Chartered flight services between Port Blair and Car Nicobar to resume soon

Port Blair, Feb 28
 The Andaman & Nicobar Administration and the Air India are working out the Modalities to re-introduce the Chartered Flight services between Port Blair and Car Nicobar w.e.f. 1st April, 2019. As per the plans, the Air India would operate a regular 144 seater Airbus A-319/A-320 aircraft weekly once on every Saturday. The tentative departure time of the flight from Port Blair would be 11.15 am. The final



schedule would be communicated in due course shortly as the process is on to obtain the regulatory clearances from the authorities for the flight and the setting up of the ground handling equipments and ancillary arrangements at the Car

Nicobar airport. It may be recalled that earlier the Alliance Air Limited - a subsidiary of Air India lazed to operate a 70 seater CRJ-700 type aircraft on the Port Blair and Car Nicobar route, once a week from 24th July 2014 which was later on

discontinued on August, 2016 due to the withdrawal of the CRJ type aircraft from Alliance Air's fleet. Since then, the A & N Administration has been regularly taking up the matter with the Air India and the Ministry of Civil Aviation for the restoration of the flight service connecting the District HQ's of Nicobar District with Port Blair and it is now expected that the wait of the public for the chartered flight service to Car Nicobar is going to end soon.

One gold, five silver medals for India at Makran Cup boxing in Iran

New Delhi, Feb 28
National champion Deepak Singh (49kg) was the lone Indian boxer to notch up a gold, while five others claimed silver medals in the Makran Cup in Chabahar, Iran. Deepak defeated Jaafar Naseri in the finals held on Wednesday night. However, none of the other five Indian finalists could win their summit clashes. Finishing second on the podium were P Lalitha Prasad (52kg), Commonwealth Games silver-medallist Manish Kaushik (60kg), Duryodhan Singh Negi (69kg), Sanjeet (91kg) and Commonwealth Games silver-medallist Satish Kumar (+91kg).



Manish, also a national champion, lost to Danial Shah Baksh, while Satish was beaten by Mohammad Mias. Sanjeet, a gold-medallist at the India Open last year, went down to Eldin Ghossoun in his final bout. Prasad couldn't put it past Omid Safa Ahmedi and settled for the second position. Duryodhan lost to Sajjad Zadeh Kezimi in the welterweight final. Earlier, Rohit Tokas (64kg) and Manjeet Singh Panghal (75kg) lost in the semifinals to sign off with bronze medals.

U-19 Test: Rex Singh, Anshul Kamboj wreck South Africa as India complete clean sweep

New Delhi, Feb 28
Left-arm seamer Rex Singh (4 for 18) and right-arm speedster Anshul Kamboj (3 for 20) guided India to an innings and 158 run victory in the second U-19 Test, helping the hosts wrap the series 2-0. South Africa made 152 in the first innings while the hosts piled up 395 in response, riding on tons by Yashasvi Jaiswal (173) and Vaibhav Kandpal (120). However, the Proteas colts fared worse in the second innings as they slumped to 85 all out after starting the day at 50 for 2. They lost eight wickets for 35 runs inside 25 overs. Andile Mkgakane (15) was the first to go, nicking one from Kamboj to the captain Suraj Ahuja. Skipper Matthew Montgomery, who had batted in a positive manner on Wednesday, could add only two runs to his overnight score of 34, before edging one from



Kamboj to his counterpart Ahuja behind the wickets. After the spinners Manishi and Hrithik Shokeen, who did the damage in the first innings, picked up a wicket each including that of the dangerous Bryce Parsons (6), it was the turn of Manipur pacer Rex to get into the act. The left-arm pacer had Luke Beaufort caught by substitute Varun Nayanar for 1 and then took the wickets of Siya Plaati (0) and Lifa Ntanz (4) to wrap up the SA innings.

Women cricketers to get recognition on Lord's honours board

London, Feb 28
Women cricketers will finally feature on the Lord's honour board as the 135-year-old Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) has decided to recognise centuries and five-wicket hauls in ODI cricket too. Earlier, only centuries and five-wicket hauls in Test matches were mentioned on the boards at home and away dressing rooms at Lord's. The change is a part of MCC's refurbishment drive at the "Home of Cricket" ahead of 2019 season. "We are delighted to now be able to recognise the same achievements for One-Day Internationals as we have done for Test Matches for many years. This is a landmark moment for Lord's, with women's cricket now documented in the dressing rooms for the first time,"



ESPNcricinfo quoted MCC chief executive and secretary Guy Lavender, as saying. "The Honours Boards are amongst the most popular attractions for the many visitors to the Home of Cricket. There is a huge amount of prestige for players to see their name inscribed in history, so it is appropriate for a new installation of the boards to take place ahead of what will be such a busy year of cricket at Lord's," he added. This new change will mean that Sarah Taylor, Claire Taylor and Caroline Atkins of England Women's team will have their names immortalised for scoring centuries at Lords. Katherine Brunt and Anya Shrubsole will also feature on the honours board for taking five-wicket hauls. Among men cricketers, players like Ricky Ponting, Michael Atherton, and Muttiah Muralitharan will have their names mentioned on the honours board after missing out for so many years.

Virat Kohli enters top-three in highest T20I run scorers list

Dubai, Feb 28
India captain Virat Kohli didn't get the desired outcome in the T20I series against Australia with defeats in Visakhapatnam and Bengaluru. The series defeat dented Kohli's flawless captaincy record at home and gave Australia their first win in India in any format since 2008. Personally, however, Kohli went past 2200 runs in T20I matches to become the third highest run scorer in the format. With 72 runs from 38 balls, he took his run tally in the shortest format to 2263 runs from 67 matches, thereby equalling Pakistan's Shoaib Malik who also has 2263 runs to his name but from 111 matches. Kohli took



the least number of innings to reach the 2200 run mark milestone. Ahead of Kohli, Shoaib are Martin Gupthill (2272 runs from 74 matches) and Rohit Sharma (2331 runs from 94 matches). That leaves Kohli nine runs behind Gupthill and 68 behind Rohit. Virat scored an unbeaten 72 runs in the second T20I at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium, which also happens to be the home ground of IPL franchise Royal Challengers Bangalore which is captained by Kohli. His inning witnessed two boundaries and six sixes as he forged a 100 run stand with MS Dhoni for the fourth wicket.




