All bank branches in A&N Islands to remain open today; guidelines issued

Port Blair, Nov. 12 As announced by the Government of India, Rs. 500 and Rs.1000 denominations of Bank Notes of the existing series issued by Reserve Bank of India have ceased to be legal tender with effect from 9th November 2016, to the

extent specified in the Notification. Bank Branches will be the primary agencies through which public and other entities can exchange the specified old bank notes for crediting to their accounts upto and including Dec. 30, 2016.

Therefore, banks have to accord highest priority to this work. In order to enable the public and other entities exchange their existing Rs. 500 and Rs. 1000 notes, a number of arrangements have been made by banks. Accordingly, all the 102

Bank Branches situated in A & N Islands will give top priority to provide facility for exchanging the old Bank notes and open additional counters to meet the public demand.

series bank notes of Rs. 500 and Rs. 1000) over the banks counter is once for the entire duration till the limit is reviewed by Reserve Bank of India after fifteen days. This is not a per day limit. In other words, a person can exchange worth Rs. 4000 only across the banks counter unless the limit is revised after review. Amounts above this have to be deposited in accounts only.

For exchanging the old Bank notes the applicant has to submit a specified format issued by Reserve Bank of India, available with all Banks along with Identity Proof in Original to be shown at the counter. Documents like Aadhaar Card, driving License, Voter ID Card, Pass Port, NREGA Card, PAN Card, Identity Card Issued by Government Department, Public Sector Unit to its Staff are valid ID proofs.

There shall not be any limit on the quantity or value of the old bank notes to be credited to the account maintained with the Bank by a person, where the old notes are tendered; however, where compliance with extant Know Your customer (KYC) norms is not complete in an account, the maximum value of specified bank notes as may deposited shall be Rs. 50,000.

The equivalent value of old bank notes tendered may be credited to an account maintained by the tenderer at any bank in accordance with standard banking procedure and on production of valid proof of Identity.

The equivalent value of old bank notes tendered may be credited to a third party account, provided specific authorization therefore accorded by the third party is presented to the Bank, following standard banking procedure and on production of valid proof of identity of the person actually tendering the amount.

Cash withdrawal from Bank account over the counter shall be restricted to Rs. 10,000 per day subject to an overall limit of Rs. 20,000 a week from the date of the notification until the end of business hours on 24th Nov, 2016 after which these limits shall be reviewed.

Withdrawal for ATM shall be restricted to Rs.2000 per day per card upto 18th Nov 2016 and the limit shall be raised to Rs.4000 per day per card from 19th Nov 2016.

There shall be no restriction on the use of any non-cash method of operating the account of a person including Cheques, Demand Drafts credit or debit cards, mobile wallet and electronic fund transfer mechanisms or the like.

The general public have been advised not to panic since all Banks are well equipped and all arrangements were made to deal with the customers. There are sufficient Currency available and full efforts are being made for all ATMs' operation. In a press release received here today, the Lead District Manager, State Bank of India, Shri P K Ummer Farooq said, since this is an emergency situation, people have been requested to be patient and support for smooth functioning of Banks. All the Banks situated in A&N Islands will be opened for normal business on Sunday i.e 13.11.2016. The facility for exchange and deposit of old bank note is available upto 30th Dec 2016, the release added.
