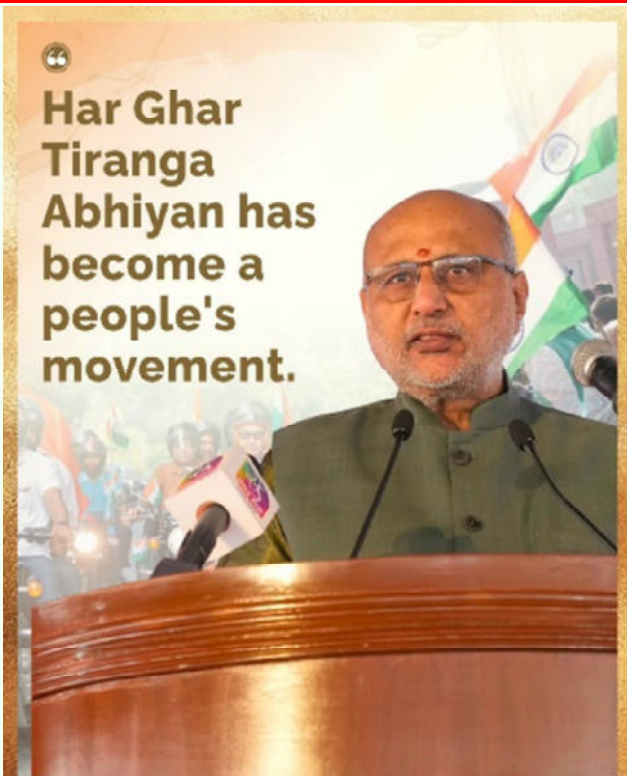
Hon'ble Vice-President recalls Netaji's hoisting of Tricolour in 1943 and sacrifices of freedom fighters imprisoned in Cellular Jail

New Delhi, Aug. 12 (PIB)

Hon'ble Vice-President, Shri C. P. Radhakrishnan today flagged off the Har Ghar Tiranga Bike Rally with Members of Parliament and other public representatives at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi, commemorating 150 years of the National Song, Vande Mataram. The rally proceeded from Bharat Mandapam to Major Dhyani Chand National Stadium, carrying the message of national pride, unity and citizen participation.

Addressing the gathering, he said, Vande Mataram transformed love for the motherland into a national duty and became a powerful expression of the spirit of India's freedom struggle. He recalled how its immortal words inspired countless freedom fighters with courage, sacrifice and hope.

Recalling his recent visit to the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Hon'ble Vice-President said, his visit to Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island and the historic Cellular Jail had been deeply moving. He recalled Netaji's hoisting of the Tricolour in 1943 and

the sacrifices of freedom fighters imprisoned in Cellular Jail, many of whom went to the gallows with the cry of

Vande Mataram.

Highlighting the nationwide impact of the National Song, Vande Mataram, in India's freedom struggle, Shri C. P. Radhakrishnan recalled the contributions and sacrifices of freedom fighters and leaders from Tamil Nadu, including V. O. Chidambaram Pillai, Subramaniya Siva, Tiruppur Kumaran and Vanchinathan, as well as national poet Subramania Bharati, who carried the spirit and message of Vande Mataram to the people.

The Hon'ble Vice-President said the Har Ghar Tiranga Abhiyan, launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi in 2022, has evolved into a people's movement, with citizens participating in Tiranga Yatras, bike and cycle rallies, cultural programmes and other activities. In a significant step towards strengthening coastal security and maritime operational capabilities in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM, (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency today formally inducted 10 newly procured Rubberized Inflatable Boats into the Police Marine Force (PMF), A&N Police, during an induction ceremony held in the Conference Hall, Lok Niwas.

The function was attended by Ms. Chanchal Yadav, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration; Shri Ravindra Singh Yadav,



IPS, Director General of Police, A&N Islands; Shri Sanjay Kumar Sinha, IFS, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, A&N Islands, and other senior officers of the A&N Administration and Police.

The Police Marine

Force plays a vital role in strengthening coastal security, maritime surveillance and patrolling, search and rescue, and responding to various operational and emergency requirements across the Islands.

