## Initiative under ease of access to services District Administration launches Single Window System for survey & registration/ revalidation of Inland vessel

Port Blair, Oct. 12 The District Administration has been receiving complaints regarding considerable delay in survey and registration/revalidation of Inland Vessel since the inspection by Surveyors from Port Management Board and District Administration were done separately. Taking into consideration the hardships faced by the

vessel owners, a meeting was held by the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman with all stakeholders and it was decided that the inspection shall be conducted jointly by the team of Port Management Board and District Administration on a single day. This will reduce the time taken for inspection procedure which normally requires 2-3 months and now the

whole procedure shall be completed within 20-25 days. All Inland vessel owners under the jurisdiction of South Andaman District have been informed that to reduce the time for survey and registration/revalidation of the vessels, a Single Window System for survey and registration/revalidation of Inland vessel has been introduced and

henceforth, the team for Joint Inspection of the Inland vessel by Surveyors from Port Management Board and staff from District Administration shall be available at the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman. Standard Operating Procedures for entire registration/survey/revalidation has been devised which shall be modulated and managed at a single delivery point. The

documents required for initial and periodical survey, first time registration as well as for revalidation of registration certificate have been uploaded and general public may follow the link for required documentation in the web portal [www.edistrict.andaman.gov.in](http://www.edistrict.andaman.gov.in), a press release from DC (SA) said.

Port Blair, Oct. 12 The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be holding National Lok Adalat in the District Court Complex at Port Blair and Sub-Divisional Court at Mayabunder and Circuit Court at Diglipur on Nov.12, 2022 by adopting all COVID SOP issued by the MHA from time to time. Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in

different courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-litigation disputes include NI Act cases u/s 138, money recovery cases, labour dispute cases, electricity and water bills cases (excluding non-compoundable), maintenance cases civil disputes and disputes under the Consumer

Protection Act. The general public having any such dispute at the pre-litigation stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair before Oct. 31, 2022 so that their disputes may be processed and made ready for hearing before the National Lok Adalat on Nov.12, 2022, a press release from DLSA said.
