1st DISHA meeting of District Administration held

MP reviews progress of all 29 Centrally Sponsored Schemes of various Departments



Port Blair, Sept. 12

The 1st DISHA meeting of District Administration South Andaman was held in its conference hall under the Chairmanship of Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray on Sept. 9. DISHA Committee has been recently constituted by the Govt. of India to oversee and monitor all the Centrally Sponsored Schemes being implemented by State or UT Administration. The Member of Parliament, A&N Islands is the Chairman of the Committee and Deputy Commissioner (SA) is Member Secretary. Various schemes implementing Departments like Rural Development,

Electricity, Social Welfare, Education, PBMC and Adhyaksha, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman, Pramukh, Prothrapur and other PRIs etc., are Members in the Committee. Committee has also been given executive powers to seek co-operation from the Departments and issue directions.

In the 1st meeting, the Member of Parliament reviewed the progress of all 29 Centrally Sponsored Schemes of various Departments. The MP pointed out the lacunas and various shortcomings at various stages of implementation and directed the Departments to take immediate action.

He further emphasized that Govt. of India has launched all these schemes for the benefits of the Islanders and it is the duty of the Departments to ensure that the benefits as envisaged in the schemes reaches the general public of the Islands. He further directed the Member Secretary, DC (SA) to seek status reports from all the Departments on various points mentioned by him during the discussion and submit report within 30 days.

The Adhyaksha, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman pointed out that the Departments should take the views of the PRIs while implementing these

With the objective to bridge the skill gap in the Tourism Sector, to raise the quality of service and to open livelihood opportunities for local youth of the Islands, the Department of Tourism, A & N Administration jointly with Dr. B.R Ambedkar Institute of Technology (DBRAIT), Port Blair will be organizing a number of courses in Hospitality Sector at DBRAIT viz. Hospitality Certificate Course in Food & Beverage Service & Accommodation Operation and Hospitality Certificate Course in Food Production & Bakery. The fees for each course is

Rs.3,000/- and the duration of the course will be 30 days (06 hours per day).

All interested candidates, having minimum of 8th pass certificate in CBSE schooling system can apply for the course in the prescribed format by 5 pm of Sept. 20, 2016. The interview/selection of candidate by screening committee is scheduled at 10 am on Sept. 21 while the last date for payment is Sept. 23, by 3 pm. The training will commence from Sept. 26, 2016.

US Open: Stanislas Wawrinka beats Novak Djokovic to lift men's singles titles

New York, Sept 12
Switzerland's Stanislas Wawrinka defeated world number one Novak Djokovic with a scintillating display to win his first US Open and third Grand Slam title.
Wawrinka, seeded third, won 6-7, 6-4, 7-5, 6-3 to add the US title to those he had already won in Australia and France over the last two years.
Switzerland's Stanislas Wawrinka became the oldest US Open men's champion in 46 years when he defeated world number one Novak Djokovic to claim a third Grand Slam title on Sunday.
Third seed Wawrinka, triumphed 6-7, 6-4, 7-5, 6-3 after almost four hours of high intensity tennis.
The final started with Djokovic quickest out of the blocks. Trailing 2-5, Wawrinka, who had spent the best part of nine hours more than Djokovic getting to the final, saved two set points.



But Djokovic glided untroubled through the tie-break as Wawrinka's serve fell apart. Wawrinka is used to chasing lost causes against Djokovic, coming back from losing the first set to win their 2014 Australian Open quarter-final and again at Roland Garros last year. Calling on that expertise, he broke for 3-1 in the second set, recovered from handing the advantage back in the seventh to level the final when Djokovic unleashed a wild forehand on set point in the 10th.
Wawrinka saved three break points in the opening game of the third set, to take a 3-0 lead. But Djokovic clawed his way