The existing fleet of Rubberized Inflatable Boats, procured under the Coastal Security Scheme (CSS) - Phase II, has been extensively deployed at Coastal Police Stations and remote Look Out Posts for coastal surveillance, shallow-

water operations and Search & Rescue missions. Prolonged deployment and exposure to harsh marine conditions have resulted in progressive ageing of the fleet, necessitating phased replacement to maintain operational readiness.

The newly inducted boats will enhance the capabilities of A&N Police in coastal surveillance and patrolling, search and rescue, anti-poaching operations, boarding of suspicious vessels, shallow-water operations and rapid response during maritime emergencies. They will also facilitate transportation of personnel, equipment and essential supplies to remote and strategically important locations such

Elaborate traffic arrangements made for rehearsal of Independence Day on Aug. 13 & for main function on Aug. 15

It is notified for the information of the General Public that the following Traffic arrangements have been made for the rehearsal of the Independence Day celebrations on 13th August 2026 (Thursday) (Full Dress Rehearsal) and for the main function on 15th August 2026 (Saturday).

1. The carcade of Hon'ble Lt. Governor and other dignitaries, holders of parking card 'P' (Green) shall be parked inside the Netaji Stadium.
2. The holders of parking card 'P' (Pink) shall be parked near Andaman Club and in the parking area in front of Sports Hostel.
3. The holders of car parking label 'P', (both Green and Pink) may use any route of their choice to approach the place of function, but are requested to reach the place of function latest by 0830 hrs and 0815 hrs respectively, failing which, their vehicles will be stopped near the Gymkhana Crossing, RK Mission and Fire Brigade (HQ) crossings.
4. After the departure of the Chief Guest from the place of function, the vehicles bearing parking label "P" (both Green & Pink) shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-Vikas Bhawan (ANIIDCO Office)-Fire Brigade-APWD Crossing to their destinations.
5. The holders of 'P-1'(Yellow) parking labels will arrive at the Netaji Stadium by 0800 hrs. via Model School-Clock Tower-Gymkhana Crossing. Thereafter, the vehicles shall proceed to the parking on the western side of main gate of Netaji Stadium and near Swimming Pool.
6. After the departure of all vehicles parked inside the stadium and near Andaman Club having "P" parking label the vehicles with "P-1" parking label will be allowed to come to the main entrance of Netaji Stadium to pick up the guests and shall leave via Scout Hut Junction-Girls School Crossing-RK Mission and RGT Road.
7. All other vehicles without any parking label including two and four wheelers will be parked near Water Sports Complex and Girls School parking.
8. The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing - Bengali Club - Goalghar- Secretariat Junction - Police Line and Nayagaon.
9. No heavy vehicles, private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed towards Cellular Jail from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs and shall be diverted to other routes from Bengali Club Junction.
10. The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV- Secretariat Junction and Goalghar.
11. Heavy vehicles shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglighat from Bengali Club from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.
12. No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards the place of function from Y- Narayan Junction, RK Mission, Fire Brigade Junction and Water Sports Junction after 0830 hrs.
13. No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed towards Aberdeen Bazar after the start of the function from any direction till the dispersal of the crowd.
14. The vehicles carrying parade contingents after dropping the contingents in front of Netaji Stadium shall proceed to Water Sports Complex/Girls School Parking and will remain stationed there. After culmination of parade they will come to Netaji Stadium via Y- Narayan Junction and proceed to their respective units with the parade contingents.
15. Further vehicles intending to proceed to GB Pant Hospital shall follow the routes from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.
 - (i) Gandhi Statue- Marine Gate - Sisty Nagar - Dignabad Sea Shore Road - Khan Jn. - exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.
 - (ii) Bengali Club - Clock Tower - Gymkhana Crossing - Round Basthi - Dignabad Sea Shore Road - Khan Jn. - exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.

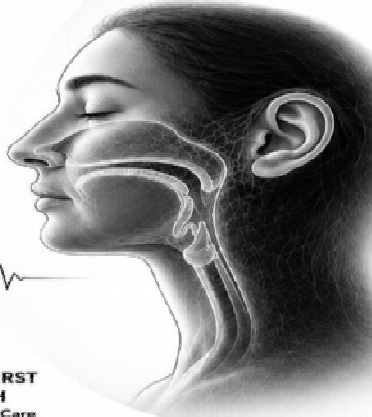
